

Reflection

"Glory to God in the highest and peace to his people on earth." The angels announced Christ's birth with these words. What happened to the peace the angels announced to the shepherds when we read the Gospel of this Twentieth Sunday of Ordinary Time? Jesus was sent not to bring peace but to set the earth on fire, in other words, to bring conflict and division to this earth and even among family members. No one would be spared – a father will be divided against his son and a daughter against her mother.

In general, we understand what Jesus was trying to say in the Gospel, that if you were a thief, there would be no peace in you when you see a police officer because there would always be conflict between a thief and the law. However, Jesus did not mention a thief and the law but the members within the family. He is talking about the way we are to conduct ourselves in our daily lives as we live together in a family. He is talking about our way of living; our relationship with one another in the family and in society. When one lives not in accordance with the teachings of Christ, one is in conflict with Christ and with those who follow His teachings.

Before we can set the earth on fire by following the teachings of Christ, we must first prepare ourselves to have a deep relationship with the Lord. In our church history, we know that almost all the reformers of religious orders came into conflict with their brothers and sisters within the same order. For example, the sixteenth century contemplative saint, John of the Cross, was involved in tremendous controversy and conflict in his efforts to reform his Carmelite Order. His work was strongly opposed by his brothers in the order. He was even imprisoned by some of them, locked up in a small cell and whipped several times a week, in an effort to get him to change direction and admit he had been in error. But, he was at peace with the measures he had taken. It was the darkness of his life during that period that provided him with the inspiration to begin his famous writing on spiritual darkness. Because of his deep relationship with the Lord, St. John of the Cross could survive the darkest night of his life.

We must learn from St. John of the Cross the importance of having that intimate relationship with Christ before we set the earth on fire without damaging consequences to ourselves and to our loved ones. Like Moses and Aaron entering the tent to consult the Lord (Nm 20:1-13), we must also enter into our deep conscience to consult with our Lord.

Even after consulting with the Lord, do we carry out as the Lord would command us to do? Moses did not and he suffered the consequences. He carried out the Lord's command with anger. After coming out from the tent, he hit the rock twice with his staff as he was ordered, and the water came out from the rock for the children of Israel to quench their thirst in the desert. But before he did so, he lashed out to the Israelites and said in anger: "Just listen, you rebels! Are we to produce water for you out of this rock?" Afterwards, the Lord said to Moses and Aaron that since they did not acknowledge his holiness before the Israelites, therefore, they shall not lead the Israelites into the promised land. (Nm 20:10-12) I hope we as Christians would have the courage to set the earth on fire, but at the same time develop an intimate relationship with our Lord to monitor the way we do it, and to make sure we are in accordance with his commands..




Originally from Pasadena, Fr. Sebastian Walshe is a Norbertine Canon of the Abbey of St. Michael in the Diocese of Orange, California, where he is a professor of philosophy for the seminary program. After completing his studies at Thomas Aquinas College in California, he continued studies at The Catholic University of America in Washington D.C., receiving a license in Philosophy. Later, he attended the Pontifical University of St. Thomas at Rome (the Angelicum) where he received a Masters in Sacred Theology and a Doctorate in Philosophy. His thesis was entitled: "The Primacy of the Common Good as the Root of Personal Dignity in the Doctrine of St. Thomas Aquinas." From 2003-2005, Fr. Sebastian was also a visiting professor in the Philosophy Department at the Angelicum.


