Reflection

"Rejoice Everyone, It's the Fourth Sunday of Lent"

On this Fourth Sunday of Lent, the Church, for centuries, has called us to "Rejoice" and take a break from the fasting and abstaining that we have been involved in for the last three weeks. This Sunday has traditionally been called "Laetare Sunday" from the Latin word "to rejoice" or "to be joyful." We rejoice because Easter, the great day of the Resurrection, is right around the corner. We rejoice because the great day of Salvation is almost here. We pause from the pain of Lent for one day and tomorrow we're back at it. Trying again to keep our Lenten promises. We pray the Holy Spirit will fill us with the grace needed to bring us to mysteries of the Passion, Death and Resurrection of our Lord.

In John's Gospel, we hear proclaimed those wonderful words: "For God so loved the world that he sent his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life." I remember at major league baseball games or NFL games, every so often, some guy would hold up a sign that said: John 3:15. People would look up this verse and find those words that our God loved us so much, the very gospel we hear this Sunday.

These words do not communicate a 'one time in history' event. The Passion, Death and Resurrection of the Lord is a once in history event we commemorate and hopefully live each time we celebrate together the Eucharistic liturgy - the Mass. The action of God so loving the world that he sends his only Son, happens every day all over the world and it happens every day in you and me. Because, by the grace of God and by the life of the Holy Spirit, you and I are sent out as messengers of God's love. We are sent out to show all who we encounter that God loves them: our family, our fellow employees, our friends and those we encounter only once. If we stay true to the words of Scripture and live these words, we will not perish but will have eternal life.

These words demand that we live the life of the Lord Jesus who first showed us the love of the Father. The catch is this: we don't decide to do this on our own. Our God chooses us, and invites us from our baptism to live the life of the Lord only by the grace and power of God. We cannot do this on our own. That is why these Sunday celebrations of the Eucharist are so important because we are fed and nourished to go back out into our own world to be the Sons and Daughters of our God. Today we are sent into the world to show that everyone who believes will have eternal life. This is why we rejoice today, because we have the privilege of being God's messengers of his love and of his Gospel.
