REFLECTION

The Gospel of this Sunday describes for us how Jesus began his mission in Galilee, a region distant from the capital of Judea. It was a land full of pagan people, those who did not live in conformity with the faith of the Hebrew people. Additionally, it was a region surrounded by people completely separated from Jewish customs. Saint Matthew wants to reaffirm Jesus is the Messiah of all people and not solely of the Hebrew communities. He is bringing salvation which is capable of removing barriers amongst peoples and embraces all people of the world. The presence of Jesus in Galilee represents, for the Evangelist, a fulfillment of the splendid prophetic vision announced by the prophet Isaiah.

The light will conquer the darkness; where there is death there will be life again. The world of Jesus, announces the presence of God in the life of the people and, at the same time, it has the power of liberating us from all forms of oppression and slavery, which tend to dominate, subject and separate us from God.

The message of Jesus includes the call to conversion as a preparation for the arrival of the Kingdom of Heaven. The news is always good because it fills with Joy the hearts ready to receive God. The Kingdom of God is the very God who intervenes and manifest himself in favor of his people. God loves us so much; his love for us overflows in the person of his beloved Son.

The arrival of the Kingdom of God moves us to conversion to God: To listen with faith, to look at his works of a life of grace, to return our gaze and our affection upon in Him. Once the believer is set upon the road of conversion, then, the voice of Christ resonates again, saying: "Follow me." Conversion means to make ourselves attentive disciples of Jesus Christ, and it is for this reason we follow him, as did the first Apostles. The voice of Christ resonates at some point of our lives and will resonate once again when, at the end of our lives, he calls us to Eternity.

My brothers and sisters in Christ may Almighty God bless us in this new year. May this new year be a year of blessings for all of you and your families.






