

NEW MASS TIMES!

Based on the results of our first outdoor field Mass and feedback I've received, our new Sunday Mass schedule will be: **9:00am outdoor field Mass, 10am drive up Communion and a 6:00pm outdoor field Mass.** Please wear your mask, keep social distancing, and bring a lawn chair, hat/umbrella and sunscreen. Thanks to Rodger Huber, Natalie Espada, David Lanzarin and our Youth Ministry team who did such an awesome job with our first outdoor field Mass. It was a great success with over 200 people in attendance. And a big thanks to Angela and Robert Amparano for setting up their canopies for us to use.

Drive up Communion:

Please note: Drive up Communion will be available on Sunday from 10:00 to 10:15am. View Mass online and then drive to St Angela's to receive Holy Communion. Just pull into the parking lot and park near the lunch table area. When the Eucharistic Minister arrives, get out of your vehicle and follow the directions of the usher. Before receiving Communion, please sanitize your hands, then receive the Host in your hand and step six feet aside before lifting your mask to consume the consecrated Host. To avoid the potential spread of the Covid Virus, reception of Communion on the tongue is discouraged. We will continue to do our best to live stream Mass at 7:45am.



SUNDAY REFLECTION

What aspects of the Kingdom of God do the parables of this Sunday want to teach us? What decisions, what concrete behavior does the evangelist St. Matthew have in mind? In Palestine, the land of Jesus, people frequently experience the discovery of hidden treasures. Property owners will bury their treasures in times of war, and because of the usual sacking of property and values that followed, they died without revealing to their families and friends the location where their hidden wealth was buried.

The kingdom of heaven is like a treasure buried in a field, which a person finds and hides again, and out of joy goes and sells all that he has and buys that field. The message of the parable this Sunday is very clear: The kingdom of God possesses a supreme value, a priceless magnitude, and a unique importance. It is worth any sacrifice, and all renunciation of wealth and status to form part of this kingdom. The Gospel underscores the immediate, good, and radical decision to acquire the newly discovered treasure, sacrificing all things in favor of new wealth. The importance is not in the sacrifice involving in the decision, but in the joy and final result of the discovery and now as one's possession.

Jesus is inviting us to ask ourselves what hidden possessions we have in our lives. Answering that question is not always easy, not readily put into words (especially if we are being completely honest). One thing seems to be clear though. The reality is, many of us experience a certain dissatisfaction regarding our lives. Things haven't always gone as we had planned. For many of us, disappointment has crept into areas of our lives where we wish it was completely absent. Our relationship isn't perfect. Our families aren't perfect. Our jobs aren't perfect. We aren't perfect. This dissatisfaction can often cause us to be somewhat restless. We don't always know what the one thing is, don't really know how to make things better, don't know exactly what will make the biggest difference in the way we experience life. All we know is there has to be something better out there somewhere. What it is, we are not exactly sure.

What do we discover? Nothing in particular. No surprise there. What did we expect to happen? As you've heard me say many times before, not much happens in the spiritual life by accident. It just doesn't work that way. Rather, authentic life of faith requires a certain kind of intention, a certain kind of focus, a certain kind of wisdom; the kind of wisdom which provides us with a clear understanding of what we are (or should be) looking for. Of course, that "thing" isn't a thing at all. It is leaving God. Solomon seems to have known these at the same implicit level as we just heard in our first reading from the Book of Kings. When God requests something of him, promising to give back, Solomon asks for an understanding heart, so he will be a good ruler. Notice that he doesn't ask for something outside of himself. He doesn't ask for a particular outcome in battle, or riches, or that he will rule forever. He simply asked to be a better person. God, in return, grants his request. Anytime we are asking to be changed from the inside, anytime we are asking for some good attribute or attitude or disposition, what we are really asking for is God. God is the source of all that is good. When Solomon asks God for wisdom, what he's really doing is inviting God in. Inviting God in, to shape his heart and mind and thoughts. Put another way Solomon seems to want God to work within him, not for him. This makes all the difference.

My friends, we are asking to consider two important questions today; questions which aren't hypothetical, but which have real consequences for our lives. These questions truly matter. We ask ourselves, what do we treasure above all else? Where should we look to discover that treasure? If our sincere answer to the first question is God, then the very first place we need to look is within. Once we find him, once we allow him to come alive within each of us, we will begin to discover him everywhere in every person and every situation. When that happens, absolutely everything changes; we will come to realize a better life awaits us not when the world around us changes, but when we do. What exactly are we looking for? Hopefully, there is only one answer, someone rather than something in particular.




