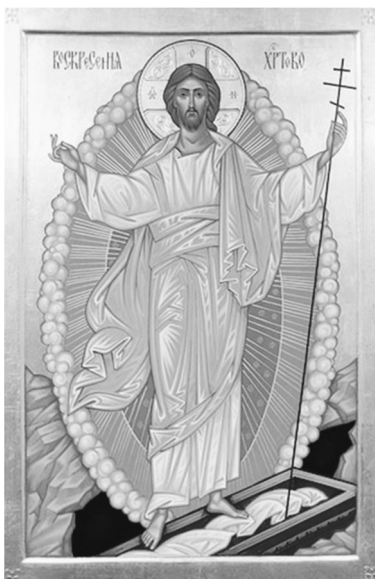

# Reflection

*Sisters and Brothers: Are you aware that we who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death ... so just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might live in the newness of life ... we know that Christ raised from the dead dies no more; death no longer has power over him ... you must think of yourselves as ...living for God in Christ Jesus (Romans 6-Easter Vigil)*

Easter is a unique feature of Christianity, not because more people go to church, but because it celebrates the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. Christianity teaches that its founder is living today, here and now! No other religion make such a startling claim. Various faiths state that the "spirit" of their founder lives on in their teachings and in their actions and lived life, but Christianity claims that Jesus died, but then arose physically and appeared to many on several different occasions (Acts 10-Easter Sunday). Christianity stands

or falls on this point. Christianity is not based on ethical or religious teachings, but on a historical event! The foundation of our faith is not just what Jesus taught, but what God did in Jesus in history.

Paul's letter to the Romans (Romans 6-Easter Vigil) addresses those who were having difficulty with the resurrection. They were doubting the resurrection of Christ. The resurrection of the body was hard to grasp for the people of Paul's time (as it is for us today) and this theological concept is still a tremendous challenge even to our sophisticated technological minds. Paul directed the attention of the Romans to the notion... *that if we died with Christ, we believe that we shall live with him. We know that Christ raised from the dead, dies no more; death no longer has power over him ... consequently, you must think of yourself as ... living in Christ Jesus (Romans 6-Easter Vigil)*. Paul's contention is that if God raised Jesus from the dead, he will do the same for us. As far as Paul was concerned, resurrection is the cornerstone of our faith: *...if we have grown into union with him through a death like his, we shall be untied with him in the resurrection (Romans 6-Easter Vigil)*.

Without Easter we would ... *remain old yeast, the yeast of malice and wickedness (Colossians-Easter Sunday)*. There would be no hope beyond what we experience life to be. As Paul states, we would remain unleavened (1 Corinthians 5-Easter Sunday). As it is, *Christ is Risen*, and Easter thrusts us forward into a world that sometimes finds itself in the grip of stopping us dead in our tracks, but it is Christ's resurrection which inaugurates the validity of life over death. If Jesus were not risen from the dead then death would have the final word, and we would truly be the most sorry of people, yet as Paul reminds us, Christ resurrection is the bold proclamation that life always overcomes death and resurrection is the theological-spiritual belief that life is reversible because God raised Christ from the dead. We no longer are left to walk a path that leads from the depths of darkness, but are lavished with the gift of the newness of life not just once, but over and over and over and over again ... as many times as it takes (Pope Francis)! It is precisely because of this belief that we are not a people who look backwards. *We are a resurrected people in Christ, and it is the resurrection that is the impetus that boldly proclaims Now Is Always The Time to keep moving forward and never looking back at what was, but envisioning what can be ...*

*Have a Blessed Easter!*

*Christ is Risen! Christ is Risen! Christ is Truly Risen! Alleluia! Amen!*

*Reflection:*

*How do we experience resurrection in our lives? Do we experience being physically redeemable by God in the midst of life situations that can sometimes convince us that God cannot possibly value, embrace, care, and love us? How does the experience of resurrection provide us with the hope and willingness to continue to move forward?*



## **NOW IS THE TIME FOR RESURRECTION**

In the most fundamental sense, love realizes itself most fully when it is demonstrated. The Resurrection is such a demonstration. Jesus overcomes all obstacles that obscure the immensity, intensity and scope of God's love for us. We have not always realized fully the depth and intimacy of our relationship with God, but we're working on it. Often, it is difficult for many to accept the enormity of the gift we have been given through Christ Jesus. Perhaps this Easter, after realizing *Now Is The Time* to deepen our relationship with God, we might have expanded our capacity for Mercy, Mutuality and Mindfulness. to become centered in our relationship with God the Father through Jesus the Son. By simply: 1) accepting God's love as it is expressed in the passion, death, and resurrection of Jesus 2) being grateful for all that unfolds in our life 3) trusting and surrendering to the flow of reality, so we might actually find ourselves becoming increasingly aware of our deep connection through our life in the Resurrection.

Did the Apostles run to the tomb to welcome Jesus back from the dead? The Gospels indicate that they did not. In the canonical Gospels, there does not appear to be any witnesses to the Resurrection to the events that occurred afterwards. In a skeptical world, there is always the possibility that details, such as chronology, can get mixed up. Perhaps they misremembered the order of the actual events. In the end, faith is not about evidence. Faith is about trust in our relationship with God.

When confronted with the reality of the empty tomb, we can fill it with mostly wonder or doubt (or a combination of the two). Any sense of certainty, while seemingly desirable, neither fills nor satisfies the deeper questions the Paschal Mystery engenders. When we are focused in the now of relationship, we find ourselves within a framework large enough to grasp the enormity of the love God has for each of us, as demonstrated by the events of Holy Week.

Realization of such a mystery was expressed by St. Paul when he wrote in the letter to the Romans: *For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor present things, nor future things, nor powers, nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord* (Romans 8:38-39). I wonder, if we lived with that conviction, how would it influence the way we live, and move, and have our being in the world?

Perhaps, communion with God (the most concrete sign of our relationship) is not entirely up to us, but perhaps is God's choice as much, or more, than our own. If we can "realize" our relationship in such a way, perhaps we might more truly know that ... *Now Is The Time!* May the blessings of Easter arouse in us the sentiment expressed in Psalm 51, *Restore into me the joy of my salvation.*



One of the most exceptional aspects of Saint Angela Merici is the feeling of welcome and belonging: We are part of something much greater than any one person. Our parish connects us as neighbors, a community, and as a People of God and followers of Christ. The dedication of our people, the gifts, time, talent, and treasure that are shared so generously have created a faith community that is vibrant, alive, and filled with the Spirit of Christ.

Your Stewardship support for the Pastoral Services Appeal last year has allowed our Diocese to continue to foster the many ministries of Faith Formation, Outreach, and social and community activities. We were also able to continue to foster the ministries of our parish particularly with our parish outreach (Bread of Angels and the ACT Office) and our Youth, Jr. High, and Young Adult Ministries, (Steubenville, Pets for Vets, Winter Wonderland, Spiritual and Personal Growth Evenings for youth and young adults, and Adoration and Prayer and Praise evenings) which our parishioners have always held as a very high priority at each Parish Assembly in the last ten years. In addition, we were able to enhance and complete many upgrades of our site that were in need of our attention after fifty years: Complete the roof work in Saint John Vianney and in the Parish Center Offices as well as replace the air condition/heat systems, resurface and stripe the black-top of the parking lot on Fir Street, provide special parking spaces for our seniors for easy access to the church for mass, the care and enhancement of our landscaping and the painting of our site. We are currently in the process of completing the work on our Roland Digital Grand Piano and reviewing the options for an organ since the original instrument, because of age was evaluated as an extreme fire hazard. Repairing the organ would be more than purchasing another, and if moved (as planned to the Choir Area) would take up over half of the space needed for our choirs). Finally, we are in contact with the Diocese of Orange and the City of Brea to move forward with the LED Parish Signage on Walnut Avenue. These are a few of our projects that have transpired because of your support and care. Our vision for this PSA 2017 is to continue to support our Youth, Jr. High, and Young Adult Ministries and to supplement the purchase of an organ for our parish.

It is our belief that Saint Angela Merici has consistently been generous stewards when specific endeavors or projects for ministry and the life of the parish are warranted, so it is important to listen to your heart as we begin PSA 2017. Your pledge is very important to the work, ministry, and the growth of our parish. This year's presenters, Susie and Dave Beas, Chris Blake, and Carolyn Lamka will share their own personal faith journey and how Saint Angela Merici has enabled them and their families to embrace more intimately their Catholic-Christian identity. As you reflect on your pledge, remember all stewardship is returned to our parish once we have met our pledge-goal of One Hundred and Two Thousand Dollars) \$102,000.00 This year we are asking for each person (family) to pledge \$400.00 (Four Hundred Dollars) which is about \$33.00 a month or approximately \$8.25 a week. You may pledge on the envelopes provided in the pews or on the parish website or you may want to take a pledge envelope home and pray and discern about your stewardship support. Your response to God's generosity will certainly be evident in the experience of Church at Saint Angela Merici. Please pledge. Pledge now. Pledge to make a difference. Pledge to witness to your gratefulness to God and the desire to see us continue to faithfully fulfill our Gospel-mission as a Parish Faith Community. *Now is the Time!*
