

Reflection

There is an irony in today's word: Our usual perception is that we are the ones who pursue God, but today we are presented with a God who not only "searches us out" but is the one who is persistent in his intent. In the *Book of Exodus*, despite the infidelity of the Israelite People, God is not deterred. He remembers how he broke into Abraham's life and forever changed the history of this people (*Exodus 32*). The same theme seems to craft its way into *Paul's Letter to Timothy*. Paul persecuted the followers of Jesus, yet despite Paul's disregard for the lives of others and his exuberant commitment to murder the followers of Jesus, God breaks into the life of Paul on the way to Damascus and his life is changed forever (*1 Timothy 1*). In each case, there is a sense of loss and then the experience of "being found" by one who pursues, searches, and persistently goes out his way to assure that those who took the wrong turn can find the path to their destiny.

All of us at one time or another have experienced losing something of great value to us or have "taken the wrong turn in our lives" or have had the feeling or thinking that somehow our lives are simply not unfolding in way that seems right. We expend enormous amounts of energy searching for what we have lost or sometimes we simply imitate life even though the pieces just do not seem to fit (*Luke 15*). Jesus takes this sense of loss and disorientation and weaves it into three stories: ... who among you having a hundred sheep and losing one would not leave the ninety-nine and go after the lost one ... and when you find it, throw it onto your shoulders with great joy ... or if you had ten coins and lose one, who would not call the neighbors and say, 'Rejoice with me because I have found the coin that I lost' or a father who after his son returns home after losing everything surprises his son by saying ... 'we must celebrate and rejoice because this son of mine was dead and has come to life again (*Luke 15*)'. It seems Jesus wants us to realize that even when we have a sense of "being lost" or have opted for an alternative choice that is not life-giving, or have sinned or feel separated, alienated, or distant, God refuses to remain silent and disengaged. He will go to any length to assure that we do not stray by perusing us until we are found and then with sheer delight rejoices that we are found!

Today's story may be easy for us to embrace simply because most of us believe this is simply one of those nice stories of Jesus. This is the reason so many of us find it hard to believe that God will actually will go through all this effort to rescue us from ourselves, but then this is the challenge Jesus sets before us. Can we embrace the notion that God would actually go out of his way to search us (me) out ... that God will actually come after me and even go so far as to throw a party because he has found me! Our response often is "me?" God cares for me? The answer is yes he does and this is the reason Jesus uses these stories to bring home this point. Jesus draws us into the drama of the situations and characters of his stories so he can break through our skepticism. He wants us to understand that God's dream is that no one should ever feel that they are left outside the circle of his life. He wants us to visualize that from our personal experience of "searching for something or someone that was lost and found" speaks to us. He wants that moment of relief when we find that we have recovered something of value or rediscover ourselves " God literally ... throwing us on his shoulders ... while gathering the entire kingdom and saying: let us rejoice because I have found what was lost ... the one who was dead has come back to life (*Luke 16*)". Jesus is trying to get us to see that there is no other God that has such great mercy for us to the point that he can get excited about "me" to the point that he spirals into an uncontrollable excitement "when we are found." Of course this should be "no surprise to us" simply because this is the type of God we believe in!
