

Reflection

Many lessons can be gleaned from the story of Isaac and Abraham. God appears to be asking the impossible of him: to surrender his only son through mortal sacrifice. Perhaps what is really being asked for is

trust, faith and total self-gift back to God. Just as God gives Himself completely to us we're called to give ourselves completely to God.

Abraham, Moses and Elijah were men of the covenant who gave their all to God, withholding nothing. In the carrying out of God's divine plan, they prefigure Jesus Christ. Jesus gave his all to God, putting his love for God, and for us, above all else to the point of sacrificing his own life for the sake of obedience to God's will. He now intercedes for us as, we too, strive to put God ahead of all things.

Saint Paul reminds the Romans and each of us today that Jesus always intercedes for us to the Father. To paraphrase Saint Paul: "Our God did not spare his own Son to prove how far he is willing to go for each of us. Will he not provide whatever we truly need throughout our journey of life?"

Every year on the Second Sunday of Lent, the pre-resurrection event of the Transfiguration of Jesus is proclaimed. It sets the stage for the Passion of Christ to unfold right before the disciples, and helps to strengthen their resolve to endure what was coming. Jesus gave all on the cross, his disciples too will end up giving their all.....and now we're called to do the same so we may be transformed into resurrection glory.

Lent is a season to prepare us to be transformed into this glory and one of the best ways to do this is by going to Confession. I always recommend people attend the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession) a minimum of twice a year. Once before Christmas and then Easter, it helps us to receive all the grace and love God wants to bless us with. To that end, please plan on attending our Parish Penance Service on February 28th from 7-8 PM. We'll have 10 priests to help out so you won't have to wait in line very long. The best part is that they don't even know you.

In our Gospel we heard how Jesus was transformed. God gives us the Sacrament of Confession to help us do the same. In this season of Lent, and in every season, may we have the grace to enter into God's transforming power and give our all to God. Yes even our sin.

Dear friends,

There's been a couple projects that we've been working on lately and I thought you'd be interested in a quick update. As you're aware we had a successful "Fund a Need" campaign to raise money to replace our Church projector's, the sound system and lights in the church. Well the good news is, the new projectors have been installed and the current sound system is 90% installed. We hope to start working on the Church lighting system in the next month. Until then, we have a temporary lighting system installed to brighten up the sanctuary area. A big Thank You goes out to Jason Padilla, Ron Sled, John McEntee, Gary Schwab and Vince Vaccher for their help on this project.

Our school kids needed more room to play and study, so the big 20' and 40' containers that were by the school have been moved to free up space. The Boy Scouts did an admirable job in clearing out the eyesore behind the rectory garage to make room for the containers and trailer.

Recently, the Diocese did a Safety inspection of the Church grounds and several concerns were identified. The first was what I call the ficus Forest. Unfortunately, the one time beautiful ficus trees in front of the Church, have grown so big they've become a potential safety hazard. As you may know, the ficus tree has a huge root system. These roots have been tearing up our concrete foundations and plumbing systems. So, for safety reasons they need to be removed. An architect has also volunteered his time to propose some ideas to dress up the front area of the Church. This is very important as it's the first impression people will have of our community.

You'll also notice that windows have been installed on our Confessional doors. The windows were installed so that we would be in compliance with the Diocese' Safe Environment requirements. A big Thank you to Bill Morgan, Frank Waclawik and Frank Madrigal for their help on completing this project. The interiors of the confessionals are also in the process of being cleaned up...so if it's been awhile since your last confession please come on in and check it out. We'll leave a light on for you.

We're also in the process of upgrading our Chapel. Eventually, we'd like to replace the old carpeting, fix the cracks, paint the walls and build a more substantial and reverent altar. We're blest to have a host of people involved in this upgrade.

It's also come to my attention, although we're a Catholic Church, we have no cross on the Church roof. Apparently, the cross was removed when the unsafe bell tower came down. So much of our Catholic tradition centers around the love God has shown us in the cross of Jesus Christ. So future plans include the placement of a cross on the Church roof.

And finally, I must say that one of the truly greatest blessings to all of us and to me is the fact that each and every one of these projects are being worked on and completed by our very own parishioners. That speaks volumes about the character and generosity of the community here at St Angela Merici. A big Thanks to all who've donated their time, talents and treasure!

Lenten Traditions

The 40 days prior to Easter is meant to signify two biblical accounts, the first being Jesus wandering the wilderness for 40 days and being tempted by Satan as well as the 40 We go years the Israelites wandered. through lent as a time of temptation while we participate in abstinence, fasting and penance in order to strengthen our faith and come out of lent stronger and more faithful then when we entered. Three traditional pieces of lent are prayer, fasting and almsgiving. During the Lenten season we should focus on becoming closer to the Lord through prayer and examine our lives to focus on our area in need of improvement and therefore penance. Fasting predates Lent but primarily the fast is important to have a clear and focused mind leading to the celebration of Easter. Fasting helps us realize the suffering others face every day and reminds us of our Baptismal promises of showing Christ's Love to the world. This should lead us to a greater need to help alleviate the suffering of others. In the same way, almsgiving is also linked to our Baptism, to share with others as God has done for us. Friday's of Lent are completely meat free. Good Friday is a day of fasting. Only one meatless meal and 2 half meals, not to exceed 1 full meal, should be eaten on that day.
