# Reflection




I am sure most of us have experienced the server telling us as our main dish is being placed before us: *Careful! The plate is hot ...* Also, we have all noticed that Fast Food Restaurants include a caution label on such items as coffee, hot chocolate or any foods where we run the risk of a possible burn. Although the warning is often appreciated, I believe most of us realize "the obvious," but these cautions do highlight the notion that sometimes what may appear inviting, soothing, sweet or tasty can actually scald our hands, tongue, or mouth. A very inviting treat can very well "come back at us," if we are not careful. It seems the Beatitudes are bit like that. The words are very familiar to us: *Blessed are the poor, those who mourn, the meek, the hungry, the merciful, the clean of heart, the peace makers, and the pure of heart* (Matthew 5). Of course there is a temptation to remember the part of the Beatitudes which reflect the lowest common denominator, the part that seems to go down the easiest and the beatitude that does not create ripples in our lives. Unfortunately, like the hot plate served at dinner or the coffee or hot chocolate cup, what is inside can be scalding hot!

There is also a tendency on our part to "play with the beatitudes." As we hear or listen to the catalog of blessedness, we seem to use them as a thermometer or gauge of ourselves: Am I humble enough, or how about being meek, how am I doing with that, and mercy, am I being merciful. We tend to view the end result of the beatitude as the all-important as if the beatitudes were merely about the "doing of" rather than the "being about." If we find that we are meeting the criteria for at least four or five of the blessedness, then we just might receive our reward when we die; however, I am not too sure Jesus' idea of the Beatitudes was something reserved to the afterlife. Life in Christ is not a lay-away plan! I believe the Beatitudes are a reminder to us that we are not ever to stand on the sidelines, to simply do nothing, or wait for God to make the first move. I think the blessedness Jesus speaks about dares us to mess with life! It is one thing to talk about doing what is right, but there is blessedness about those who are willing to put themselves on the line to make sure what is right is realized. One can easily talk about being a peacemaker, but there is a blessedness about being insulted and persecuted and having every kind of evil lodged against us because we put ourselves out to assure the dignity and integrity of each person is honored.

There is a caution in today's Gospel: The words of the Beatitudes may sound comforting on the outside, but *watch out ... the contents are hot!* Standing on the sidelines where it is cool and safe is simply not acceptable. The peripheral may be more attractive to us, but like coffee, chocolate, or apple pie, when it is put aside, it becomes cold and stale, and such is the case with our lives. When we choose to live on the sidelines, life can become cold, empty, and shallow. The Beatitudes are about being *hot* not *cold*! It is about choosing to put ourselves on the line to be a blessing to others. It is about standing up and making a difference. It is about saying to the world: *Look out! Caution! Here we come and we are scalding-hot for Jesus!*



#### **Rose @90 Turning the Corner**

I have been taking Rose to coffee once a week for over twenty years. Rose looks forward to these sharing times.

We always go to her favorite McDonalds and we sit and bring each other up to date, well I sit there and listen to her stories. About eight years ago Rose began repeating some of her stories. I used to get a bit upset and told her she had already told me that one. Then I realized that my mood affected her mood. I shifted my response and acknowledged her story and showed my happiness for her sharing it with me. I listen without judgement. Rose shows me each time a picture of the retired police department lieutenant who had come to her house to interview her about her potential neighbors who were selling drugs. I always appreciate her showing me that picture and ask her if there was any follow-up with the problem neighbors. It is not about me but about Rose being comfortable with sharing her stories with me. I recently took some WWII songs and played them for her. She was pleased and I could see her entire body making a few slight movements. I have shared my photography, poetry, short stories and even novels with Rose. I have queried her for information about her family so I could update our family tree. These personal sharing opportunities have added a new freshness to our discussions.

**Have you considered becoming a minister to our sick and homebound?** We minister by taking communion and fellowship to our friends in six different medical and convalescent facilities and about thirty homes, every Sunday and some weekdays. I coordinate the assignments and make sure all of us do not get overburdened. Many of us have been doing this ministry for greater than a decade and all of us are full of joy being in the presence of the Lord. When the Holy Spirit moves you, please contact me to discuss and see if there is a good fit. Training, mentoring and nurturing is implicit in this ministry.
