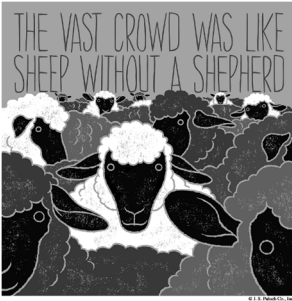

## Reflection

When I was a kid, the television I hated the most were news programs. News about politicians, policies, economies and what happened in other countries were not interesting to me. Just like most kids, I had my own little world, as long as there was food on the table and a roof over my head, I could care less which way the world turned. In the six years I spent in administering to the incarcerated, I realized most of them also had their own little world. The gangsters and the addicted had no idea of what was going on in their own country and around the world. Their world was so small that no matter how many times they had been in jail, it did not deter them from staying away from crime. It is because of their world being so small that being in jail is not much of a difference than living in the outside world.

This Sunday's gospel continues the journey of Jesus after the rejection in Nazareth by his kinsmen. In Nazareth, he was amazed by the little faith they had in him despite of all the miraculous healings he had done for them. Their world was so small and limited, like a child's that nothing could get into their heads. On the contrary, the crowd the disciples and Jesus met in this Sunday's gospel were hungry to know more about the kingdom of God. After hearing the preaching of the disciples and the explanation of the laws, their eyes opened and their minds were ready to know more about the wisdom of God through Jesus. Jesus was deeply touched by their enthusiasm and Mark described the emotion of Jesus in this way: "His heart was moved with pity for them". According to the professor of Scripture at Boston College School of Theology Michael Simone, S.J., the original Greek word the gospel used for heart is translated into "guts, bowels". So, the translation should be "He was moved in his guts for them." As the professor continued to say, it was quite a setback for Jesus at that time because of his kinsmen's rejection in Nazareth and the execution of John the Baptist. Watching the crowd hungry for the good news, stepping out from their own little world and embracing his was a moving experience for Jesus. Even though he and his disciples were exhausted and had not had time to eat, he continued to preach and let the disciples rest. Jesus knew what his mission was as described in the first reading, "I will appoint shepherds for them who will shepherd them so that they need no longer fear and tremble."

Even though Jesus was sad and tired, he did not forget his mission and the will of God. We all have difficulty and setbacks in our life, the question is when will it be the right time for us to evangelize? We all have answers as excuses, such as when the economy gets better; when the children have grown up a bit more; when I find a new job closer to my parish; etc. There is no right time to bring the good news to others. Jesus gave us this lesson today.

Today when I turn on the TV, the first thing I want to watch is the news. The world within me is much bigger now. The sports I used to play and watch as a kid no longer an effect on me. We must come out from our little world and embrace a bigger world. Only then do we have the interest to know more about the teachings of Jesus, because his teachings are about how to live with one another in harmony around the world. I was once among the crowd in Nazareth, and today I am among the crowd on the shore waiting for Jesus.

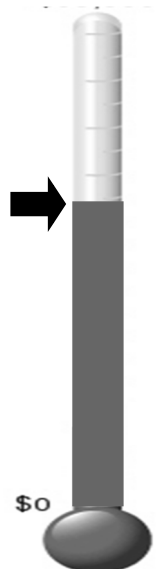

## **Important Change in our Posture during Mass**

From time to time it is worthwhile to examine why we do the things we do. This is especially true for us Catholics who wish to show proper reverence and awe for the Most Holy Eucharist. We know that what we do at Sacred Liturgy forms us, and others who observe us, in ways that sometimes supersedes words! This is especially true with bodily postures. With this in mind and to continue to foster devotion and belief in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist and in conformity to the General Instruction of the Roman Missal (GIRM) Bishop Vann has requested the faithful of the Diocese of Orange to begin kneeling after the Agnus Dei (Lamb of God), i.e. Lamb of God you take away the sins of the world, have mercy on us.....Lamb of God you take away the sins of the world, grant us peace. (please kneel at this time). If you have bad knees or in the case of infirmity and are unable to kneel please feel free to sit. Remain kneeling until the time you get up to receive Communion. Our actions and postures at Mass assist us in remembering that we are in the presence of the Bread come down from Heaven, God's very presence.

Our implementation date for this new practice will be towards the end of August. Please stand by for more details.
