We need men and women ages 18- 65 to help us sanitize the church after Masses, ushers to queue up guests and escort them in and out of the church, lectors to read, and Eucharistic Ministers to serve communion at various locations on the church grounds. If you want to help as a Eucharistic Minister, please contact **Steve Allevato, (714) 746-3677**, to help as an Usher, please contact **Tony Samaniego, (562) 706-2586**, and to help as a team member to disinfect the church please contact **Rodger Huber, (714) 335-5539**. Training will be provided. Thank you in advance for your service.

Please join us for our **Pentecost Drive-Thru Blessing in the Church parking lot**. Pentecost is the 3rd most important Feast Day behind Easter and Christmas. So please come to our Pentecost Drive-Thru to receive a special blessing on **Sunday, May 31 from 10 am to 12 noon**. The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed as the clergy bless you and your family.

Safety protocols will be forthcoming on re-opening our Church. For the first several weeks there will be a limit on the number of people who can attend. Of course, if you have a fever, flu, or cold like symptoms please stay home. Everyone, except priests, are still dispensed from their Sunday obligation to attend Mass. Wearing a mask and washing your hands before attending Mass will be required.

PENTECOST SUNDAY

Happy Feast of Pentecost! Pentecost Sunday is a wonderful day to rejoice in the power of the Lord! We celebrate the birth of our Church, and the readings show us God's powerful manifestations: a strong, driving wind; tongues as of fire; the ability of the disciples to speak to people in their own languages. With the power of the Holy Spirit lives are changed, fear-filled disciples are transformed into bold preachers. Pentecost is also a great day to challenge ourselves. In the past several weeks, we have commemorated the passion and death of Jesus and celebrated his Resurrection, his appearances in a glorified body to the disciples, his ascension into heaven, and now his sending of the Holy Spirit in great power.

The key question is what do we do with God's power in our lives? We know there are different kinds of spiritual gifts but the same Spirit; there are different forms of service but the same Lord. To each individual the manifestation of the Spirit is given for some benefit. And all of these have one thing in common: they are to be used to build up the Body, the Church, and in turn to fulfill the Church's mission. The mission is the proclamation of Jesus as Lord and of the love God has for each of us, as shown to us through our Lord Jesus Christ. By faith and through the power of the Holy Spirit, we all have the basic gift Paul mentions in his letter: The realization and the ability to say Jesus is Lord. This is the foundation of being a Christian. Grace and discernment help us own the gifts we have been given and make an effort to use them for God's glory and the sake of the kingdom.

One of the challenges to knowing and growing in the Gifts of the Holy Spirit is we tend to become complacent in our faith and hold on to things which can become road blocks to the Holy Spirit. It's always good to ask the Holy Spirit to reveal such road blocks to us. What are the road blocks we're holding on to? If we were to entrust them to God's transformative power, God might return to us as something new and greater than we could ever imagine. I always encourage people to place whatever fear, unforgiveness, brokenness, shame, sin, or grief we're dealing with on the Altar with the bread and the wine so it might also be transformed. As the old saying goes, things grow better, bigger, deeper, and stronger in soil that's been broken open. Today's a great opportunity to break open our hearts to God's transforming power.

Your gifts and talents are more important today than ever. Example: in the past much of the heavy lifting here at St. Angela's has been done by people who are retired. Well guess what? It's those same people who are now considered part of the population most vulnerable to the Corona virus and need to stay home. You know what that means? It's time for you to step up to the plate. St Angela's needs your help. Our church plans on re-opening for public Masses on June 13, and we need the help of a number of dedicated parishioners to implement necessary safety protocols. 



WORK, SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY: GIVE EMERGENCY KITS TO PEOPLE WHO COUNT ON YOU (COLLEGE STUDENTS, ELDERLY PARENTS, ETC.)

Put together basic emergency kits for people who may not be able to do so for themselves or for those who may not think of doing it for themselves. Show them what is in the kit and talk to them about disasters.

Make sure the kit meets their specific needs. For instance, if someone takes prescription medicine, include a list of medications and dosages. For a college student, make sure the kit is small enough to store in the space they have available.

College Students

Talk to your college student about how you will stay in touch if a disaster occurs. Make sure they understand cell phones may not work during a disaster. Choose an emergency contact who does not live near you or the college. Arrange with your student to call that person if they cannot reach you during a disaster.

Visit the website for your student's college to find out about the school's disaster plans and procedures. Some colleges will provide a phone number that you can call in an emergency. If you don't find the number on the website, call the admissions office and ask. Add the number to your emergency contact list. Make sure your student knows to call you if there is an emergency on campus. Also, ensure your student is registered for any emergency notification system on their campus.

Insurance

Talk to your insurance agent to find out if your policy covers your student's belongings while they are away at school. You may need to buy an additional renter's policy. Also check with your health insurance carrier to find out where your student can find covered healthcare at school.
