REFLECTION

As we read today's Gospel, we hear how the Apostles had said to Jesus, "Lord increase our faith." We must remember our faith is a gift, and God is the source and giver of that gift. So why would the Apostles say this; what prompted them to make this unusual request? To understand this, we need

to go back to previous passages in Luke's Gospel, the parables about the prodigal son, the dishonest steward, Lazarus, and the rich man. Together, they point to a reality that God's ways are different from our ways. They remind us that if we are to be faithful disciples, we must live not as the world lives, but as Jesus Christ lives. It is Jesus who reveals to us the very mind and heart of God.

We use the word "faith" in different ways, from our Catholic identity to our Christian values to the very Creed we proclaim every Sunday. When Luke speaks of faith and when Paul speaks about the gift (of faith) given through the laying on of hands, they are not simply speaking about what we believe in our heads. Instead, they refer to that gift from God that binds us and empowers us to follow and live in Christ. This is what the disciples sought: an increase in the most precious of all gifts.... a strong and enduring relationship with Jesus Christ.

It has never been easy to be a Christian. The early Christians had to deal with all sorts of threats and persecutions. We can understand why this call to faith is at the heart of the Gospels. By asking Jesus for an increase, the disciples are recognizing He is the source of this supernatural faith, and such a faith is not the outcome of human strength or willpower, but is a sheer gift from God (GRACE). Because it is a gift, it can never be seen as something we can earn or boast of as our own achievement. We are servants of our Lord Jesus Christ, and when we respond to God's gift of grace, we are simply doing our duty.

The challenge is we also live in a world where it can be difficult to be faithful disciples. In such a world, our living out of our grace given faith is of more and more importance. This is why it's so important to pray as Jesus taught us.... for God's Kingdom to come and God's will, not ours, be done. To be a faith-filled Christian is not simply about having an inner conviction, but the courage and strength to live our faith on a daily basis. Christ's word to us today is a word of encouragement, we need only a little trust, the size of the mustard seed, in His strength to carry us through this life. It is the power of God living in and through us that will ultimately empower us to be faith-filled and faithful....as we pray: dear Jesus "increase my faith".





Respect Life

"Human trafficking is a crime against humanity. We must unite our efforts to free victims and stop this crime that's become ever more aggressive, that threatens not just individuals, but the foundational values of society..." — Pope Francis

Human trafficking occurs within almost every country and across most international borders. Today, 30 million¹ people are bound in forced labor. The root cause of trafficking is poverty. Two and one-half billion people in the human family, attempting to exist on two dollars per day or less, are lured into trafficking or bound into indentured servitude that continues for generations, as a means of survival. In Southern California, victims of human trafficking can be enslaved in the garment industry, as housekeepers, care givers for the elderly or prostitutes. Today, human trafficking victims are getting younger, with many children and teenagers domestically trafficked through illicit social media contacts. Human trafficking demeans the dignity of the human person, fractures families and exploits workers. To counteract this global problem, supporting education, especially for girls excluded from educational opportunities and purchasing fair trade products to provide a living wage diminishes the lure of trafficking. Locally, in our communities, awareness and education about the signs of trafficking and supporting organizations addressing the issue will help free those enslaved and protect potential victims, especially youth, from becoming ensnared. (Catholic Relief Services)

In order to stop Human Trafficking, we need to understand it and know what actions to take. This is not merely a "foreign problem." According to the California Attorney general, a Trafficker can make over \$500,000 a year making this the fastest growing crime in the state.


