ASCENSION OF THE LORD

Jesus returns to the father and leaves his disciples to continue the work he began. He promises to send them the Holy Spirit to guide them in their mission. In the Acts of the Apostles, Jesus is asked whether he is going to restore the kingdom of Israel to which he replies it is not for them to know the time which the father had determined; they must patiently wait for the coming of the Holy Spirit.

The early disciples of Jesus had some pretty big questions as they journeyed with Jesus and got to know him better. They heard him preach. They saw him heal. They heard him tell some unusual stories in unexpected ways. They saw him comfort, admonish, challenge and cry. The disciples heard a lot of "God" talk and descriptions of the "kingdom," which wasn't like anything they had ever known. Finally, one of the most divine and miraculous things they witnessed was their Lord dying and coming back to life. In one sense, it clarified for them Jesus was not "ordinary." They knew he was special, but now he was a special in ways they couldn't quite wrap their minds around. What did his resurrection really mean? What were they supposed to make of it and how were they to understand it? Was this just another one of Jesus' miracles, or was it more? They wondered and witnessed what we are celebrating today - Jesus Ascension.

The Ascension did not answer all of their questions, which would be impossible, it did however confirm one deeply profound reality: Jesus had come from God, and was returning to God. In other words, his "rightful place" was with God. His "eternal destination" was the same place from where he had come. Perhaps, for the first time, they began to truly believe this was each of their destinies as well; maybe, one day, what happened to Jesus would happen for them. In a very real sense, this was confirmation there was more to reality than what they could simply see, feel and touch. They came from God and maybe one day would return to him, just as Jesus had.

Do we believe the same? I know we SAY we believe those same things, but do we live as though we do or, do we live as if this is all there is, as if the goal of each human life is to simply get all we can with no real purpose, direction, or destination? It takes real faith not only to believe in Heaven, but to live in the light of this truth. It's often easier to focus on the immediate and not consider a bigger picture. Jesus' Ascension challenges us to always see our lives as a journey with a particular destination; one prepared for us by our God who loves us more than we can imagine. My friends, knowing precisely where we are going just might help us place our feet on Jesus' path, the path of love, kindness, mercy, and generosity, which will take us where we need to be, where God wants us to be, and where we were born to be. Only Jesus can show us the way.

My brothers and sisters may Almighty God guide us and protect us from this virus and relieve us from the burden, however we were affected by it and keep safe. May you all have a blessed week.

Luke Rivera, a member of the Youth Ministry, a senior at Bishop Amat High School, and alumnus from St. Angela School, is proud to announce he has been selected to be a NET missionary in the upcoming year. NET Ministries is a National Evangelization Team made up of over 175 Catholic young adults who give nine months of their life traveling across the United States sharing the gospel with young people and their families. They do this through leading retreats for middle and high school students. Since 1981, NET teams have led over 34,000 retreats and ministered to more than 2.1 million young Catholics, including our own middle school students. This is where Luke first found his inspiration to join. He plans to attend the University of Portland (Catholic University) or APU when he returns. Please pray for him and all missionaries.



CORONAVIRUS: KNOW HOW IT SPREADS

There is currently no vaccine to prevent coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19). **The best way to prevent illness is to avoid being exposed to this virus.** The virus is thought to spread mainly from person-to-person. Between people who are in close contact with one another (within about 6 feet). Through respiratory droplets produced when an infected person coughs, sneezes or talks. These droplets can land in the mouths or noses of people who are nearby or possibly be inhaled into the lungs. Some recent studies have suggested that COVID-19 may be spread by people who are not showing symptoms.

Clean your hands often

Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds especially after you have been in a public place, or after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing. If soap and water are not readily available, use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol. Cover all surfaces of your hands and rub them together until they feel dry.



- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Avoid close contact
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick
- Stay home as much as possible
- Put distance between yourself and other people.
- Remember that some people without symptoms may be able to spread virus.

Keeping distance from others is especially important for people who are at higher risk of getting very sick.

Cover your mouth and nose with a cloth face cover when around others

- You could spread COVID-19 to others even if you do not feel sick.
- Everyone should wear a cloth face cover when they have to go out in public, for example to the grocery store or to pick up other necessities.
- Cloth face coverings should not be placed on young children under age 2, anyone who has trouble breathing, or is unconscious, incapacitated or otherwise unable to remove the mask without assistance.
- The cloth face cover is meant to protect other people in case you are infected.
- Do NOT use a facemask meant for a healthcare worker.
- Continue to keep about 6 feet between yourself and others. The cloth face cover is not a substitute for social distancing.



Cover coughs and sneezes

- If you are in a private setting and do not have on your cloth face covering, remember to always cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when you cough or sneeze or use the inside of your elbow.
- Throw used tissues in the trash.
- Immediately wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not readily available, clean your hands with a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol.



Clean and disinfect

- Clean AND disinfect frequently touched surfaces daily. This includes tables, doorknobs, light switches, countertops, handles, desks, phones, keyboards, toilets, faucets, and sinks.
- If surfaces are dirty, clean them. Use detergent or soap and water prior to disinfection. Then, use a household disinfectant. Most common disinfectants will work.


