## Reflection

Do you ever notice that God often cuts something out of our lives just when we decide to keep it? When we finally begin to get comfortable, God is right there trying to rearrange our lives! Perhaps this may be the case because many times, despite our comfortability, we are not in the place God wants us to be! Many of us live in "fast freeze." Things look great on the surface, but underneath, we are driven and fueled by a myriad of emotions, feelings, thoughts, and unsaid desires which we tuck away and lock behind closed doors except for those moments to our embarrassment or horror, these hidden emotions make their way to the surface. This is the image of the apostles in today's Gospel. We too like the followers of Jesus have huddled ourselves behind closed doors (John 20). The imagery in today's word, for many of us, is an accurate portrait of our lived-experience.

Pentecost is about God's desire to give us a complete make-over. Often however, our response is to hold on to our perceptions of life, ourselves and one another that lure us to live in fear rather than embrace God's gift to be set free. Today's Gospel presents God breaking through the protective package of the apostle's lives. The Acts of the Apostles (Acts 2) is an expose of how God desires a complete transformation of our minds and hearts. I believe most of us want and desire to experience Pentecost in our lives. We have a deep desire for the gift of the Spirit to release us, but like the disciples we too find ourselves huddling behind the history of our old ways of perceiving ourselves and God, so when God pours out his Spirit to bust open and break through the barriers he finds us locked behind the closed doors of our lives.

First and foremost Pentecost is not simply about "rearranging the chairs on the titanic" (of our lives, which we often do, to convince ourselves we have really changed). Nor is it about tweaking our lives. *It is about a conversion in character and conduct.* Pentecost is about a radical turn around. Perhaps this is the reason the doors and windows of our hearts are often shut tight: We are afraid of the change God may be asking of us. An authentic experience of Pentecost is when we allow God to rid us of whatever is holding us back. It is not about settling. It is seeing the potential and possibilities that takes hold of our lives when we realize the power of God in our hearts. God did not want to see the disciples remain where they were, (they were not in the right place) and God does not want us to keep repeating the endless, spinning, fast freezing of our lives. He does not want us to simply continue to spin our wheels. He knows how disastrous and debilitating it can be to live behind closed doors that are shut tight. This is the reason he comes and breaths into what is lost, forgotten, dying, or dead.

Paul tells us: ... *no one can say, 'Jesus is Lord,' except by the Spirit (Acts 2).* To live in the realm of the Spirit is first and foremost about allowing God entrée into our lives. Pentecost is not just about boldly proclaiming that Jesus Christ is Lord. To authentically embrace Jesus as Lord, we like the disciples, must in the midst of our doubts and pain, open the windows of our lives and lay open what we have hidden for so long in order that the Spirit may vanquish the fear that often obscures and anesthetizes us. To live in the Spirit is to be set-free. It is not about refusing to allow our past hold us down and push us back. Pentecost proclaims with great audacity, that none of us freed by the Spirit can ever be held back again. It is only when we are set-free, when the windows and doors of our lives are opened, and fresh air plummets through the very fiber of our lives, that we can then stand up and shout with everything within us to the glory of God the Father that *Jesus Christ is Lord!*


