

### Reflection

About once a month I'm scheduled to preach at three or four masses. I'm very blessed - some deacons only get to preach during the week only once or twice but I'm able to preach a bit more and I'm very grateful for that.

We live out near Corona and this past weekend I wasn't scheduled here, so Rachel and I went to the local parish for their 10:30

mass. It's nice to go to mass 5 minutes from the house. Last weekend we babysat our wonderful 20 month old grandson. His parents had a date night so we had a sleep over with Jacob. Rachel brought a number of quiet toys for him to play with. During the first reading, I held him. We started looking at a book, which took about 12 seconds. Rachel then held out a sheet of small stickers, which Jacob started putting on his hands and then the side of my face, this really kept him occupied. We stood for the Gospel with Jacob placing more stickers on me until almost half my face was covered. Then he started taking them off and throwing them on the floor, which we then had to pick up. As I was trying to pray and listen to the Gospel and homily, I realized this wasn't working so well. Which brought me to this thought: I forgot what it was like to have young children. Parents can hardly pray because their kids are all over the place, playing with envelopes and missalettes, looking around, smelling everything and then having to go to the bathroom. I realized how hard it must be for you parents. And we don't make it easy. Every so often, parents are chastised by other parishioners who tell them things like 'hey, I'm trying to pray here and your kids won't let me" or "Can't you control them?"

My brothers and sisters, these kids and these parents and families are gifts from God. You know why kids mess around, why they're constantly moving, because God made them that way. Parents, thank you so much for being here Sunday after Sunday. You are examples to your children and to us! You bring us life!

Jesus has been appearing to his apostles over the last three weeks after his resurrection and trying desperately to convince them that he has been raised from the dead. Today, he told them he was not a ghost, don't be frightened, look, give me something to eat and you'll see that I'm not a ghost, I eat and drink like you. They all ate a meal and they recognized him in the breaking of the bread. In the sharing and giving and taking and offering, just like we do when we sit down to eat. Let's recognize Jesus in everyone we meet. Even in the crying babies. Let us be present to each other. When we eat, shut off devices, pay attention to one another. He is not a ghost, let us see Jesus in each other.

Let's praise our God for these lives around us; for the babies and kids and parents and older folks because we are all sons and daughters of our loving God. And because our Lord Jesus Christ has risen as he said and let us truly rejoice and be glad, Alleluia, Alleluia!



## What is Eucharistic Adoration or Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament?

Understood simply, Eucharistic Adoration is adoring or honoring the Eucharistic Presence of Jesus Christ. In a deeper sense, it involves "the contemplation of the Mystery of Christ truly present before us". During Eucharistic Adoration, we "watch and wait", we remain "silent" in His Presence and open ourselves to His Graces which flow from the Eucharist ... By worshiping the Eucharistic Jesus we become what God wants us to be! Like a magnet, The Lord draws us to Himself and gently transforms us. In its fullest essence ... Eucharistic Adoration is "God and Man reaching out for each other, at the same time!"

The Eucharist is: Jesus truly present - Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity! At the moment of Consecration, during the Mass, the "gifts" of bread and wine are transformed (transubstantiated) into the actual Body and Blood of Christ, at the Altar. This means that they are not only spiritually transformed, but rather are actually (substantially) transformed into the Body and Blood of Christ. The elements retain the appearance of bread and wine, but are indeed the actual Body and Blood of Christ. This is what is meant by Real Presence: the actual, physical presence of Jesus in the Eucharist.
