# Reflection

## "Believe in the Gospel"

When I was a kid during summer vacation, my mom and dad would take us to see our aunt, uncle and cousins in Phoenix. This was in the late 1950's and early 1960's when my dad would drive us through the desert in the middle of the night when it wasn't 115 degrees and our car radiator wouldn't overheat. One day we all got in my uncle's old car and drove up to the mountains for a picnic. A storm came up very quickly and I mean a STORM! The sky grew really dark and the storm brought thunder and lightning and fierce wind. I remember seeing a car near us that was towing a boat and the boat overturned because of the wind.

Jesus' time in the desert was, a very stormy time. Temptations came and went without notice. What did Jesus find through this time of being by himself to face horrendous things and temptations, the same kind you and I face? Jesus found the Father, who loved his Son beyond belief.

Lent is our moment to come to understand the temptations, the storms and the stresses of our lives and place them in perspective. It's our time to find the peace of God in the upheavals of our daily lives. It's our time to let the Holy Spirit enable us to make sense of the pain and stress we encounter. It's our time to remember life is fragile, we only have so much time to Repent and believe in the Gospel, to turn our lives away from sin and live our faith.

However, one thing I have always found frustrating about Lent is I run out of ideas of what to do. My ideas of what I'm going to give up or do differently kind of run out of gas; after a couple of weeks of not being able to do what I wanted to do, I tend to give up. They become like New Year's resolutions that never get achieved. So this might help: I've come across two websites that I want to share with you:

First, Matthew Kelly's website: Dynamic Catholic [info@dynamiccatholic.com](mailto:info@dynamiccatholic.com) This will lead you to "Best Lent Ever" details and every day suggestions. The second website is <http://bustedhalo.com/> which will lead you to a video called "Lent in 3 Minutes" as well as "25 Great Things You Can Do For Lent." These resources and many others are designed to help you make it through the dry spots, the deserts of Lent. Remember, when you come to Sunday Mass, offer up all the tough and painful and stressful things of life that you and I experience. Give them to Jesus and during the Eucharistic Prayer of the Mass, offer them up along with all the good things about yourself. Imagine what love the Father has for you and understand this is what Jesus found in the desert. For all the darkness and dryness of Lent, Jesus found and offers us hope, unconditional love and mercy. That's how we're able to "Repent and believe in the Gospel."

Dear friends,

There's are a couple projects we've been working on lately and I thought you'd be interested in a quick update. As you're aware, we had a successful "Fund a Need" campaign to raise money to replace our Church projector's, the sound system and lights in the church. The good news is the new projectors have been installed and the current sound system is better than the previous Demo system so it's currently in the process of being installed. We hope to start working on the Church lighting system in the next month. We may have a temporary lighting system installed to brighten up the sanctuary area. This could happen within a month. A big Thank You goes out to Jason Padilla, Ron Sled, John McEntee and Vince Vaccher for their help in project.

Recently the Diocese did a Safety inspection of the Church grounds and several concerns were identified. The first was what I call the Ficus Forest. Unfortunately the one time beautiful ficus tree's in front of the Church have grown so big that they've become a potential safety hazard. As you may know the Ficus tree has a huge root system. These roots have been tearing up our concrete foundations and plumbing systems; so, for safety reasons they needed to be removed. An architect has also volunteered his time to propose some ideas to dress up the front area of the Church. This is very important as it's the first impression people will have of our community.


You'll also notice windows have been installed on our Confessional doors. The windows were installed so that we would be in compliance with the Diocese' Safe Environment requirements. A big Thank you to Bill Morgan, Frank Waclawik and Frank Madrigal for their help on completing this project. The interiors of the confessionals are also in the process of being cleaned up....so if it's been awhile since your last confession please come on in and check it out. We'll leave a light on for you.

We're also in the process of upgrading our Chapel. Eventually we'd like to replace the old smelly carpeting, fix the cracks, paint the walls and build a more substantial and reverent altar. We're blest to have a whole host of people involved in this upgrade.

It's also come to my attention that, although we're a Catholic Church, we have no cross on the Church roof. Apparently, the cross was removed when the unsafe bell tower came down. So much of our Catholic tradition centers around the love God has shown us in the cross of Jesus Christ. So future plans include the placement of a cross on the Church roof.

Finally, I must say one of the greatest blessings to all of us and to me is the fact that each and every one of these projects are being worked on and completed by our very own parishioners. That speaks volumes about the character and generosity of the community here at St Angela Merici. So a big Thanks to all who've donated their time, talents and treasure!

## Lenten Traditions

The 40 days prior to Easter is meant to signify two biblical accounts, the first being Jesus wandering the wilderness for 40 days and being tempted by Satan as well as the 40 years the Israelites wandered. We go through lent as a time of temptation while we participate in abstinence, fasting and penance in order to strengthen our faith and come out of lent stronger and more faithful than when we entered. Three traditional pieces of lent are prayer, fasting and almsgiving. During the Lenten season we should focus on becoming closer to the Lord through prayer and examine our lives to focus on our area in need of improvement and therefore penance. Fasting predates Lent but primarily the fast is important to have a clear and focused mind leading to the celebration of Easter. Fasting helps us realize the suffering others face every day and reminds us of our Baptismal promises of showing Christ's Love to the world. This should lead us to a greater need to help alleviate the suffering of others. In the same way, almsgiving is also linked to our Baptism, to share with others as God has done for us. It is recommended Friday's of Lent be completely meat free and Good Friday is a day of fasting and only one meatless meal should be eaten on that day.
