


Reflection

Forty years ago, when we mentioned mouse, we knew it referred to the little animal that had been nesting in the barn. Now when we mention the word mouse, we think of a gadget that controls the cursor of a desktop computer. Apple and berry used to be the healthy fruits and now they are electronic machines. Some say that babies who are born this year will never have to learn to drive because by the time they reach their driving age; the car will be fully automated and able to drive itself. Those of us who are senior citizens already find it more and more difficult to adjust to the technological world. When Jesus came to this world two thousand years ago, the Jews had difficulty accepting his teaching and we can even feel the same way today. For example, if someone slaps you on one cheek, turn to them the other also. Or, bless those who curse you and pray for those who mistreat you. The Gospel of this 25th Sunday once again turns our world upside down. The last will be first, and the first will be last. Why is that?

Does God turn our world upside down or do we ourselves turn God's world upside down? If we read the gospel and use ourselves as the focal point, many times we will have a hard time understanding the gospel. If we compare today's Gospel with the gospel of the prodigal son, they convey the same meaning that God is generous and forgiving. However, in the parable of the prodigal son, we do not question the unfairness of the father to the elder son because we identify ourselves with the younger son and we are glad that God is so forgiving. In the parable of today's gospel, if we identify ourselves with the worker who works all day long and gets the same wage as the one who works for only one hour, then we will question the fairness of God. God in both parables showed the generosity and the willingness to forgive. He forgave the younger son who spent all the inheritance he had received and he forgave all the hours the worker was supposed to work to have earned a full day's wage. Usually, it's because of our selfishness that we cannot see how God's world is supposed to function. Unless we abandon our worldly view and accept fully what the Prophet Isaiah said in the first reading about God's world: For my thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways my ways; otherwise, we would always find the teaching of Jesus difficult to digest.



Catholic Social Teaching & the Death Penalty: Life and Dignity of the Human Person

The first and foremost aspect of the Church's teaching that applies to the Death Penalty is the belief in the inherent dignity of the human person. Made in the image and likeness of God, the human person is the foundation of a moral vision for society and stands at the heart of the Church's understanding of justice. As Catholics, we believe in a *consistent ethic of life*, from conception to natural death the sanctity of the human person cannot be diminished. By allowing the state to end a life before natural death, the death penalty contradicts this consistent ethic, and does not conform to our pro-life teaching.

The death penalty violates the sanctity of the human person, and it also threatens innocent life. Despite our best efforts, our criminal justice system is not perfect. According to a 2014 study, at least 4% of those sentenced to death in the United States are innocent. The 159 people and counting who have been exonerated due to their innocence since 1973 exemplify that fact. For every 9 people who have been executed since the death penalty was reinstated in 1976, 1 person has been exonerated after being proven innocent.
