Reflection

Who is my neighbor?

Of course, the answer is, all our fellow human beings. Isn't that obvious to those who are familiar with the teaching of Jesus? But, for some, it is not that clear who my neighbor is because of the meddling of the politicians in the issue of immigration. Recently, we are having more than the usual number of refugees seeking asylum at the border of our country from all over Central America. Are they our neighbors? They are not, according to the lawyer in the gospel of this Fifteenth Sunday, that is, before he had the conversation with Jesus. The lawyer in Luke's gospel knew better in the book of Leviticus that Jesus had quoted about loving one's neighbor had always been interpreted as referring only to fellow-Jews. The purpose of asking Jesus the question was to pressure him into supporting that interpretation. But now that ploy had backfired, instead of using the political and legal view to answer the question, Jesus used the moral view, in other words, the conscience to answer the question. Jesus used the example of love and mercy from the good Samaritan to the robber's victim, to force this Jewish lawyer to break that legal interpretation to admit that his age-old enemy the Samaritan is his neighbor. It wasn't easy for this Jewish lawyer but he would have looked very foolish if he had claimed that the Jewish priest or the Levite had acted like neighbors to the injured man.

We, as Catholics, today tend to use politics and legal venues to express our stand in moral issues. For example, we have spent our energy and money fighting the abortion law for almost half a century as if, when we won, no one would kill the unborn baby anymore. Killing is illegal, dumping plastic irresponsibly is illegal and yet we have people committing murder every day and many sea creatures die because of the illegal dumping of plastic. How do we change people's minds about killing the born and the unborn? Or, not to use plastic products that cannot be recycled? Jesus taught us a lesson today, how to change peoples minds. He used the love and mercy example of the good Samaritan to change the stone-cold-hearted lawyer.

To educate people using their conscience is a slow and elaborated process but it is necessary in order to have a long-term effect rather than using political means. Once we engage in political means, we become controlling, angry and even violent. We try to scream and yell to our opponents and see who has the bigger and louder voice. In fact, we did all that, and what was the result? Nothing has changed much. If we use our Lord's way to educate and imprint the conscience to our next generation by showing them the example of loving our neighbor, no matter who they are, we would have planted the seed of love in every child. Every important decision they make when they grow up, would use their conscience to decide. Moses reiterated the aspect of conscience in the first reading today in Deuteronomy 30:10-14. When Moses said to the Israelites in regards to keeping the Lord's commandments and statutes, he said, "For this command that I enjoin on you today is not too mysterious and remote for you. No, it is something very near to you, already in your mouth and in your heart; you have only to carry it out."

Conscience, the voice of God, is the best way to guide us to live harmoniously in this complex and diverse society. If we rely on the external force, like the law, to behave ourselves, we are not any different than the animals. The law has little effect on deterring crime, it is designed for punishment and revenge. If we start today to be good Samaritans wholeheartedly, who knows, in the future, there will be no more need for good Samaritans because there would be no more victims. —**Fr. Francis**




