## Reflection

Self destructive behavior repeated over and over again can soon become comfortable and enticing, as we find ourselves engaging and entwined in behaviors and certain ways of thinking that can become even attractive and addictive. This seems to be the case with the Israelites. Despite the subjugation of their task masters and the wretched life style they endured in Egypt, they found themselves longing to return to the hell-hole of slavery: ... *why did you ever make us leave Egypt? Was it just to have us die here of thirst with our children and our livestock* (Exodus 17). Their momentary discomfort in the desert seems to have skewed the greater notion of being a free people. Imposed forced slave labor and the abuse of Egypt became more attractive. They longed again for the hell-hole of servitude because at least it was familiar. Change is difficult and our resistance to it is a way to avoid the risk of shattering the vicious cycle we often find ourselves caught in especially if we fear the challenge of what a change might bring about.

The Gospel presents an interesting encounter between Jesus and a woman at the well who also found her "own hole of refuge." Although according to the story she is a foreign woman (from the perspective of the Jews) her rhetoric and the barriers of centuries and culture do not obscure the image she has created: She flaunts her individuality. Her story suggests that she is adaptable, resourceful, self-sufficient and reliant. Life has obviously not been easy for her, but she asks for no pity. Her manner is self-assured even bold. Her mind is facile and her tongue is sharp. She enjoys the company of men and has the experience of matching wits with any of them. Her multiple marriages seem to put her at ease with men, however, to women she was a threat. She was the subject of gossip. It is certainly no coincidence that she chooses to come to the well at midday, the hottest time of the day in the desert, when no other women would even think of drawing water. There is a loneliness and emptiness behind her bravado.

The conversation that transpires with Jesus is brisk, but quickly is transformed by his prompting from "small talk" to shaking the self-confidence of this unidentified woman from her complacency: ... *He told me everything I ever did* (John 4). Each day the woman draws water from the well and hears Jesus offer her "water that will quench her thirst forever..." (John 4) and it is she who challenged the stranger for not having a bucket to draw water, ends up leaving her own jug behind (John 4) ... Her priorities have radically changed. She realizes "her hell-hole" and just how empty she was: So many men, but so *little* love. Jesus pierces her pain. The barriers the woman created in her life do not seem to matter anymore. What Jesus offers is an alternative to the need to keep jumping into the hole: ... *if you know the gift of God and who is saying to you, 'Give me a drink,' you would have asked him and he would have given you living water* (John 4). The woman recovered life because of a stranger at the well who did not come to judge or criticize or condemn, but merely point out that the many choices she was making to satisfy her thirst were inept and will surely fail to satisfy her deepest longing. Like the woman, we too substitute God for what we believe will subvert our pain and self-deception. Today, Jesus says the same thing to us as he did to the Samaritan women: ... *give me a drink* (John 4). The risk is whether we like the woman, are willing to enter into a dialogue with Jesus that will radically transform the priorities of our own lives so the next time we walk down the road we will no longer need to jump into the hole.

One of the most exceptional aspects of Saint Angela Merici is the feeling of welcome and belonging: We are part of something much greater than any one person. Our parish connects us as neighbors, a community, and as a People of God and followers of Christ. The dedication of our people, the gifts, time, talent, and treasure that are shared so generously have created a faith community that is vibrant, alive, and filled with the Spirit of Christ.

Your Stewardship support for the Pastoral Services Appeal last year has allowed our Diocese to continue to foster the many ministries of Faith Formation, Outreach, and social and community activities. We were also able to continue to foster the ministries of our parish particularly with our parish outreach (Bread of Angels and the ACT Office) and our Youth, Jr. High, and Young Adult Ministries, (Steubenville, Pets for Vets, Winter Wonderland, Spiritual and Personal Growth Evenings for youth and young adults, and Adoration and Prayer and Praise evenings) which our parishioners have always held as a very high priority at each Parish Assembly in the last ten years. In addition, we were able to enhance and complete many upgrades of our site that were in need of our attention after fifty years: Complete the roof work in Saint John Vianney and in the Parish Center Offices as well as replace the air condition/heat systems, resurface and stripe the black-top of the parking lot on Fir Street, provide special parking spaces for our seniors for easy access to the church for mass, the care and enhancement of our landscaping and the painting of our site. We are currently in the process of completing the work on our Roland Digital Grand Piano and reviewing the options for an organ since the original instrument, because of age was evaluated as an extreme fire hazard. Repairing the organ would be more than purchasing another, and if moved (as planned to the Choir Area) would take up over half of the space needed for our choirs). Finally, we are in contact with the Diocese of Orange and the City of Brea to move forward with the LED Parish Signage on Walnut Avenue. These are a few of our projects that have transpired because of your support and care. Our vision for this PSA 2017 is to continue to support our Youth, Jr. High, and Young Adult Ministries and to supplement the purchase of an organ for our parish.

It is our belief that Saint Angela Merici has consistently been generous stewards when specific endeavors or projects for ministry and the life of the parish are warranted, so it is important to listen to your heart as we begin PSA 2017. Your pledge is very important to the work, ministry, and the growth of our parish. This year's presenters, Susie and Dave Beas, Chris Blake, and Carolyn Lamka will share their own personal faith journey and how Saint Angela Merici has enabled them and their families to embrace more intimately their Catholic-Christian identity. As you reflect on your pledge, remember all stewardship is returned to our parish once we have met our pledge-goal of One Hundred and Two Thousand Dollars) \$102,000.00 This year we are asking for each person (family) to pledge \$400.00 (Four Hundred Dollars) which is about \$33.00 a month or approximately \$8.25 a week. You may pledge on the envelopes provided in the pews or on the parish website or you may want to take a pledge envelope home and pray and discern about your stewardship support. Your response to God's generosity will certainly be evident in the experience of Church at Saint Angela Merici. Please pledge. Pledge now. Pledge to make a difference. Pledge to witness to your gratefulness to God and the desire to see us continue to faithfully fulfill our Gospel-mission as a Parish Faith Community. *Now is the Time!*


