## Reflection


All of us would like to have some assurance when it comes to life. It is natural to desire some sense of predictability, but unfortunately when it comes to the Kingdom of God, there are no guarantees, no clear-cut signs, not even a badge or entrée card that will promise we are included in the Kingdom of God. The truth is, God's Kingdom is not so easily discernable nor is it something we possess just because we say we believe even if we have the proper credentials. God's Kingdom is not a club or organization that hands out membership cards. Perhaps this is the reason Jesus says: .... *strive to enter through the narrow gate, for many I tell you, will attempt to enter, but will not be strong enough* (Luke 13). Despite what we may think, the journey to the kingdom is not something in which the necessity is to complete all the prerequisites and then we have it made! This is a very hard concept for us to embrace because this is the way life works: sheer determination and know-how is almost a guarantee we will get what we want. Jesus makes it very clear when it comes to the Kingdom of God there is no moment in which we can simply believe we hold the trump-card so that when the time comes, we simply whip out the pass that will get us in the pearly gates! This is not the way it works: ... *After the master of the house has arisen and locked the door ... you will stand outside knocking and saying, 'Lord, open the door for us' ... and he will reply, 'I do not know where you are from' ... you will say, 'we ate and drank in your company ...'* (Luke 13).

There were those in Jesus' time who seriously thought they possessed the Kingdom of God in their hip-pocket: ... *we are followers of Abraham* (Luke 13). They believed because "they did it right" and "knew the right person" that the Kingdom of God was theirs. Jesus shatters their self-assurance and complacency: ... *people will come from the east and the west and from the north and the south and recline at the table in the Kingdom of God* (Luke 13). What a surprise it might be for those of us who think we are at the head of the line only to discover there are others who are standing in front of us! It is a spiritual disaster for us to put all our hopes on the externals, rank, station, affiliation or some particular demonstration of how we keep the law. Once we feel comfortable and content with ourselves then this is precisely the moment we have actually distanced and alienated ourselves from God's kingdom. Once we believe we "have arrived" then we cease to make the journey, seek the way, and strive to enter the narrow gate and begin to think that the gate or the door is "open wide" so all we need to do is sit back and relax. Jesus makes it extremely clear this is not how the Kingdom of God works: ... *strive to enter through the narrow gate ... for many I tell you, will attempt to enter, but will not be strong enough* (Luke 13). It takes "strength" to accept that the kingdom is never a guarantee.

Truly, the gate to the kingdom is narrow, and if we wish to enter we must seek to pass through the narrow door because that is the way to Jesus. Seeking the narrow road is about our willingness to embrace a vibrant relationship with God that does not depend on affiliation or our presumptions. We are participants in faith and not spectators! Jesus grinds against those who take God and their faith for granted and rails against those who have an entitlement mentality. Presumption has no place in the Kingdom of God. Only those who are willing to shed what prevents and inhibits them from ... *passing through the narrow gate*, rather than presuming their right to the kingdom will ever come to embrace the Kingdom that Jesus offers: ... *for behold some who are last will be first, and some are first who will be last ...* (Luke 13).



Pope Francis' document: *Amoris Laetitia – The Joy of Love* will be presented in a series each week during the Year of Mercy. It is an easy-reading document and inspires us to become a People of Mercy. We are presenting *The Joy of Love* in its original English translation without commentary as an avenue of reflection and prayer during this Liturgical Year of Mercy.

## The Eighteenth in the Series



Show affection and concern for the other person. Love surmounts even the worst barriers. When we love someone, or when we feel loved by them, we can better understand what they are trying to communicate. Fearing the other person as a kind of “rival” is a sign of weakness and needs to be overcome. It is very important to base one’s position on solid choices, beliefs or values, and not on the need to win an argument or to be proved right. Finally, let us acknowledge that for a worth-while dialogue we have to have something to say. This can only be the fruit of an interior richness nourished by reading, personal reflection, prayer and openness to the world around us. Otherwise, conversations become boring and trivial. When neither of the spouses works at this, and has little real contact with other people, family life becomes stifling and dialogue impoverished.

The Second Vatican Council teaches that this conjugal love “embraces the good of the whole person; it can enrich the sentiments of the spirit and their physical expression with a unique dignity and ennable them as the special features and manifestation of the friendship proper to marriage.” For this reason, a love lacking either pleasure or passion is insufficient to symbolize the union of the human heart with God: “All the mystics have affirmed that supernatural love and heavenly love find the symbols which they seek in marital love, rather than in friendship, filial devotion or devotion to a cause. And the reason is to be found precisely in its totality.” Why then should we not pause to speak of feelings and sexuality in marriage? Desires, feelings, emotions, what the ancients called “the passions”, all have an important place in married life. They are awakened whenever “another” becomes present and part of a person’s life. It is characteristic of all living beings to reach out to other things, and this tendency always has basic affective signs: pleasure or pain, joy or sadness, tenderness or fear. They ground the most elementary psychological activity. Human beings live on this earth, and all that they do and seek is fraught with passion.

As true man, Jesus showed his emotions. He was hurt by the rejection of Jerusalem (cf. *Mt* 23:27) and this moved him to tears (cf. *Lk* 19:41). He was also deeply moved by the sufferings of others (cf. *Mk* 6:34). He felt deeply their grief (cf. *Jn* 11:33), and he wept at the death of a friend (cf. *Jn* 11:35). These examples of his sensitivity showed how much his human heart was open to others.
