PRESENTATION OF THE LORD

FEBRUARY 2, 2020



REFLECTION

Doesn't it seem odd and out of sequence to be celebrating the Presentation of the baby Jesus? Why, just several weeks ago we celebrated the adult Jesus being baptized by John, the beginning of his public ministry and the calling of his first disciples. Well this is where knowledge of Jewish custom and history helps us understand this momentary shift out of Ordinary Time and back to a feast. The Gospel says, when the days were completed for their purification, according to the law of Moses, Mary and Joseph took Jesus up to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord. Mosaic Law set this time of purification as 40 days after the birth of a male child, and today is 40 days, inclusive, after Christmas, the birth of Jesus. As their firstborn and only son, Jesus is consecrated to the Lord, and while this does not have to take place in a temple, Mary and Joseph took Jesus to the Temple in Jerusalem for this purpose. The symbolism of this ought not to be lost on us. In bringing Jesus to the Temple, his parents are giving back the very gift God has given them. This gesture of whole-hearted thanksgiving to God, therefore, becomes the pattern of salvation and the way of all Christian living. This newborn child, the Father's gift to creation, will in turn offer his whole life back to God in another act of sacrificial self-giving at Calvary. The child who is presented in the Temple of Jerusalem will one day die in this same city, destroying this Temple and raising a new one.

Often, I will pose the question of why, we as Catholic's, bless everything with Holy Water? We bless homes, cars, animals, the very dirt we're buried in, and we bless ourselves.... Why? Because we're doing exactly what Mary and Joseph did when they presented their Son in the Temple. We're acknowledging everything God gives us is a gift.... From our children to our cars, homes, etc., and yes, the very breath we breathe. Everything is a gift from God, and for this, we say.... Thank you for your goodness of giving us this beautiful gift.

I had the privilege of getting to know Kobe and his girls at my first assignment in Newport Beach. I got to know them at a personal level and as friends. When I heard of Gianna and her Dad's passing, I thought to myself, this just isn't the way it's supposed to be. Gianna was so young and Kobe so much bigger than life. This just isn't the way things should go in life. I, like many, felt such a sadness in hearing of their passing.

Well, today we celebrate the Presentation of Jesus. Jesus is the very gift of God to us, long promised through the words of Malachi: the one who will fill the Temple with the very presence of God. This is not just any divine revelation, for Jesus loves us so much He shares with us our human condition, with all its trials and temptations; making him a true light and hope for all humanity. When we reflect on the life and death of Jesus, we can feel sad at His passing at a very young age. We can say to ourselves it's not supposed to happen this way. Jesus, a man filled with such love and compassion.... and so much bigger than life. The death of Jesus just shouldn't happen in such a way. The glory of our faith is God, who makes good come from our losses. For all humanity the door to our eternal salvation has been opened for us by the death and resurrection of Jesus.

On this Feast of the Presentation of Jesus we all say thank you God for the life, death, and resurrection of your Son. Thank you, God, for all the gifts you've blest us with. And, thank you, God, for all our loved ones who have died too young and were bigger than life. Thank you, Jesus, for all your gifts to us.

VALENTINE'S WEEKEND


When was the last time you and your spouse went on a date?
