Reflection

Peace Be With You!

53 days ago many of us gathered in this church to celebrate the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper. In that celebration, Jesus showed us what being a disciple was all about: it was about being of service to the least of our brothers and sisters. It was about welcoming them and attending to them with our whole heart and soul, it was about following Jesus to the cross: to a horrible death.

When we celebrated Easter Sunday, we celebrated Jesus' victory over sin, our redemption; we celebrated our call to heaven. Now we celebrate Pentecost when the Holy Spirit comes upon us with power. Up to now, I haven't told you anything new. We've all heard this before. Here are a few things that may change the way we look at Pentecost:

1. In John's Gospel, the Resurrection and Pentecost happen on the same day: the first day of the week. His followers were in fear of their lives, they just didn't know what was going on because the one they all loved had just been executed a couple of days before. The Crucifixion of Jesus was a tremendous blow to the disciples. Think of the tremendously hard blows that we've experienced.
2. Maybe it's just me, but my imagination of that descent of the Holy Spirit upon the disciples does not describe in any way the power that took place in the room where the disciples found themselves. I envision the disciples sitting around with little fires over their heads. The pictures coming out of Hawaii of the Kilauea volcano show in a minuscule way the power of God: creation is still taking place and the power behind this newest chapter of creation is God. The disciples were filled with this power that came in the form of wind and fire.
3. The power I just described, enabled the disciples to leave behind the fear they were experiencing and move out of that room and start sharing the fire of love and mercy with all the people in Jerusalem. There were people from every part of the Jewish world, people who spoke different languages and from different cultures and the disciples were given the power to communicate with them to tell the story of Jesus and his love and mercy.

It was only through the power from the Spirit that the disciples were able to do one more thing: to forgive. Priests are the only ones who can give absolution and forgive in God's name. We, however, are called to forgive those things done to us: the words people we love say to us that hurt us; the things people around us do to belittle us takes our dignity away. Jesus tells us to forgive, to let go of things. It is by doing this that we will finally experience the Peace that Jesus gives to us. Today, let us go outside of ourselves; let us forgive those who have hurt us. May we today experience the incredible power of God's love and may we give that love to everyone we meet, no matter who they are, and no matter how different they are from us. May we see them as our brothers and sisters of our one God and Father!




Christ's Healing Presence


