Reflection

Jesus' words today give us reason to pause. There does not seem to be any squeeze room when it comes to his notion of commitment to him: ... No one can serve two masters .. you will either hate one and love the other or be devoted to one and despise the other (Matthew 6), but Jesus furthers the notion of what it means to follow him when he states: ... look at the birds in the sky; they do not sow or reap, they gather nothing into barns, yet your heavenly Father feeds them ... learn from the way wild flowers grow ... they do not work or spin ... I tell you that not even Solomon in all his splendor was clothed like one of them ... if God so clothes the grass of the field which grows today and is thrown into the fire tomorrow will he not much more provide for you ... are you not more important (Matthew 6). Jesus seems to indicate that not only does our commitment to him needs to be firm, but we need to totally rely on God and nothing else. God will provide.

I do not believe Jesus' mandate of being less anxious and worrisome (Matthew 6) is as cavalier as it may sound. What he is asking us to do is make a radical decision for God. Jesus is inviting us to trust in God. To believe that God will ultimately take care of everything. I believe Jesus noticed in his own time (as in our own) how often greed can consume and disfigure us, transforming us into selfish and ruthless people. Life becomes an obsession about obtaining more and more to the extent that we lose sight of any moral value which can guide or put in check our insistence on "having it all." Only trust can fill the fears and insecurity that causes such worry about the things of the world and creates the obsession that amasses them. Trust gives us the courage to choose God over and against the things and concerns of our everyday lives. Trust is the belief that God is greater than when things do not seem to be going the way we want them to go. Trust allows us to continue to believe even in the midst of the hardships we encounter, the confusion that envelopes us, the difficulties that challenge us, the people who disappoint us, and even the sin that seems to overpower us. Trust allows us to recognize God in everything that happens: ...can a mother or father forget their infant ... be without tenderness for their child ... even should they forget ... I will never forget you (Isaiah 49).

Jesus' challenge seems to go against and almost seems contrary to what we have been taught and the way we think today. It almost seems irresponsible, but we need to remember that sometimes God can be obscured by our lack of trust and the hoarding of things. It is only when we are at the point of throwing everything to the wind, and decide instead to make the radical decision without reserve to believe, that we come to experience just how much God is truly working for us and within our lives. It is in that instant, that we come to the full realization that all that really matters is God, and he will ultimately give us what is truly good and necessary for us (probably not what we think we want, but what we really need). Only then, when we are able to trust God enough to release him in our lives, that we will come to know that everything we will ever need will be given to us and more (Matthew 6).

One of the most exceptional aspects of Saint Angela Merici is the feeling of welcome and belonging: We are part of something much greater than any one person. Our parish connects us as neighbors, a community, and as a People of God and followers of Christ. The dedication of our people, the gifts, time, talent, and treasure that are shared so generously have created a faith community that is vibrant, alive, and filled with the Spirit of Christ.

Your Stewardship support for the Pastoral Services Appeal last year has allowed our Diocese to continue to foster the many ministries of Faith Formation, Outreach, and social and community activities. We were also able to continue to foster the ministries of our parish particularly with our parish outreach (Bread of Angels and the ACT Office) and our Youth, Jr. High, and Young Adult Ministries, (Steubenville, Pets for Vets, Winter Wonderland, Spiritual and Personal Growth Evenings for youth and young adults, and Adoration and Prayer and Praise evenings) which our parishioners have always held as a very high priority at each Parish Assembly in the last ten years. In addition, we were able to enhance and complete many upgrades of our site that were in need of our attention after fifty years: Complete the roof work in Saint John Vianney and in the Parish Center Offices as well as replace the air condition/heat systems, resurface and stripe the black-top of the parking lot on Fir Street, provide special parking spaces for our seniors for easy access to the church for mass, the care and enhancement of our landscaping and the painting of our site. We are currently in the process of completing the work on our Roland Digital Grand Piano and reviewing the options for an organ since the original instrument, because of age was evaluated as an extreme fire hazard. Repairing the organ would be more than purchasing another, and if moved (as planned to the Choir Area) would take up over half of the space needed for our choirs). Finally, we are in contact with the Diocese of Orange and the City of Brea to move forward with the LED Parish Signage on Walnut Avenue. These are a few of our projects that have transpired because of your support and care. Our vision for this PSA 2017 is to continue to support our Youth, Jr. High, and Young Adult Ministries and to supplement the purchase of an organ for our parish.

It is our belief that Saint Angela Merici has consistently been generous stewards when specific endeavors or projects for ministry and the life of the parish are warranted, so it is important to listen to your heart as we begin PSA 2017. Your pledge is very important to the work, ministry, and the growth of our parish. This year's presenters, Susie and Dave Beas, Chris Blake, and Carolyn Lamka will share their own personal faith journey and how Saint Angela Merici has enabled them and their families to embrace more intimately their Catholic-Christian identity. As you reflect on your pledge, remember all stewardship is returned to our parish once we have met our pledge-goal of One Hundred and Two Thousand Dollars) \$102,000.00 This year we are asking for each person (family) to pledge \$400.00 (Four Hundred Dollars) which is about \$33.00 a month or approximately \$8.25 a week. You may pledge on the envelopes provided in the pews or on the parish website or you may want to take a pledge envelope home and pray and discern about your stewardship support. Your response to God's generosity will certainly be evident in the experience of Church at Saint Angela Merici. Please pledge. Pledge now. Pledge to make a difference. Pledge to witness to your gratefulness to God and the desire to see us continue to faithfully fulfill our Gospel-mission as a Parish Faith Community. Now is the Time!



Una de las cosas más excepcionales de ser parte de Sta. Ángela Mérici es el sentimiento de bienvenida y pertenencia: Somos parte de algo más grande que una persona. Nuestra Iglesia nos une como vecinos, comunidad y como hijos e hijas de Dios y seguidores de Cristo. Su donación y apoyo a la Apelación para los Servicios Pastorales del año pasado ha permitido a nuestra Diócesis seguir fomentando la Formación en la Fe de muchos ministerios, de alcance y actividades sociales y comunitarias. También pudimos seguir fomentando ministerios, de alcance en nuestra comunidad, especialmente (Pan de ángeles y la Oficina de Cristianos Activos) y nuestros jóvenes adolescentes y jóvenes adultos y ministerios, como (Steubenville, mascotas para veteranos, Winter Wonderland (las maravillas de invierno), crecimiento espiritual y personal, tardes para jóvenes y adultos, de Adoración, oración y alabanza tanto en Ingles como en español) que nuestros feligreses han considerado siempre como una muy alta prioridad en cada uno de los conjuntos de la parroquia en los últimos diez años. Además, pudimos mejorar y completar muchas de las actualizaciones de nuestro sitio web que necesitaba de nuestra atención después de cincuenta años: se completó el trabajo del techo en San Juan Vianney y en las oficinas del centro parroquial, así como actualizamos los sistemas de aire acondicionado/calefacción, se puso nueva la superficie y la raya superior negra del estacionamiento en la calle Fir, proporcionamos espacios de estacionamiento especiales para nuestros ancianos para que tengan fácilmente acceso a la iglesia para la Misa, el mejoramiento de nuestro panorama y de la pintura de nuestro sitio. Actualmente estamos en el proceso de completar el trabajo en nuestro Piano Digital Roland y revisión de las opciones para un órgano desde el instrumento original, por razones de tiempo fue evaluado como un extremo peligro de incendio. Reparar el órgano sería más que la compra de otro, y si se mueve (como estaba previsto en la zona del Coro) llevaría más de la mitad del espacio necesario para nuestros coros). Por último, estamos en contacto con la diócesis de Orange y la ciudad de Brea para avanzar con el LED de señalización parroquial en calle Walnut Avenue. Estos son algunos de nuestros proyectos que han ocurrido gracias a su apoyo y sus promesas. Nuestra visión para el PSA 2017, es seguir apoyando los ministerios de nuestros jóvenes adolescentes y adultos, y complementar la compra de un órgano para nuestra parroquia.

Es nuestra creencia de que Sta. Ángela Mérici ha sido generosa administradora consistentemente cuando hay determinadas actividades o proyectos para el ministerio y la vida de la parroquia que están garantizados. por lo tanto, es importante escuchar su corazón al momento de decidir su promesa para los Servicios Pastorales (PSA) 2017. Su compromiso es muy importante para la obra del ministerio, y el crecimiento de nuestra parroquia. Los presentadores de este año, Susie y David Beas, Chris Blake, y Carolyn Lamka compartirán su propio itinerario de fe y de cómo Sta. Ángela Mérici Les ha permitido a ellos y a sus familias abrazar su identidad Católica-Cristiana más íntimamente. 
