## Reflection

---

It is a custom in the Chinese culture that when there is an invitation to a banquet, the whole family is invited.

My siblings and I would always try to think of an excuse for not going when my parents got an invitation. What was wrong with the banquet that we did not want to go? First, at home, we had enough to eat and drink so the food at the banquet was not an attraction for us. Second, as kids, we did not know how to socialize with the adults so we found the banquet quite boring. These seemed to be legitimate reasons but now we find ourselves strangers among the relatives because we missed the opportunity to interact with them. The invitation of the banquet in the gospel today represents God calling us to have an intimate relationship with Him. Take a brief look at your life and see how many excuses we have made to refuse this invitation:

- I know I should write that email, but I am not in the mood.
- I know I should make an effort to get to Mass on time (or just to get to Mass at all), but something always gets in the way.
- I know I should spend more time with my children, but I need the extra money for them to have a better life.
- I know I drink too much, but I am under a lot of stress these days. When the stress is gone, I will stop drinking.
- I should visit my ailing friend, but right now my favorite program is on television.

The excuses the parable mentioned to keep the invited guests from attending the banquet were not bad ones. One man wanted to tend to his land and the other to his business; these are good excuses. It is precisely the excuses we think are not bad, like the ones above which we would use repeatedly and becomes habit. This would gradually make us indifferent to God's calling and become a threat to our faith. We become the unprepared guest running the risk of being thrown out of the banquet. Many times I have encountered people in the hospitals I visited who have lost their faith because they went to the banquet without preparing themselves for the feast. Young people have the same issues with their faith. These people are too proud or angry and tell me they do not believe anymore. Little did they know that they are not punishing God or the Church by not believing. They are actually being thrown out from the banquet by their own doing.



## **HOLY SEE APPOINTS VIETNAMESE-AMERICAN AUXILIARY BISHOP FOR DIOCESE OF ORANGE**

The Vatican Press Office today announced that Bishop-elect Thanh Thai Nguyen has been appointed by the Holy See as Auxiliary Bishop for the Diocese of Orange. Auxiliary Bishop-elect Nguyen will support Bishop Vann and auxiliary Bishop Timothy Freyer, ordained this past January, in caring for the spiritual needs of the 1.3 million member Diocese of Orange, one of the fastest growing and most ethnically diverse in the United States. His episcopal ordination will be announced in the coming days.

"I am both humbled and honored to accept this appointment," said Bishop-elect Thanh Thai Nguyen. "I am grateful to Pope Francis and to Bishop Vann for their trust and confidence in me and I pray that I may live up to their expectations. My life continues to be blessed by the Grace of God and I look forward to joining with my new family of faith in the Diocese of Orange."

In his new role, Bishop-elect Nguyen will quickly pick up the mantel of leadership in support of Bishop Vann's energetic ministry. He will provide important pastoral care and leadership within the Vietnamese Catholic community in Orange County, the largest congregation in the United States. Like his brother Bishops, Bishop-elect Nguyen will focus on shepherding the large and diverse community of faith toward an ever deeper relationship with Christ.


"We are blessed as a Diocese to welcome such an experienced and passionate leader to journey with us in faith. Bishop-elect Nguyen is loved greatly by his current congregation and has a reputation as a humble, competent and caring leader. These traits will serve our Diocese well as our community continues its growth – both in size and faith," said the Most Rev. Kevin Vann, Bishop of Orange.

Bishop-elect Nguyen was born in Nha Trang, Vietnam in 1953 and is the second oldest of eight boys and three girls. He spent most of his elementary education in Catholic schools and in 1966 he entered St. Joseph Seminary, a small diocesan institute in Vietnam. His seminary formation was interrupted when the communist government took over the Country in 1975. Bishop-elect Nguyen and other seminarians were forced into hard labor in the rice fields to be allowed to continue their studies.

In 1979 after suffering religious persecution, Bishop-elect Nguyen along with 26 members of his extended family boarded a small motorboat and slipped out of Cam Ranh Bay – headed for the Philippines and safety. The family was soon engulfed by a tropical storm and spent 18 days at sea, several with no food or water. The family prayed the Rosary together each morning and evening. All 26 of them, through the Grace of God, arrived safely in the Philippines. After 10 months in a refugee camp the family left Manila in June of 1980 for their new life in Beaumont, Texas.

Upon arriving in the United States, Bishop-Elect Nguyen's vocational calling continued to draw him toward God. He worked at Catholic Charities in Hartford, Connecticut before returning to his academics at Merrimack College in N. Andover, where he earned a Bachelor's of Arts degree. After two years of study he graduated Cum Laude and immediately began his novitiate year in Washington D.C. and took his first vows with the La Salette Order in 1987. Bishop-Elect Nguyen graduated from the Weston Jesuit School of Theology, Cambridge, Massachusetts in May 1990 and was ordained on May 11, 1991.

Bishop-Elect Nguyen was later incardinated into the Diocese of St. Augustine, Florida where he currently serves at St. Joseph parish, where he was appointed pastor in 2013. Bishop-elect Nguyen is well known by parishioners for his love of music and skill in playing the guitar. He is also an avid tennis player.



## October is Life and Dignity Month

### **Catholic Social Teaching & The Death Penalty: Solidarity**

We are one human family whatever our national, racial, ethnic, economic, and ideological differences, and are called to be our sisters' and brothers' keepers. This means that no matter what wrongs a person may commit or what experiences their lives bring, we are called to live in a pursuit of justice and peace. The death penalty unjustly targets people of color, those with intellectual disability and mental illness; it affects those living in poverty and risks killing innocent life. Our call to solidarity is our call to live out a preferential option for the poor and vulnerable.

The death penalty denies our call to solidarity by ignoring the pain and harm caused by violence. The necessarily long, complex death penalty trial process can force victims' families to re-live their trauma and pain. This costly process diverts money and resources from needed services for victims' families. For many victims' families the loss of another life is not the answer: "*Pursuing the death penalty would not be the way we would want to honor our daughter's life, nor would that decision have helped us deal with the painful reminders of her unfulfilled hopes and dreams,*" (Vicki Schieber, CMN Speaker). As Catholics, we are called to care for these victims' families, to bear witness to their experiences, and allow them to heal from the harm they have experienced, not create more victim's family members with the death penalty.
