

Reflection

Jesus does not address the end of time (Matthew 24) in an attempt to frighten us or give us a reason to be worried, rather, it is more to remind us to be present to where we are that we might discover God in any given moment. The real challenge in our fast-moving, instant communication, quick solutions world is our willingness to pay any mind or attention to the present moment and to embrace what is before us. More often than not, we are one step ahead of ourselves and global worlds away. For instance, when we are home, at the office or at church or commuting, our minds and emotions are often going a mile a minute, focusing on what we have to do next, the day ahead, the tasks at the end of the week, or the worries that have not even materialized. How often have we driven on the freeway and then all of a sudden find ourselves "checking back into the moment" and realize that we were mentally in some other world while driving seventy-five miles an hour on the freeway!

The difficulty of living in the "other world of our minds" is what is actually present to us often slips by in a flash or an instant and rarely presents itself again. These lost opportunities pass us by in the blink of an eye and very often we miss the very thing we have longed or have searched for in the depths of our hearts. In today's Gospel, Jesus references Noah as an example of those lost opportune moments: *... as it was in the days of Noah, so it will be at the coming of the Son of Man ... they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, up to the day that Noah entered the ark. They did know until the flood came and carried them all away ...* (Matthew 24). Notice, Jesus does not say there may not have been warnings all around Noah's townsfolk. There could have been indications of impending danger; however, the people in Noah's time were so occupied and focused on other things that they literally became absorbed to the point that they were totally blinded to what was taking place in front of them (Matthew 24). The same is true for us. Fundamentally we are not always cognizant of what we are about to lose. It happens little by little. . We become "other focused" about situations, things, and people little by little. We lose touch little by little and sometimes we even become oblivious to God little by little. Like the people in Noah's time, so too for us, what we are losing sometimes can hardly be noticeable. Perhaps this is the tragedy. Once we finally realize what has been lost, it is sometimes very difficult, like the people of Noah's time to recover or escape what we have brought upon ourselves.

It is precisely in any given moment often unknown to us that God comes and breaks into our lives. The dawning of Advent asks us to simply stop what we are doing and to take notice of what is happening in us, around us, and with others and not fall into the trap of becoming ignorant to the NOW. If we are present to what is potentially imminent and try to embrace the gift of what is potentially being offered to us, if we try being where we are, then we will find ourselves in God's Time in which there is no need to fear when at last God comes or makes an appearance or when he makes himself known, or breaks into our lives, because it is precisely in that moment we have found ourselves ready right here, right now to embrace him! Is this not what Advent is really all about? Maranatha! Come, Lord Jesus!

The Year of Mercy

Into the Heart of Mercy

Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths ... (Matthew 3). This has been the strident invitation of John the Baptist for over two thousand years and was evident as Pope Francis articulated that the celebration of God's mercy would be local: Have people experience God's love in their parishes

and send them out into the world to commit random acts of mercy. The Pope had said he wanted the Holy Year to be a new step on the church's journey in her mission to bring the Gospel of mercy to each person. The Pope's constant refrain during the Year of Mercy was that no one is excluded from the mercy of God. All can be forgiven, the Pope taught over and over again, and once a person experiences just how loving and merciful God has been, they can in turn reach out to others with the same love and mercy. Pope Francis said: God is pleased by every act of mercy because in the brother or sister that we assist, we recognize the face of God which no one can see. Our encounter with John the Baptist year after year would not be necessary if our paths were made straight by mercy (Matthew 3). The Year of Mercy was an occasion to help people recognize how merciful God has been to them. In effect, Pope Francis was commissioning all Catholics to be missionaries of mercy. Preaching God's mercy has been a central focus of Pope Francis' ministry since his election in March 2013, and the closing of the Holy Door in St. Peter's Basilica will not end that focus.

Jesus is God's demonstration of mercy to us, as we are God's demonstration of mercy in our work, family, friends and those estranged or forgotten by others: ...welcome one another...as Christ welcomed you ... (Romans 15). It is our hope that this Year of Mercy has enabled us to undertake the mission of a radical mercy which the Gospel beckoned us to enter. If, the spirit of the Lord has rested on us this past year ... if we find ourselves not judging by appearance ... if justice is now the band on our waist ... if we are the avenue in which the wolf is the guest of the lamb (Isaiah 11), then be grateful. If we are just beginning to make our path straight, for after all it is the core of our life time journey of faith not a project or program, then be disciplined. May mercy that has been awakening in us in this special year continue to unfold fully within us. Now is the Time!

The Holy Year officially came to a conclusion on the Feast of Christ the King, but in the same way, when we initiated the Year of Mercy we have chosen to celebrate the close of the Year of Mercy at Saint Angela Merici on the Second Sunday of Advent, Sunday, December 4th at 9:30 AM (at a combined 9:30 and 11:15 mass) so our community can come together to close the Holy Year. Remember our church overflowed one year to the day on the Second Sunday of Advent 2015, a symbol of our willingness to enter into the ... Heart of Mercy during this past Holy Year. So let us come together once again and give thanks to God for his mercy..."which has been from of old."

Our Parish School will host hospitality following Eucharist, and Youth Ministry will be providing a Winter Wonderland so we can enjoy each other's company with various activities, special games and music for all to enjoy. **Mark your calendars and celebrate with us the graces of this Year of Mercy at our 9:30 combined mass (9:30 & 11:15 AM) next Sunday, December 4th.**

Think about these items for your Go Bag:

Battery powered radio and extra batteries, Flashlight with extra batteries, Lightweight blankets, Emergency information, including insurance policies, A list of medications and correct dosage, and doctor's names, Personal items such as toothbrushes, soap, extra glasses, etc., Whistle, First aid kit, Change of clothing, Non-perishable snacks, Books, cards or magazines to pass the time.

Consider these additional items for infants and children:

Baby formula and food, Diapers, Baby wipes, Blanket or toy

Consider these additional items for medical conditions:

Empty pill bottle(s) or a list of current medications and your doctor's phone number.

*Make sure you update your Go Bag when your medications change.

For pets:

Pet food & water, Collar with ID tags, Pet medication (s), Pet carriers and leashes, Medical records from vet, Photos of your pet, Microchip information.


