

Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Reflection

Throughout the centuries, many have speculated about Paul's thorn. Some have said it was a physical illness like recurring malaria, or an eye infection that impaired his vision. Others have thought it was a spiritual ailment like the pain of rejection or a demonic presence that constantly tested his faith and tempted him to sin. Whatever it was, and we shall never know, it caused Paul to be all the more dependent on Christ and to keep his eyes fixed on the Lord. Maybe in the long run, it is best we never know, otherwise we might miss the real reason of his sharing – that in our times of struggle we might learn from him and seek refuge in Christ.


In those very honest words, Paul shares not just his trials and challenges, but the very fact that he begged the Lord three times to remove this thorn. Here, he realizes that his weaknesses and failures before the world are what actually hollow out his personal spiritual depths. Here, Paul is emptied of any false illusions about his success, creating within him a space where God's power can truly dwell and expand. It is as if he stands spiritually naked before the Lord, vulnerable, open and yet in his weakness, at his strongest in Christ Jesus!

It is in this holy moment that Paul realizes whatever befalls him in this life, his first duty must be to Christ. Nothing else will do honor to God or pay true homage to the gift that God has given. Like Ezekiel from our first reading, Paul realizes that no matter what response he receives, he must be bold and courageous in his witness. He must accept, as Jesus pointed out in the Gospel, a prophet is not always accepted in his native place and that while many will accept the message, many more will reject it.

Perhaps this is where Paul's insight speaks to us this day. To be a disciple of Christ, we too, need to be courageous and faithful in all things, even if it runs contrary to the ways of the world or what is now socially acceptable. This is the first step in true Christian living. Today's readings also remind us that, like the prophets, we are sent into the world and that, like the Apostles, we will be challenged to explain and defend our faith before others. We cannot be believers who sit on the fence or disciples who are lukewarm or halfhearted in our commitment. Trying to reconcile the ways of this world with those of the Gospel will inevitably cause us to have to choose between the two.

Instead, we need to be believers who know of our need for God and believers who are always growing in our faith and prayer life. It is only when our courage, perseverance and fidelity are united with Christ and his mission that, like Paul and Ezekiel, we can humbly accept our own weaknesses and our need of God's grace and strength. Only then can we stand up more firmly grounded in our faith and in our relationship with Christ. Only then can we be truly strong when we're weak.

Welcome to the New Principal of **St. Angela Merici Parish School!!!**







BISHOP VANN ANNOUNCES "HOLY YEAR OF PREPARATION" FOR CHRIST CATHEDRAL DEDICATION

With the dedication of Christ Cathedral approaching, Most Rev. Kevin Vann, Bishop of Orange, has launched a year-long celebration calling for spiritual reflection and formation across the Diocese of Orange. Vann proclaimed the next 12 months to be a special "Holy Year of Preparation of Christ Cathedral" during a Mass on June 29 at Christ Cathedral Campus. "After years of planning, prayer and Faith, and due to the hard work and dedication of many and, by the Providence of God, we are approaching the completion of the renovation of Christ Cathedral," Vann said. Christ Cathedral will be dedicated on July 17, 2019. Once dedicated, the cathedral will be spiritual home of Orange County's 1.5 million Catholics. "I would be most pleased if the faithful were on fire for Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ and that his Holy Name be always on our lips as we prepare this place for Christ forever," Vann said.

***Where do you begin?** Well, you just begin from where you are now!

*Laying a strong foundation. Faith will be the foundation of your life. Make that foundation solid!

*Go slowly, make sure that you're satisfied with your own faith development before moving through each of the RCIA stages. Don't let pressure from anyone else make you move on.

*Briefly...RCIA stage 1: Just Looking. In the **Inquiry** stage, you're finding out about Jesus, Christianity, and the Catholic Church.

*RCIA stage 2: Learning about the Faith. In the **Catechumenate**, your faith has begun to develop. Now you need to learn and grow more.

*RCIA stage 3: Getting ready for rebirth! This period of **purification and enlightenment** is the final stage before receiving the Easter sacraments of initiation into the Church: baptism, confirmation and Eucharist.

*RCIA stage 4: Reflecting on the mysteries of the Mass. This stage of **mystagogy** during Easter is for continued reflection on the sacraments you have received at Easter, especially the Eucharist.
