# Reflection

I sometimes think that life would probably be so much easier if things were simply black and white; if solutions to life's experiences and the issues we encounter could easily be dealt with either one way or another! Then all we need do if we want this is just do this; or if we want that, we know we would have to do that. It

would seem like things would be less stressful in life and complicated, but the truth be told, life is not like this. Life is not black or white; rather it takes on the character which encompasses hues of grey. It is precisely in the grey areas that we live our lives. It is in the variations of the grey that life is truly experienced. It is in the blending of the greys from light to dark that life unfolds.

The Gospel word, at first glance, may seem an exception. Jesus seems to infer that there is a "black and white" dimension when it comes to following him, and he defines this point very definitively in his story by saying: ... no servant can serve two masters. You will either hate one and love the other or be devoted to one and despise the other (Luke 16). It seems Jesus is very clear. There does not seem to be any room for the grey when it comes to being a disciple of Jesus! At first glance our perception may seem correct. Jesus appears to be aiming to show that we are either good or clever stewards or we are not; however, it seems Jesus' point lies not in the "black and white" as we may believe, but lies more in the areas of the grey in our lives. I think Jesus is inviting us to take a close look at our attitudes and those speckles of "grey" that exist within the black and white pallet of our lives. He wants us to scrutinize what we perceive as important to us: What we hold in high esteem. How do we use the money and processions and ask whether we have become slaves to money and other matters of life (Luke 16). Our immediate answer would naturally be "of course we do not," but notice Jesus never says money is bad. What he does focus his attention upon is on how we use our money. The value and high esteem we place on it. Jesus in no uncertain term reminds us not to abuse things, people, and situations of life (as the unfaithful steward did). The importance and focus of Jesus' story is more about what we hold as important to us, what we embrace with grace and esteem that is up and above God which in the long run ends up separating and creating a cleavage between ourselves and others.

Jesus' question is uncomfortable. Addressing the grey areas of our lives in which we "tuck away" the true identity of our intentions is not an easy task, yet it is precisely in the "grey" of our lives that lay the truth of our attitudes, the way we truly feel or think about others, and our relationship with God. Therein truly lays our treasure. Being good stewards is not so much about keeping a balanced money account, as much as it is how we go about knowing the balance between things and people. It is about seeing the value and the dignity that each person holds, rather than treating them disrespectfully or abusing them, or dismissing them or putting another in their place or keeping them at bay or trying to control situations and people to our advantage. Jesus places before us a very tough question: *How can we be good stewards in faith if we are not trustworthy about simple things that really matter* (Luke 16). What God wants us to have the courage (unlike the unfaithful steward) to take a good hard look at those "grey areas of our lives." What is interesting about Jesus parable is the response of the Pharisees and Jesus delivers his punch line: They laughed! The story seems to indicate the steward was truly wise. He tricked his boss and gave everyone a discount and made friends so he could call upon them in the future; however, the Pharisees, who were known for their love of money were not laughing at the story's punch line, (Luke 16) they were laughing at Jesus' idea of praising only the steward's sharpness and not his self-serving attitude. Jesus demanded a radically different attitude when it comes to money and things: He believed that those who claim to be his disciples need to embrace the truth that God is first, the true center of their lives and we are to use what we possess in a way that extenuates its true value, while at the same time not become a slave or side tracked by our cleverness! A difficult balance! The dismay of the Pharisees and perhaps our own may very well lay in the grey where we might discover to our surprise and that we are not as great stewards of our faith as we may think. Searching out the grey may very well mean we need a makeover in our faith-life because some of those grey areas could be the genesis that creates levels of untrustworthiness in our lives.


