## Divine Mercy Sunday

Today is not only the second Sunday of Easter, but the completion of the octave of Easter and the Feast of Divine Mercy.

On the first anniversary of the founding of Divine Mercy Sunday, John Paul the second recalled, "Jesus said to St. Faustina one day: "Humanity will never find peace until it turns with trust to Divine Mercy." This is the Easter gift the Church receives from the risen Christ and offers to humanity.

In today's Gospel, Jesus came and stood in the mist and said to them, "Peace be with you." When he said this, he showed them his hands and his side. The disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord. Jesus said to them again, 'Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me so I send you.'

Thomas, called Didymum, is known as doubting Thomas because he declared, 'Unless I see the mark of the nails in his hands, put my finger into the marks, and put my hand into his side, I will not believe.' Thomas had difficulty believing. He may have been suspicious of the claims of his fellow apostles, who were still mourning, but were amazed by the resurrection of Jesus. Jesus appeared a second time for Thomas' sake. He went immediately to Thomas and showed him his hands and side, and exhorted him stop doubting. With humility and affection, Thomas exclaimed, "My Lord and my God!" Thomas was ready for his mission. Jesus then declared, "Those who have come to believe even without seeing or touching him are blessed."

The first reading says many signs and wonders happen through the hands of the apostles; Thomas included. Because of this, more and more became believers. Jesus would refer to them as blessed.

In the second reading, John writes that he is imprisoned because he has been proclaiming God's word and bearing witness to Jesus. He lived in an era when believing in Jesus was regarded a crime. Now, we willingly believe in Jesus and commit ourselves to Him.

My brothers and sisters every day we celebrate mass, our Lord Jesus is in the midst of all of us saying the same words, peace be with you. Think about it when the priest or deacon says, 'brothers and sisters share with each other a sign of peace' 'It is a moment for us to give our brothers and sisters signs of peace which come from the heart.

God Bless you all not just during this Easter season but always.





A few days ago, Andrea Draper sent an email to those of us, who are participating in the parish's RCIA. She asked each of us for short bio covering our journey to faith and how we are feeling now. The bios were for the Easter Bulletin. I am a very private person. The thought of having my story in the Bulletin had no appeal. I still do not believe anyone will find it interesting. However, in the end, I thought I should comply for two reasons. First, I feel a great debt of gratitude to Andrea, the rest of the RCIA team and those who are going through the process with me. Secondly, it gives me the opportunity to thank everyone who is a part of the St Angela Merici Catholic Church for welcoming me. During my recent Rite of Election, I heard our deacon refer to St. Angela's as the "Welcoming Parish." I have to say, "Amen!"

I am the oldest person who is now participating in the parish's RCIA. I spent my childhood going to Sunday school in a Baptist church, which did not believe in infant baptism or dancing. Before I could be baptized, the great Mambo and Cha Cha Cha craze of the 1950's hit. My parents started taking dance lessons. Soon after, we stopped going to the Baptist church. But we held onto our faith. Through life's struggles and my missteps, I have continued to hold fast to it.

I have been blessed and shown an abundance of unmerited grace and mercy throughout my life. I attended a Catholic university (Hoya Saxa!) where I met the woman I love. I still cannot believe how lucky I was to find her. We were married in a chapel on campus. Our son was baptized and raised Catholic. I have had the pleasure of seeing him grow-up to be a better person than me. But something has been missing. Through the decades, I remained an unbaptized Christian without a spiritual home. I have always been on the outside. When I went to mass with my family, I had to watch while they and the others received communion and fully participated in the Eucharist.

While looking for a spiritual home, I attended services at a number of Catholic and non-Catholic churches. I never felt like I belonged until I started coming to mass at your church. This led me to RCIA, my Catechumenate and Election. During the Easter Vigil, I will join the parish's other Elect and receive the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and the Eucharist. I will no longer be on the outside. Better late than never.


