Reflection

Most everyone knows that in our Sunday celebrations of Mass, when it comes to our readings, we are on a three year cycle. Which means, for the most part, we hear a set of Sunday readings once every three years; at least that's the theory? For reasons that my non-mathematical mind can't figure out, today's three readings haven't been heard since 2010. Next week's readings haven't been heard since 2007 and the readings for the last Sunday before Lent begins haven't been heard since 2001. The readings today and over the next two Sundays have some very important messages for us as we journey into the Season of Lent?

Let's talk about Lent for a moment. Lent is about fasting, praying, and Almsgiving, correct? Well, that's what we're called to do but these three actions don't tell us why. So why do we fast, pray more and give to the poor during Lent? This prepares us to celebrate Easter. If that's what you thought, you're almost right. Remember during Easter, every Sunday we have a Sprinkling Rite and we renew our Baptismal Promises. Lent enables us to prepare ourselves to be transformed by the suffering, death and resurrection of the Lord and in so doing, Lent empowers us to confidently and sincerely live the Baptismal Promises that we will proclaim "yes" to.

In today's Gospel, Luke provides us Jesus' Sermon on the Plain as different than Matthew's Sermon on the Mount. In Matthew's Gospel, Jesus tells us how about the beatitudes: blessed are those who are poor in spirit, those who are meek, those who seek out righteousness, and so on, that theirs is the Kingdom of Heaven. Jesus only speaks to his apostles. In Luke's Gospel, Jesus is preaching to a large crowd and talks about only four beatitudes but also four "woe's": woe to those who are rich, who are filled up with food, and so on. And in these beatitudes and woes or curses, Jesus uses the word "you." In essence, Jesus is telling you and me who we must stand up for; we must stand for those who can't stand up for themselves. We must stand for those who are on the margins.

Today, members of the Knights of Columbus will talk about their efforts to stand up and help those who have special needs. These are the people that you and I don't like to look at, don't like to talk about and about whom some of us make fun. The Knights sponsor and work with something called Camp ReCreation. Volunteers, many from the Knights, enable those with special needs to have fun, to learn about God and how much God loves them and will do so in a place where people love them, and won't laugh at them. Children and adults with special needs are some of the people that Jesus commands us love and care for. It's our choice and it's not easy. So instead of being oblivious to the needs of those who can't stand up for themselves, let's learn from the Knights of Columbus how we can step by step live Jesus' command to make a difference in their lives.

May we pray this weekend that the Holy Spirit shows us the way and be generous, caring and empathetic to those with special needs.
