## SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

It's wonderful to be with you again and I'm so thankful for the privilege and grace in praying with you today.

We've been in this awful pandemic at least seven or eight weeks now. There's really no place to go. Even if you are working outside of the house, it's straight home after work; other than stopping somewhere to get food to go, which is usually cold by the time you get home. If you and I are at home, we're home pretty much all the time, even with a walk or two a day. Even with Zoom, where we can talk to our friends and our family, it's not normal, not natural, weird, sad, and we are just living through it.

For many of us, we are getting stir-crazy, cranky, impatient, and irritable with each other. Many of us are down-right afraid. We're afraid we'll catch the virus, loose our jobs and benefits; we're afraid someone close to us will get sick. It is just a rotten time right now. Still, in all of this, Jesus gives us an opportunity to be with him, inside us to our very core. Jesus tells us if we love him, we will keep his commandments. We will love the Lord our God with all our hearts, and all our soul, and all our strength. We will love our neighbor as ourselves, whoever the neighbor is, whether it's a person down the block or the person in the next room in our house. The love we express when it pertains to others as well as to God is holy love and therefore, those we love who are with us (day in and day out), are holy as well. Whether they are actually holy or not is not for us to determine; we are not to judge them, we are to love them with a sacred and holy love, as Jesus is holy and as Jesus loves.

Jesus tells his disciples he will send them another Advocate, besides himself, to live in them, to enable them to walk the journey as Jesus walked the journey, as Jesus walked the Way of the Cross; to walk the journey every day with us. We know this because our relationship with Jesus grows every day, even when we don't know it. Why? Because the Holy Spirit is inside us, at our core, in every part of our being. The Holy Spirit is pleading with Jesus, every minute or every day, for us to love and be holy.

How are we to love our neighbors more: for one thing, let's pray for each other. We really need each other's prayers right now. We need to stand together right now; let's do it through prayer. Secondly, and this is important, when it comes to those darned masks, let's make sure we wear them when we go outside. If I'm wearing my mask, I'm not protecting myself from you, I'm protecting YOU from me. This is a Christ-like action! Whether we agree this virus is serious or a made-up lie, let's do this for others. Let's do it because Christ Jesus lives inside us and cares for others through us.

May our loving Lord Jesus, who lives in us with his Spirit and the Father, guide us to love others this week. May he bless and keep you,

Luke Rivera, a member of the Youth Ministry, a senior at Bishop Amat High School, and alumnus from St. Angela School, is proud to announce he has been selected to be a NET missionary in the upcoming year. NET Ministries is a National Evangelization Team made up of over 175 Catholic young adults who give nine months of their life traveling across the United States sharing the gospel with young people and their families. Since 1981, NET teams have led over 34,000 retreats and ministered to more than 2.1 million young Catholics, including our own middle school students. 

# CORONAVIRUS: KNOW HOW IT SPREADS

There is currently no vaccine to prevent coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19). **The best way to prevent illness is to avoid being exposed to this virus.** The virus is thought to spread mainly from person-to-person. Between people who are in close contact with one another (within about 6 feet). Through respiratory droplets produced when an infected person coughs, sneezes or talks. These droplets can land in the mouths or noses of people who are nearby or possibly be inhaled into the lungs. Some recent studies have suggested that COVID-19 may be spread by people who are not showing symptoms.

## **Clean your hands often**

Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds especially after you have been in a public place, or after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing. If soap and water are not readily available, use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol. Cover all surfaces of your hands and rub them together until they feel dry.

- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Avoid close contact
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick
- Stay home as much as possible
- Put distance between yourself and other people.
- Remember that some people without symptoms may be able to spread virus.



Keeping distance from others is especially important for people who are at higher risk of getting very sick.

## **Cover your mouth and nose with a cloth face cover when around others**

- You could spread COVID-19 to others even if you do not feel sick.
- Everyone should wear a cloth face cover when they have to go out in public, for example to the grocery store or to pick up other necessities.
- Cloth face coverings should not be placed on young children under age 2, anyone who has trouble breathing, or is unconscious, incapacitated or otherwise unable to remove the mask without assistance.
- The cloth face cover is meant to protect other people in case you are infected.
- Do NOT use a facemask meant for a healthcare worker.
- Continue to keep about 6 feet between yourself and others. The cloth face cover is not a substitute for social distancing.



## **Cover coughs and sneezes**

- If you are in a private setting and do not have on your cloth face covering, remember to always cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when you cough or sneeze or use the inside of your elbow.
- Throw used tissues in the trash.
- Immediately wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not readily available, clean your hands with a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol.



## **Clean and disinfect**

- Clean AND disinfect frequently touched surfaces daily. This includes tables, doorknobs, light switches, countertops, handles, desks, phones, keyboards, toilets, faucets, and sinks.
- If surfaces are dirty, clean them. Use detergent or soap and water prior to disinfection. Then, use a household disinfectant. Most common disinfectants will work.


