

We will start celebrating Mass in the plaza on Wednesday's at 8:00am and 6:00pm. Confessions are at the usual time, 3:30pm Saturday, in the plaza area.

In August, we will have 5 outdoor field Masses for children making their First Holy Communion and in September 2 outdoor Masses for teens making their Sacrament of Confirmation. A recent donation was made to upgrade our field fencing and to that end work has begun. In today's world the security of our children is paramount. This is a great step in the right direction.

The long awaited church lighting project is almost complete. This project was paid for by 2018 school auction and PSA designated funds. Thanks Bill Morgan for all your hard work.

Sunday Mass Times

Our new Sunday Mass schedule is: **7:45am live stream on line Mass, 9:00am outdoor field Mass, 10am drive up Communion, 10:30am Spanish outdoor field Mass and a 6:00pm outdoor field Mass.** Please bring a lawn chair, hat, umbrella, easy up, sunscreen, etc. You can also tune into St Angela's field Masses on the FM dial at 106.9. The field Masses will be broadcast live to cars in the parking lot. Listen to our field Mass in the safety of your vehicle and then come up and receive Holy Communion on the field or at our drive up communion at 10am.

Drive up Communion:

Please note: Drive up Communion will only be available on Sunday from 10:00 to 10:15am. View Mass online and then drive to St Angela's to receive Holy Communion. Just pull into the parking lot and park near the lunch table area. When the Eucharistic Minister arrives, get out of your vehicle and follow the directions of the ushers.

Please remember you are not required to attend Mass; Bishop Vann has granted dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass until further notice. At all times please wear your mask, keep social distancing, and before receiving Communion, please sanitize your hands, then receive the Host in your hand and step six feet aside before lifting your mask to consume the consecrated Host.

SUNDAY REFLECTION

In the 1980's and 1990's, there was a morning radio show called the Ken and Bob Company. It was a funny talk show and for many, it was fun to listen to on the way to work. It was intended to start your workday on a good level. They had a saying that was abbreviated, "EGBOK" and it stood for "Everything's going to be OK." I hear that every so often, everything's going to be ok or everything's going to be alright. You know, we want to hear that. We want to hear that from God who even tells us in today's Gospel, "Do not be afraid."

Almost a week ago, an earthquake centered under our neighbor, Yorba Linda, and shook us a little bit. When there have been larger earthquakes that really do shake us up, we always ask God to make the earth 'calm down', to make everything alright so our little world will not come undone, so we are safe and sound.

What does Jesus ask of his disciples? He asks them to get in their boat and set sail to the other side of the Sea of Galilee so Jesus could have time alone with his Father in prayer. This is a typical place for Jesus to find his Father in prayer; in peaceful quiet. The disciples did as Jesus asked them and set sail at night. By the time the disciples were a few miles from shore, a huge storm hit. Matthew writes the boat "was being tossed about by the waves, for the wind was against it." Scripture scholars tell us the line "for the wind was against it," represents the hostile forces of the world. The waves were considered the waves of death. These disciples were scared out of their minds.

For the last six months, our whole world has turned upside down with the pandemic and everything it brings with it: sickness and death, economic disaster, having to wear masks everywhere we go, not to get close to anyone and not being able to come and celebrate the Mass like we used to celebrate. We keep seeing the numbers of those who have contracted the virus and those who have died increasing.

What is Jesus asking of us? First, what did he ask of Peter? Jesus told Peter to "Take Courage, it is I; do not be afraid." Peter then does the unthinkable: he challenges Jesus to prove who he is. Jesus says "Come." But Peter falls apart and sinks. Jesus saves him, despite Peter's challenge, he saves everyone on the boat. What about us? Jesus calls us to take care of each other, even with social distancing, to wear our masks so we don't get others sick and so we don't get sick. But more than anything, he calls us with the courage the Holy Spirit gives us, to check in on those who are alone, who are afraid, who have lost their jobs. He calls us to go the extra mile with all who are in our world.

Jesus calls us to come out of our comfort zone, when everything looks hopeless, and believe; with commitment and being willing to take a risk. Let's pray for others who are sick, who don't believe and who need to feel the love and strength of our Lord Jesus. May we be our Lord Jesus to them.


DIOCESE OF ORANGE CHURCH AID

MAKE A PLAN: PLAN WHAT TO DO IF YOU HAVE TO EVACUATE.

Choose two places for your family to meet.

- ◆ One place should be right outside your home in case of a sudden emergency, such as a fire. The other should be outside of your neighborhood, in case you cannot return home or are asked to evacuate.
- ◆ Decide where you would go and what route you would take to get there. You may choose to go to a hotel, stay with friends or family in a safe location, or go to a shelter.

Hold evacuation drills at home. Practice getting out of the house quickly, and drive your planned evacuation route. The more you practice, the more confident you will be if you really have to evacuate.


Plan ahead for your pets.

Due to health concerns, pets are not allowed in Red Cross shelters. Keep a phone list of pet-friendly hotels and animal shelters along your evacuation route in case a designated pet shelter is not available. Contact your local humane society or animal shelter to ask if pet emergency shelters will be opened in a disaster.
