

## Reflection

---

*... if anyone who comes to me without hating father or mother, wife, husband, children, brothers and sisters ... cannot be my disciple (Luke 14).* These are the words that echo from Jesus as he makes his way from Galilee to Jerusalem. We cannot help but wonder what motivated Jesus to make such a strong statement. The story does not give us any indication, but that does not lessen the impact of the word "hate."

Most of us rarely use this phraseology. In Aramaic, the word hate is far more neutral than how we experience it in English. It means *not to prefer or not to choose*. I believe what Jesus was trying to get his disciples and us to realize is the personal impact of what it means to say we are willing to follow him. Jesus is clarifying the commitment: If we want to be disciples of Jesus the expectation is that we need to be ready to surrender our lives totally, including our attachment to things, our appetites which possess or control our lives, enmities, prejudices, and even those closest to us who may prevent us or are a hindrance to a total commitment to him. Jesus wants us to know from the start the tough demands and conditions that accompany our perception of discipleship. He wants us to take his invitation very seriously.

Perhaps that is the reason he expounds his exhortation by sharing two stories: *... which of you wishing to construct a tower does not first sit down and calculate the cost to see if there is enough for its completion ...* (Luke 14) No one wants to walk away from a half completed job and look like a fool! Or *... what king marching into battle would not first sit down and decide whether with ten thousand troops he can successfully oppose another king advancing upon him with twenty thousand troops ...* (Luke 14). So too, if we are thinking of being a disciple of Jesus, we need to think carefully about the cost. It may demand more than we are willing to give up even to the point of facing the opposition of family, friends, colleagues, and those we love. We all have experienced taking a stand against family or those closest to us or at work, for the sake of a greater good, and we can recall the pain and how hard it is to cope with the fear of offending or being rejected by those whom we hold dear.

Jesus knows very well how often we can confuse intellectual assent with an authentic conversion of mind, heart, and life. It is far easier to follow Jesus with our intellect by simply adhering to all the specs outlined in the blueprints and elevations of our faith. It seems Jesus' stories rails against the notion of minimizing our beliefs by committing ourselves to a cafeteria-buffet style of living our lives. To be a disciple of Jesus is like "building a tower or leading troops." It requires our total selves. Following Jesus cannot simply be about assuring that we are using the correct tools alone, but must assent to the totality of ourselves even to the point ... of carrying the cross (Luke 14).

The Gospel may be very hard to hear and not easy to embrace, but it does pose several important questions: What is really important to us in our lives? How do we perceive and understand our priorities when it comes to our needs and appetites and who and what ultimately gives us meaning and depth assuring that we are living a life that is authentic, real, and honest? I believe Jesus wants us to simply face up to the truth about ourselves. His mandate of ... *if anyone who comes to me without hating father, mother, wife, husband, children, brothers and sisters (Luke 14)* is to assure that we are not misled into thinking that following him is something that can be taken lightly without very serious consideration.

The U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops' (USCCB) president, Archbishop Joseph E. Kurtz of Louisville, Kentucky, has called for an emergency collection to assist victims of the recent flooding in Louisiana. He also issued a statement of solidarity with the victims and invited Catholics to generously help those in need. The collection funds will support the humanitarian efforts of Catholic Charities USA and will help provide support to Catholic dioceses also impacted. As many as 60,000 homes have been damaged, with nearly 20,000 people being rescued from the flood waters. More than 106,000 individuals and families have sought federal disaster aid. Immediate and long-term recovery needs place a tremendous burden on public and private resources. This is a burden we can help carry as the body of Christ. Faced with the loss of their worldly possessions and, in some cases, economic livelihood, the flood waters left thousands of families feeling isolated and fearful. Let us draw near to them. 

Pope Francis' document: *Amoris Laetitia – The Joy of Love* will be presented in a series each week during the Year of Mercy. It is an easy-reading document and inspires us to become a People of Mercy. We are presenting *The Joy of Love* in its original English translation without commentary as an avenue of reflection and prayer during this Liturgical Year of Mercy.

## The Twentieth in the Series



In the course of every marriage physical appearances change, but this hardly means that love and attraction need fade. We love the other person for who they are, not simply for their body. Although the body ages, it still expresses that personal identity that first won our heart. Even if others can no longer see the beauty of that identity, a spouse continues to see it with the eyes of love and so his or her affection does not diminish. He or she reaffirms the decision to belong to the other and expresses that choice in faithful and loving closeness. The nobility of this decision, by its intensity and depth, gives rise to a new kind of emotion as they fulfil their marital mission. The marriage bond finds new forms of expression and constantly seeks new ways to grow in strength. These both preserve and strengthen the bond. They call for daily effort. None of this, however, is possible without praying to the Holy Spirit for an outpouring of his grace, his supernatural strength and his spiritual fire, to confirm, direct and transform our love in every new situation.

The family is the setting in which a new life is not only born but also welcomed as a gift of God. Each new life "allows us to appreciate the utterly gratuitous dimension of love, which never ceases to amaze us. It is the beauty of being loved first: Children are loved even before they arrive." Here we see a reflection of the primacy of the love of God, who always takes the initiative, for children "are loved before having done anything to deserve it, and yet, "from the first moments of their lives, many children are rejected, abandoned, and robbed of their childhood and future. There are those who dare to say, as if to justify themselves, that it was a mistake to bring these children into the world. This is shameful!"

How can we issue solemn declarations on human rights and the rights of children, if we then punish children for the errors of adults?" If a child comes into this world in unwanted circumstances, the parents and other members of the family must do everything possible to accept that child as a gift from God and assume the responsibility of accepting him or her with openness and affection, for "when speaking of children who come into the world, no sacrifice made by adults will be considered too costly or too great, if it means the child never has to feel that he or she is a mistake, or worthless or abandoned to the four winds and the arrogance of man." The gift of a new child, entrusted by the Lord to a father and a mother, begins with acceptance, continues with lifelong protection and has as its final goal the joy of eternal life. By serenely contemplating the ultimate fulfilment of each human person, parents will be even more aware of the precious gift entrusted to them. For God allows parents to choose the name by which he himself will call their child for all eternity.
