Reflection

This past week, I preached about the reports of abuse in the Church. I'm sure we've all gone through many of the same emotions from disgust and anger to grief and disappointment and many of us have probably considered leaving the Church. I know 15 years ago when I entered the Seminary, the Church was in the midst of the first round of major abuse cases and I thought to myself "why am I leaving a great job for the priesthood"? Well after much prayer I just couldn't say no to Jesus. I knew the Catholic Church was the community where he wanted me to worship Him in Spirit and Truth; to choose otherwise would be to choose less than what God wanted for my life. Today, unfortunately, I know some people will leave the Church over this issue, it reminds me of last week's Gospel, in John 6:66 some of the disciples, followers of Jesus left Him. And then after leaving Jesus, Jesus turns and looks to Peter asking him "what about you Peter? Will you leave as well? Peter then turns to Jesus and says to Him: To whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. Peter loved Jesus too much to just walk away. Something we should all reflect on ourselves.

I relate to what someone told me: I'm a believer.... not because of Judas but because of Jesus. What some priests and bishops did was terribly evil, but for me leaving the Church Jesus started because of them would be like saying that evil wins.....evil finally caused me to leave Jesus in the Eucharist. All my life I've been fighting for good and so now today, how could I allow myself to leave Jesus in the Eucharist because of the horribly evil actions of a few? Yes, those who have broken laws, broken trust and broken innocent lives need to be held responsible for their crimes so all the victims may have their day of justice and hopefully this never happens again. But for me, I just can't give up on believing in all the good I've experienced from Jesus in the Eucharist. My heart has been that profoundly blest by God. So as the great prophet Joshua said in last week's reading, "*as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord!*"

One of the best responses to the issues I've heard came from Bishop Robert Barron, founder of Word on Fire Catholic Ministries. You can access his message at: <http://bit.ly/2MUFQrP> Both Moses and Jesus remind us in this week's readings that we as God's people are called to keep God's commandments, to live by a higher moral standard than the rest of the world. To be a witness to our Faith. The Pharisees and scribes, the so called religious leaders honored God only with their lips, but their hearts were far from God; in vain did they worship God, teaching as doctrines human precepts. Today, just like 2000 years ago, there are religious leaders who honor God only with their lips. But it should not be so with us.

We are all called to follow God's Commandments faithfully. The only way I know how to keep the Commandments and to love others is by having Jesus in the Eucharist as the source of all that is good. Today may our celebration of the Eucharist, a memorial of the sacrifice of Jesus, the greatest sign of God's love for us, inform and transform us for the greater good of the world. And may we honor God not just with our lips in prayer, but with our hearts in love and action.

My dear sisters and brothers in the Lord,

It is with the utmost sorrow that I write to you in this time of great scandal and tribulation in our Church. Many people in leadership, particularly among the episcopacy, have failed the people of God. There can be no ambiguity about this. As your spiritual father and the shepherd of this Diocese, I have prayed, struggled, and reflected a great deal these past few weeks in order to determine how I can best serve you. The release of the Pennsylvania's Grand Jury report yesterday confirms that we who lead the Church have a great responsibility to take action against a predation that can only be called satanic.

After I was appointed to our Diocese I began to meet regularly with our [Oversight Review Board](#), whose charge it is to advise me on matters concerning accusations of sexual abuse of a minor perpetrated by a cleric. Based on the painful experiences in my home Diocese of Springfield, Illinois during Bishop Daniel Ryan's tenure which resulted in a devastating loss of trust, I wanted to take every opportunity to create a truly safe environment, including reviewing allegations involving adults, not just minors. In addition, I urge anyone who has been a victim of clerical abuse in our Diocese to report the abuse by calling our toll free number: (800) 364-3064.

In light of the revelations surrounding Archbishop McCarrick, not to mention the situations in Honduras and Chile, I now know that the review process needs to be expanded to include claims from seminarians and priests so that they, too, are protected from sexual abuse by those in power.

Canon law provides for judicial processes to try all clergy, including bishops, who are charged with canonical crimes. Make no mistake, sexual crimes against the faithful are serious violations of Church law. As a canon lawyer, I know also that these canonical processes were strengthened by Pope Francis as recently as 2016. It goes without saying that there are civil and criminal recourses, as well.

I appreciate the righteous anger expressed toward those who have failed to follow due process and the demands of accountability. I also want to assure you that I am committed to join with my brother bishops to address these failings. A competent independent national investigative body comprised of qualified professionals needs to be created so that if we have systemic issues within our Church, they can be thoroughly reviewed and addressed. I pledge my support to this and will allocate diocesan funds for this purpose.

Unequivocally, I join my brother bishops who have already spoken out to identify the root cause as a crisis in holiness. Shepherds who sincerely seek the Lord do not abuse the power that Our Lord has entrusted to them. Those who abuse this holy office fail Christ and his Church. In this difficult time, please join with me to pray that our Church be purified, that all the people who have been wounded by abuse on the part of the clergy experience healing, and that I, along with the rest of Church leadership, act with wisdom, courage, and humility to fulfill the office that the Lord has entrusted to us.

Body Posture Change after "The Lamb of God"

As many of you are aware, Bishop Kevin Vann has recently requested that all Catholics in the Diocese of Orange strive to foster a deeper devotion and belief in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. With this in mind, we're called to make an outward expression of our inward reverence and awe for the Most Holy Eucharist at every Mass. Therefore, we have begun the practice where all of us will kneel (or sit if necessary) after the Lamb of God and will stay kneeling until their particular pew stands up and walks forward to receive Holy Communion.

Our Eucharistic Ministers, who help to distribute Holy Communion, have two options on when to approach the altar. Either they can come forward during the "Sign of Peace", sanitize their hands and begin to kneel in the sanctuary area after the Lamb of God or they may remain in the pews if necessary and then approach the sanctuary after the Priest has consumed Holy Communion.
