

Reflection

If there is one thing we can brag about our American system is that our representatives on every government level is accessible to us. We may complain that perhaps they are not as available as we would like them to be, but from a global perspective, comparing ourselves to other governing structures we are people that are “pretty up close and face-to-face to our leadership.”

The Gospel today presents a portrait of God who is absolutely available. Unlike other faiths and cultures that tweak their kings or religious leaders or important figures in history, we make no excuses nor do we try to explain away what we experience: A God that suffers and is crucified (Luke 21). Our God is truly a God who is right here in our face. There is no distance between the suffering of this chosen servant and us. His enemies ... sneered ... and said: ... he saved others; *let him save himself ... even the soldiers jeered at him ... if you are King of the Jews, save yourself* (Luke 23). Despite this humiliation, God remains unbelievably available to everyone without regard.

Our faith is not in a God that is remote, but present to his people with mercy, forgiveness, compassion, and healing without judgment, retribution or vengeance. The crowd, soldiers, and the criminals reject Jesus because of their skewed understanding of Jesus, his life and their misunderstanding of his message, but he does not condemn, reject or call out vengeance upon them, rather he embraces them by stretching out his arms and becomes the accessibility of the saving power of God. This is manifested when Jesus turns to the criminal and says ... Amen, I say to you today you will be with in Paradise (Luke 21). Other gods in history simply do not respond in the midst of personal rejection with mercy, but our God does and his words are not reserved to this condemned man, but to us as well. As the criminal states: ... we have been condemned justly, for ... our crimes ... (Luke 22). He echoes our own plight. We are sinners. We all fall short of the mark and yet Jesus turns to us without judgment and offers to embrace our shadows and sinfulness and takes our sins into himself by offering us forgiveness and redeems what was lost within ourselves and restores us: ... he delivered us from the power of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of his Son, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sin ... (Colossians 1). Jesus does not require perfection. He only asks that we come before him and allow ourselves to be embraced by the accessible gift of his presence that will transform whatever is in need of being renewed within us.


The Feast of Jesus King of the Universe is a reminder that our God is not beyond our human experience. He is our human experience! He takes our existential life and redeems it and makes it new. He transforms our inadequacies and makes us worthy, not because we deserve it, but because he so identifies with us: ... he shall shepherd my people Israel (2 Samuel 5). What other god do we know that will stoop down to be among his people, to walk with his people, to suffer with his people, to redeem his people by his own death? I do not believe there is any other God in history like our God who is so accessible to his people and so desires to assure that no one is lost that he sends his son to witness to this imaginable gift of redemption by stretching his arms between heaven and earth so we will come to realize just how much he desires us, wants us, and is near to us like no other god. What a God we have. Unbelievable? No! It is believable because that is who our God is.



I can remember many of the exciting moments that seem to occur exclusively during the Month of November. Football, the potent aroma of cigars, the shopping bags that overflowed with food for our Thanksgiving gathering, and the special fragrance that permeated not only my senses, but the whole house. I can still visualize everyone in the kitchen preparing for Thanksgiving and the excitement of family conversations and laughter that resonated throughout the house. I can also recall how these moments were interrupted because it was time to go to church. I could never understand the reason God would want us to interrupt all these festivities to go to mass! My dad's response was always the same: We can always record the game, you and your friends can always play later, but remember, everything you want to do and have is possible because of the abundant harvest from God and it is appropriate that in the middle of all the excitement to take a moment to simply acknowledge the giver of our harvest!

I am sure that all the days up to Thanksgiving and Thanksgiving morning will be busy for all of us, yet it is appropriate to the midst of our business, that we take a moment and pause and acknowledge the giver of all gifts as a People of God. **So let us take a an hour and six minutes in the midst of our business of Thanksgiving Morning and gather at 9:00 AM to raise our voices in praise of our God whose blessing we have realized in the giftedness of each other and in the harvesting of God's grace poured into our lives in Jesus Christ. See you at mass!**

If Christ is the King of the Universe, which kingdom is his: Righteous or mercy? As we bring the Holy Year to a conclusion this question arises again as it did one year ago. Mercy is spiritually demanding which can easily offend even our own sense of fairness, but that is why we have journeyed through this past year as a Church and at Saint Angela Merici through the various reflections, prayers, mercy-opportunities, events, gatherings, and outreach not to merely "do mercy," but to be and become mercy. Are we more merciful today than when we gathered a year ago on December 6th 2015? Remember our church overflowed one year to the day. Hopefully, the symbol of "standing room only" in the church served as an impetus to enter into the ... heart of mercy during this Holy Year. **The Holy Year comes to a conclusion today, on the Feast of Christ the King of the Universe, but in the same way, when we initiated the Year of Mercy we have chosen to celebrate the end of the Year of Mercy at Saint Angela Merici on the Second Sunday of Advent, Sunday, December 4th at 9:30 AM. so our community can come together to close the Holy Year.** All the Fathers and Deacons as well as music groups, ministries, and students and parents will be participating in this special celebration. Our Parish School will host hospitality following Eucharist, and Youth Ministry will be providing a Winter Wonderland so we can enjoy each other's company with various activities and special games for our children. **Mark your calendars and celebrate with us the graces of this Year of Mercy at our 9:30 combined mass (9:30 & 11:15 AM combined) on Sunday, December 4th.**



Have a Go Bag ready if you have to shelter in place or evacuate your home. Your Go Bag can be part of your emergency kit, just make sure it is in a bag or easy to carry container and that it is easy to get to.

Think about these items for your Go Bag:

Battery powered radio and extra batteries, Flashlight with extra batteries, Lightweight blankets, Emergency information, including insurance policies, A list of medications and correct dosage, and doctor's names, Personal items such as toothbrushes, soap, extra glasses, etc., Whistle, First aid kit, Change of clothing, Non-perishable snacks, Books, cards or magazines to pass the time.

Consider these additional items for infants and children:

Baby formula and food, Diapers, Baby wipes, Blanket or toy

Consider these additional items for medical conditions:

Empty pill bottle(s) or a list of current medications and your doctor's phone number.

*Make sure you update your Go Bag when your medications change.

For pets:

Pet food & water, Collar with ID tags, Pet medication (s), Pet carriers and leashes, Medical records from vet, Photos of your pet, Microchip information.


