## Reflection


The portrait presented in today's word was disturbing to the people of Jesus' time. The temple and its adornments were of great value and held in high esteem. It was the center of their way of life and to hear

Jesus say that what held the fabric of their lives together will fall into disarray would be met with great consternation: .... Teacher when will this happen ... and what sign will there be when all these things are about to happen ... (Luke 21). Jesus was addressing his words to those who are admiring the beauty of the temple in Jerusalem and said ... all that you see here ... the days will come when there will not be left a stone upon another stone that will not be thrown down (Luke 21). The unraveling of the temple and the toppling down of what was central to their life and faith would have been a very difficult message to hear.

We live in a time in which much of what we value, what has been entrusted into our care and gives us a vision, an identity, is also being destroyed leaving us with a great sense of doubt and insecurity. Some of the symptoms of this prevailing mood of doom is the emergence of a grim and humorless attitude of life in which a haunting fear that there is no future or hope for the world. Some even go so far as to spread dire warnings and predictions that the world will soon disintegrate; yet the word Jesus gives us is to "remain faithful" in the midst of what appears to be the unraveling of what we hold as important to us: ... don't be deceived (Luke 21). Jesus asks us to continue to believe even in the midst of the changes and tragedies we experience and do not insolate ourselves. Running away from life only leaves to deception because the only thing the prophets of doom can offer is a sense of hopelessness and despair and neglect to realize that very often God reveals himself in the tragedies and changes in life. Jesus tells us: ... do not follow them! When you hear of wars and insurrections ... powerful earthquakes, famines, and plagues from place to place ... it will not immediately be the end ... (Luke 21).

We need to realize that as disturbing as the world may be at this time, it does not necessarily mean that the fullness of God's kingdom is just around the corner nor an indication that the world is falling apart. We need to realize and understand that there is still more of the kingdom to be revealed and discovered and there is still more of the world that is in need of redemption. The only way to enter into the depth of God's kingdom is to embrace life even in the midst of all its uncertainties. Our challenge as people of faith is not to give in to the fears of others. Hope sustains our capacity to live with danger without being overwhelmed by it. Hope is the will to struggle against the obstacles when they appear insurmountable. If we listen to what Jesus is saying it will become apparent that he is not espousing a pessimist philosophy or perspective of life, but uprooting those who have embraced a dooms-day mentality. All the predictions in history of the end-times have been wrong. What is needed today is not a flight from life or a retreating into the past, nor a giving into a malaise that we are running out of time, but in a rapidly changing world we are invited to remain faithful. In this throw away world, it is easy to embrace a culture of death, but what we seek is not the "end of things" but the possibility that our perseverance will bring about a new world that speaks a truth that overturns the prevailing stories which is wildly circulated that a troubled and doomed world is headed to hell in a hand-basket: ... but for you ... there will arise the sun of justice with its healing rays ... (Malachi 3).



## Emergency Supplies: Gather your emergency supplies in an accessible place.

Have a Go Bag ready if you have to shelter in place or evacuate your home. Your Go Bag can be part of your emergency kit, just make sure it is in a bag or easy to carry container and that it is easy to get to.

### **Think about these items for your Go Bag:**

Battery powered radio and extra batteries, Flashlight with extra batteries, Lightweight blankets, Emergency information, including insurance policies, A list of medications and correct dosage, and doctor's names, Personal items such as toothbrushes, soap, extra glasses, etc., Whistle, First aid kit, Change of clothing, Non-perishable snacks, Books, cards or magazines to pass the time.

### **Consider these additional items for infants and children:**

Baby formula and food, Diapers, Baby wipes, Blanket or toy

### **Consider these additional items for medical conditions:**

Empty pill bottle(s) or a list of current medications and your doctor's phone number.

\*Make sure you update your Go Bag when your medications change.

### **For pets:**

Pet food & water, Collar with ID tags, Pet medication (s), Pet carriers and leashes, Medical records from vet, Photos of your pet, Microchip information.


