

REFLECTION

In the first reading, Moses spoke on behalf of the Israelites so the Lord relented in the punishment he had threatened to inflict on his people. (Ex 32:13-14) Like Moses, Jesus also acted as our mediator, to save us from eternal condemnation, by preaching the repentance of sins. On his way to Jerusalem, many tax collectors and sinners were attracted to what he had to say. Instead of rejoicing about how merciful our God is with the sinners, the Pharisees complained to Jesus that he should distance himself from them. Therefore, Jesus, in the gospel of this Sunday, uses three examples to explain the love God has towards all his people.

The first example is the shepherd who abandoned his ninety-nine sheep to look for the lost one among the one hundred others was a bit too much for those who looked at it with economical or practical reasons. Similarly, the second parable about the woman who did not mind wasting precious oil to light the lamp and turn the whole house upside down to look for the lost coin; both parables are examples of how much God loves us. A story is told about this group of people gathering with the idea to open a reformatory for boys. They invited a well-known educator to advise them on how to go about it. He made a passionate plea for humane methods of education at the reformatory, urging the founders to spare no expense in getting the services of kind-hearted and competent teachers. He concluded by saying, "If the reformatory were to save even one boy from moral depravity, it will have justified all the cost and labor invested in it." Afterwards, a member of the board approached him and said, "Didn't you get a little bit carried away there? Would all the cost and labor be justified if we could save only one boy?" "Yes, if it were my boy," came the reply. In the eyes of God, we are all his children, and we are unique and precious to him.

Jesus used the elder brother in the third parable to tell the Pharisees they need not be jealous about the way God treated the sinners, for they also have a share of his mercy. Do we, as Christians, look at the issues in the Church and in the world through the eyes of the elder brother; or, do we recognize we are the tax collectors who are just happy we have such a loving and merciful father? The Pharisees should rejoice with God for those who found their way home to God, as all three parables end with a feast after the sinner or the lost one had been found. All self-righteous Christians should do the same.

EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

Be Informed: Make sure everyone in your family knows what to do when they hear emergency warnings.

Your community may have outdoor warning sirens (also called tornado sirens) to warn you in an emergency. These sirens are meant to let people who are outside know they should go indoors. When you hear the outdoor warning sirens sound in your area it is not safe for you to be outdoors. You should take cover inside a sturdy building and get more information from television, radio, internet, or by contacting a friend or family member.

Call your local fire department to find out if your area is covered by warning sirens, when they are tested, and when they would be activated. Make sure other members of your household know what to do when outdoor warning sirens sound.

Some communities have other ways of warning residents. They may call by phone or send text messages or emails with emergency information. Check with your local emergency management or sheriff's office to find out what other warning systems are used in your area. Talk to family members about what to do when emergency information is given.






