## THE FOURTH SUNDAY OF LENT

### MARCH 22, 2020



# REFLECTION

Jesus is a miracle healer. He has performed many a miraculous cure to those who seek it. This Sunday's miracle in the gospel of John is a bit different than any other healing that Jesus performed. First, Jesus approached a blind man who did not ask to be cured. The gospel said, "As Jesus passed by, he saw a man blind from birth." After answering the disciples' question, he spat on the ground and made clay with the saliva and smeared the clay on the blind man's eyes. Then, he told the blind man to wash in the Pool of Siloam (verse 6-7). This gesture reminds us of the first creation in Genesis 2:7, how God initiated the creation of man by means of clay and breath. Jesus was imitating the Father using clay as a tool to create new light in the blind man.

Second, the difference between this miracle and the others is the story did not just end in a cure but continued with a discussion about the cure between the blind man who can see and the Pharisees who cannot see. In many other miraculous healings, Jesus demonstrated he has the power to cure and he is the Son of God. But in this healing, he wanted to make clear he is the light of the world (verse 5) and he passed on this light to the blind man and through the blind man who saw the light, passed it on to those who didn't see.

In this reading we also see the evangelist playing with the meanings of the word "sent." In verse 4, Jesus said we must do the works of the one who 'sent' me. Then he 'sent' the blind man to the Pool of Siloam (the word Siloam in Hebrew means 'sent'). This story did not end with the healing, since there was a greater purpose to be revealed. Following the healing, the man whose sight had been restored was sent to be the witness of the light of Jesus to those who don't see (the Pharisees).

During this second scrutiny Sunday of every year, we accompany the ones who seek the light of the world as they journey toward being baptized at the vigil of Easter. At the same time, we remind ourselves of our duty of being "sent" to continue to carry the light of Jesus to others.

# INTERESTED IN RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION?

As a result of the COVID-19 virus, there's a huge number of people who are homebound. Some due to age, some because of a medical condition, and many who just don't want to risk being potentially exposed to the virus. Many homebound are friends, family members or neighbors and now that we have suspended Mass they're unable to receive Holy Communion. They need your help.

One way you get to receive Holy Communion, is by bringing Holy Communion to someone else. All you need to do is purchase a pyx at a Catholic bookstore or go on line. Bring your pyx to Church before we expose the Blessed Sacrament at 8am or repose the Blessed Sacrament at 6pm and ask the Priest for assistance. There is a beautiful little prayer service that accompanies the reception of Holy Communion.

## SHELTER IN PLACE

In an emergency like a chemical spill or perhaps, our current situation with the Corona virus pandemic, you may be told to "shelter in place". This means to make the place where you are a safe place to stay until the danger has passed. Shelter in place orders are given when it would be dangerous for you to go outside.

**Notification** - Warning sirens may be used to warn people that it is not safe to be outside. Emergency responders may go door to door in the affected area. They may also use loudspeakers from police or fire vehicles to give instructions. Information will also be given over television and radio using the Emergency Alert System.

**What to do in a hazardous materials incident** - The first thing to do when a chemical spill or similar event occurs is to get information. Turn on the television or radio to find out if your area is affected and what steps to take. Never call 911 to get information about an emergency. Only call 911 if you are injured or need assistance.

If you are told to shelter in place you should close all doors and windows and shut off fans and air conditioners. Take your family to a room with as few doors and windows as possible. You may be told to put towels or tape around the cracks of the windows and doors. Follow emergency instructions carefully. Make sure you take a battery-powered radio so you will know when the danger has passed. Power in your area may be shut off during the incident.

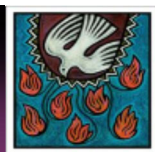

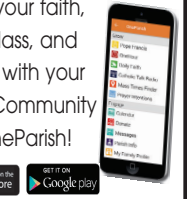

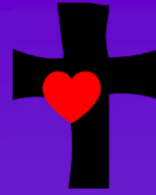
