

PARISH UPDATE

Dear friends,

Due to the dramatic rise in Covid 19 cases, our Governor has asked places of worship to postpone indoor services. This includes Sunday Mass in the Church, weekday Mass in the Hall, and Confessions. Please remember you are not required to attend Mass; Bishop Vann has granted dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass until further notice. We will continue to do our best to live stream the Sunday 7:45am Mass with drive up Communion being available twice on Sunday.

Please note: Drive up Communion will only be available on Sunday from 10:00 to 10:15am and 5 to 5:15pm.

Drive up Communion: Everyone is encouraged to view the weekend Mass on-line and then drive to St Angela's to receive Holy Communion. Just pull into the parking lot and park near the lunch table area. When the Eucharistic Minister arrives, get out of your vehicle and follow the directions of the usher. Before receiving Communion, please sanitize your hands, then receive the Host in your hand and step six feet aside before lifting your mask to consume the consecrated Host. To avoid the potential spread of the Covid Virus reception of Communion on the tongue is discouraged. Holy Communion must be consumed immediately after receiving. Please exit the parking lot onto Fir and not Walnut.

Please join our Ignite Youth Ministry for an outdoor Mass and Adoration on the school field this Sunday, July 19th at 5:00pm. There's plenty of room to physically distance so invite your family and friends. Our Youth Band will lead us for Mass and Adoration. Please bring a lawn chair.



SUNDAY REFLECTION

First, I want to take this opportunity to say "THANK YOU" to the countless people who followed all the State, County, and Diocesan requirements to create a safe environment in our church. 100% of those attending Mass had their masks on, hands were constantly being sanitized, people were maintaining safe distancing, the pews were being disinfected after every Mass, and we followed the directions of the ushers who ensured our safety. We had cones up to separate foot traffic, floor arrows and stop signs, attendance cards, singing restrictions and the list goes on of all the safety precautions we put in place and followed. So "THANK YOU", I'm very proud of the good people of St Angela's. Sometimes in life we can follow all the rules and be frustrated others aren't as careful or safety minded. In today's Gospel Jesus addresses this very issue. In life there will be weeds planted amongst the wheat.

In Matthew's Gospel, Jesus shares the parable of the sower who grows wheat in his field alongside weeds planted by his enemy. Rather than pulling out the weeds and risking harm to his wheat, the sower allows them to grow up together, patiently waiting for harvest time to separate them. Growing in faith is like being in this field, living among a mix of weeds and wheat. We strive to grow up as wheat, bearing the fruit of faith, hope, and love. But we are surrounded by weeds that feed on hatred, division, despair, and deceit. In our weakness, we may be tempted to grow like the weeds. But we are not weeds! We are planted by the master sower to grow up as wheat. We are his wheat! We are children of God. But when we forget who's we are or fail to do the good, when the weeds of sin entangle and overwhelm us, God is patient and kind to us. God is always at work in our lives even when we do not even know how to pray, when our weakness in whatever form is overcoming us, the Spirit moves in and takes over. St. Paul understands well the power and centrality of the Holy Spirit in the life of the Christian. The real message of this reading is we should be patient with ourselves and others, because even at our worst moments the Holy Spirit is there guiding us, acting in us, bringing us along, though we may not recognize His action or presence in our lives.

God governs his growing field with clemency. In his mercy, he chooses not to separate the righteous from the evildoers until the end of the age. Every moment until then is an opportunity to grow in a state of grace, and to repent and turn back to God when we have failed. He sends his Spirit to intercede for us and come to the aid of our weakness. Under the care of God, who lovingly nurtures us through the Word and Sacraments, we will grow to bear good fruit, worthy of his harvest. The weeds in our lives will see the good we do and by the example of our good words and works the weeds will be converted and transformed into life giving wheat.

God, the sower, has been so very patient and merciful with us to the point we've become good, life giving wheat and now it's up to us to do the same for the weeds in our lives.




