

The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

June 23, 2019



Reflection

Today, we honor the gift of Christ's body and blood. In the second reading we hear the earliest account of the last supper in the New Testament. The words Jesus speaks are the same words we hear spoken over the bread and the wine at every Eucharistic celebration. "This is my Body...[This is] My Blood... Do this in memory of me."

Our remembering is not a passive action recalling an event, which took place many centuries ago. Instead, it is a dynamic living of this past event in the present moment. Here, in this church, Jesus is present to us once more in the bread and the wine, his Body and Blood. Jesus gives himself to us completely.

We might pause to ask ourselves, how present are we to Jesus? How willing are we to completely give ourselves to him? Jesus' quiet time between him and the disciples is disrupted by the crowds that trail them to Bethsaida. They follow him, bringing along their sick relatives. Jesus adjusts his plans and welcomes people who are in need to His circle. The twelve do not imbibe Jesus' goodwill and generosity for the people. They suggest Jesus send the crowd away. They do not want to get involved any further. By their reckoning, they have already done enough.

Having to heal the sick the whole day, Jesus has compassion for the people and asks the Twelve to give them something to eat. The apostles find the situation impossible, but Jesus takes their very meager resources(five loaves and two fish), looks up to heaven, blesses and breaks them, and gives them to the disciples to set before the crowd.

Participating in the Eucharist must become a school of communion with Christ, which teaches us to open ourselves to God, to his will on behalf of goodness, love, and consequently, on behalf of others, for the real needs of those who surround us.

It is for that reason, today's Gospel brings together a whole Eucharistic environment such as the multiplication of the loaves, in which Jesus teaches us if we give up the little we have, He will exercise his power to multiply it to feed everyone around us. The Eucharist is food for the soul, but it is also a school of love and of solidarity, in which we learn to share with others all we have for those who are in need.






