THE HOLY FAMILY OF JESUS, MARY, AND JOSEPH

DECEMBER 29, 2019



REFLECTION

The church dedicates the Sunday after Christmas to celebrate the Holy family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. When we hear the word "family," we automatically envision a father, a mother, and their children, as the title of the celebration indicates. All three readings of this Holy Family Sunday confirm this; however, we must also include the many kinds of family groupings present in society today. We see single mothers and fathers, grandparents, adoptive parents, siblings, aunts and uncles, and many other individuals raising children. If we look at family through the eyes of a child, we might see a different perspective of the structure of a family. We might see an aunt raising a child with love and care so the child sees the aunt as the mother figure. An orphan child might see an orphanage as home if they provide good and loving care to him or her. A good and healthy environment created by the people who love the child is what makes a child feel he or she has a family. Sadly, there are families who have a father and a mother who themselves are not healthy in mind and spirit, they neglect or even abuse their children. The structure of a family is not really based on the blood related title of father and mother, but based on the love and care provided for the child to grow. When God created Adam and Eve, He had no wife to help him to take care of them. God is a single parent. Christ never had a wife or children and yet, he had a big family of disciples and followers. Adults who love and care for children make them feel safe and wanted, no matter if they are blood relatives or not. Another instance of family may occur when a patient is diagnosed with cancer, and the doctors, oncologist, nurses, caregivers, and the entire medical community become the family of the cancer patient. They provide the love and care the patient needs and help them to feel a part of their family.

In the Gospel today, Joseph and Mary acted as the providers of love and care to the child, Jesus. Even though no dialogue or interaction among the Holy family was present in this Gospel of Matthew, we can imagine the love they had for Jesus. Joseph obeyed the angel and took Mary and Jesus to live in Egypt in order to keep him safe. Living in a foreign land like Egypt was not easy, not even in today's world. The language barrier, the cultural differences, and being discriminated against as a minority were all obstacles the Holy Family had to face and yet, difficult as it was, the parents brought Jesus out of harm's way to Egypt, to escape the slaughtering of the children in Bethlehem by Herod the Great. Egypt was also a difficult place to raise a Jewish child, as the customs the Jews practiced were very different than the customs in Egypt. An angel again appeared to Joseph and told him it was safe for the holy family to return to Israel because Herod had died. The prophecy Matthew mentioned, "Out of Egypt I call my son" was fulfilled. Bethlehem, located at the southern part of Israel, was very close to the border of Egypt, and just few hours walk to the temple of Jerusalem, which would have been a convenient place to settle down. For the sake of the child, however, Joseph and Mary decided to walk past Bethlehem and walk all the way up north to Nazareth at the other end of Israel, because the son of Herod was in control of Bethlehem at that time. Therefore, we hear Matthew quote the prophets, "he will be called a Nazorean," and the prophecy is fulfilled. We also see the love the parents had for Jesus and the sacrifices they made to provide him a safe place in which to grow up. The baby Jesus received so much love from his parents, and eventually, he was able to give the love back without reservation.

Finally, the parish is also a family providing spiritual comfort to all those who seek it. On this Holy Family Feast Day, we remember no matter who you are, or where you come from, opportunities are always present which allow you to give and receive love and care within this Holy Family of Jesus Christ.




