**FIRST SUNDAY
OF ADVENT**

DECEMBER 1, 2019



REFLECTION

The weeks leading up to Christmas are some of my favorite weeks of the year. You can feel a sense of joy and anticipation in the air. In Latin, Adventus means to await the arrival of someone or something of great importance. For us as Christian believers, Advent isn't just a time of waiting but it's also a time of preparation for the greatest gift our world and our hearts could ever receive.... the birth of Jesus Christ. With this in mind, Advent is a time we should be focusing on prayer, penance and longing for God. In our ancient Catholic tradition Advent isn't just a time of waiting and preparing for the birth of Jesus; it's also a time to prepare for the Second Coming of Christ in Glory. This theme is very present in our readings today.

In our first reading, Isaiah was prophesying at a particularly dark time for Israel and Judah. It was nearly eight centuries before the coming of the Messiah Jesus Christ. The chosen people were under attack from the Assyrians marching from their capital city of Nineveh in the north. What was to follow would be a long period of war, exile and bloodshed. The people of God were lost and gave into the despair of their difficulties. It was during this time of affliction that God intervened into their darkness to shine a message of hope to help the people keep the faith. Wars will end, the suffering will give way once more to glory, when swords would become plowshares and spears would be pruning hooks. Jerusalem will be restored, the Temple rebuilt and all nations shall stream toward it. God will bring good out of the darkness and the difficulties the people faced.

When Paul wrote to the Christians at Rome, for them it was also a time of darkness and uncertain futures. The Church was being persecuted in its infancy, something Paul knew well as he himself was once the cause of the Christian's pain. Like Isaiah, Paul points to a brighter future for those who endure the cross, for if they do, they will one day wear the crown of righteousness. He encourages the Christians in Rome to throw off the works of darkness and put on the armor of light because our salvation is nearer now than when we first believed. Again, God will bring good out of the darkness and the difficulties the Christians faced.

In today's Gospel from Matthew, Jesus is also facing a time of testing and challenge. The reading describes Wednesday of Holy Week. Where Jesus will soon experience betrayal and abandonment and will be put on trial, sentenced to die, and led out to the cross. Jesus and His followers were in a time of deep darkness and uncertain futures. In the midst of this horrible time, God brought good out of the darkness and the difficulties Jesus and His followers faced.

The same can be said for us today. Our suffering is earthly, but our hope is eternal. Advent calls us to put on the Lord Jesus Christ and let His light shine in us to light up the world. Jesus admonishes each of us to be awake and alert, preparing for His birth, the end of our lives, the end of the world, and his second coming in glory.

Let us use this Advent season wisely with prayer, penance, and longing for God, to prepare for the coming of Christ; if we do this then God will surely bring good out of the darkness and the difficulties of our lives and of our world.


