

# Reflection



"Whatever is now covered up will be uncovered and every secret will be made known."

One of my father's favorite sayings, (although it certainly was not the favorite of all of us at home) was: *Speak the truth and leave the room!* I can see the wisdom in this saying, although I know the truth may not always be received well. In today's word, Jesus encourages his disciples to speak up. How hard it must have been for them to hear this advice, simply, because living under the conditions of their time, in the milieu of the social, religious, and political atmosphere, being truthful might

very well cost them their lives. While times are different, circumstances are not. The fears of the disciples are still echoed in our experience: ... *I hear the whisperings of many: 'Terror on every side! Denounce! Let us denounce him! ... All those who were my friends are on the watch for any misstep of mine'* ... (Jeremiah 20). Perhaps, this is the reason Jesus' words need to resonate again and again in our hearts and lives today.

How easy it is to remain silent in the midst of what we know is wrong. How easy it is to face evil and do nothing because we are afraid. How easy it is not to take responsibility for what we know we should be saying and choose to remain quiet: ... *what I say to you in the darkness, speak in the light; what you hear whispered, proclaim on the housetops* (Matthew 10). Sometimes our fear of the truth overrides the command of Jesus.

God's word today confronts our fears. We are challenged to consider what is behind our "hiding or disguising" our willingness to speak up under the guise of polite etiquette: ... *do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul* ... (Matthew 10). Jesus wants us to look at the heart of the "stuff" we are made of: What do we stand for? In the end as Jesus states (Matthew 10) everything will be revealed and not only will the truth be revealed, but we will be revealed for who we truly are (behind all the disguises), the stuff we are made of, and silence will no longer be silent! Those who have chosen to maintain their interests will find themselves confronted by the screaming truth of the injustice of their silence!

Certainly, not everyone who speaks up states the truth. All of us know there are those who habitually speak up only for their personal interests, but the reason they get away with it is because we remain silent. Our unwillingness to speak the truth continually empowers them to foster even further their destructiveness on the innocent. Jesus never allowed the loudest to get away with a lie! He steps up to the plate and speaks out, and in the end, the truth was eventually revealed about who was who and what was what. Maybe one of the truths that we need to embrace today might be speaking up against those who always speak up!

The word today is about the truth of life. Our love of God cannot simply substantiate our faith experience because love without the truth has very little substance. One wonders if living a shallow life is worth being rejected by Jesus as he states boldly in today's Gospel (Matthew 10). Jesus is looking for a depth in our lives: Whether we will stand by and allow a wrong to take place or allow death to overcome life, Jesus feelings are very clear. Allowing silence to triumph over the truth is a sin. The gift of Jesus himself is that the life he lived in the truth overcame sin by putting himself on the line. We have come to realize that the one who spoke out gave everything that his life may overflow into the lives of many. May we be like Jesus: Willing to authentically, without regard of our own self interests, fears, and the ramifications to stand up, step up, speak the truth, and be the truth.

## Farewell from Father Loc

A priest, at least in my own reflection, is a recipient of so many blessings. Blessings that flow from the sacrament of Holy Orders rooted in baptismal grace, blessings from parishioners who accept him, who counsel restraints regarding his impulses, who, in their daily prayers remember him. The blessings a priest receives come in different ways and not a few times quite unexpectedly: the privilege of listening to the confession of a soul so obviously holy and deeply in love with God that brought tears to his heart; the permission to enter sacred and intimate circle reserved for close family members as they mourn the death of their loved ones; the invitation to their home to share a bottle of red wine and a fabulous home-made dinner. What a privilege, what an honor!

To these blessings I owe you gratitude, deep gratitude.

THANK YOU, THANK YOU for your love and support. Thank you for your fidelity and witness to our Catholic Christian faith seemingly under appreciated or in the struggle for moral values, a faith that formed part of yours and my childhood in an age more wholesome. I am forever in debt to you.

Late January this year, I first learned of the possibility that my time at St. Angela Merici may be shortened. A diocesan priest is under obedience to his bishop. That morning of June 7, 2008 at Holy Family Cathedral in Orange, I was ordained by Bishop Tod Brown and made a promise to obey him and his successors.

When the call came in late February for a change of ministry, I said Yes. Starting in July, I will be working full time as a Detention Chaplain.

There is an appointed time for everything . . . . a time to plant, and a time to uproot the plant (Ecclesiastes 3:1-2).

There is a time for being together and a time to say goodbye. But whether we are in physical proximity or far off, in Christ we are bound as a people beloved to God. And grace reveals to us that in God's will is our peace.

It is with sadness, but more with confidence in the good Lord that I am leaving you at the end of June.

Please remember me & the detention ministry and my Mom in your prayers. Mom is always worried about her child, no matter how old he is.

I am leaving here with a grateful heart.



When Thunder Roars, Go Indoors Summer begins on June 21 and, according to the National Weather Service (NWS), increases in lightning strikes begin this season.

While the warm weather invites many outside activities, if you hear thunder, lightning is close enough to strike you. Take a moment during **National Lighting Safety Awareness Week (June 18-24)** to learn how to stay safe in a thunderstorm with tips from NWS.

#### Outdoors:

- When thunder roars, go indoors - move inside a sturdy building or hard top vehicle with the windows up as soon as you hear thunder.
- Do not take shelter in small sheds, gazebos, dugouts, bleachers, under isolated trees, or a convertible automobile.
- Avoid open fields, the top of a hill, or a ridge top.
- Stay away from water, wet items, such as ropes, and metal objects, such as fences and poles. Water and metal do not attract lightning but they are excellent conductors of electricity.

#### Indoors:

- Stay indoors. Stay inside at least 30 minutes after you hear the last clap of thunder.
- Do not touch anything plugged into an electrical outlet.
- Use a corded telephone only for emergencies; cordless and cellular phones are safe to use.
- Avoid contact with plumbing; do not wash your hands; and do not take a shower or bath.
