

Drive up Communion will be available from 10:00 to 10:15am.** Please bring a lawn chair, hat, umbrella, easy up, sunscreen, etc. You can also tune into St. Angela's field Masses on the FM dial at 106.9. The field Masses will be broadcast live to cars in the parking lot. Listen to our field Mass in the safety of your vehicle and then come up and receive Holy Communion on the field or at our drive up communion at 10am.

At all times please wear your mask, keep social distancing, and before receiving Communion, please sanitize your hands, then receive the Host in your hand and step six feet aside before lifting your mask to consume the consecrated Host.



SUNDAY REFLECTION

Matthew's Gospel begins with Jesus' genealogy tracing his Jewish heritage. Most of the ancestors who are listed are men except for Mary, the mother of Jesus. In addition, Matthew slips in four other women: Tamar, Rahab, Ruth, and Bathsheba. These women played significant roles in the history of Israel even though they were not of Jewish origin. Matthew's community was largely made up of Jewish Christians but included a small part of the community who were Gentiles. Undoubtedly, the Jewish Christians considered themselves in a better position; as Matthew mentioned Jesus was sent only to the lost sheep of the house of Israel.

In today's Gospel, Matthew first made the Jewish community feel superior by showing Jesus referred to the food "of the children" as the children of Israel and referred to the Gentile woman as lowly as a dog, when he said, "and throw it to the dogs." Some interpreters attempt to soften this statement by the translation of the Greek word used (kynaria) which means puppies and not a dog. I am not sure if a person would feel any better if you called him or her a slob but added an adjective such as "cute" or "nice" in front of the insulting word.

Nevertheless, the woman replied to Jesus, "Please, Lord, for even the dogs eat the scraps that fall from the table of their masters." Jesus said to this Canaanite woman, "Great is your faith! Let it be done for you as you wish." The woman's daughter was healed from that hour. Jesus was showing the disciples and all others the universalism of faith. Belief in Jesus as Lord was no longer just for the "lost children of Israel" but for all peoples including Gentiles. God's love and care extends beyond the boundaries of race and nation, and into the hearts of all who live.

Two thousand years later, we are still struggling with the race issue, not only in the United States, but around the world. It seems that it is our human nature to revere those who are above us and step on those who are already on the floor. Do we need others to flatter us first, like Matthew's Gospel, before realizing we are all equal?

MAKE A PLAN: PLAN WHAT TO DO IF YOU HAVE TO EVACUATE.

Choose two places for your family to meet.

- ◆ One place should be right outside your home in case of a sudden emergency, such as a fire. The other should be outside of your neighborhood, in case you cannot return home or are asked to evacuate.
- ◆ Decide where you would go and what route you would take to get there. You may choose to go to a hotel, stay with friends or family in a safe location, or go to a shelter.

Hold evacuation drills at home. Practice getting out of the house quickly, and drive your planned evacuation route. The more you practice, the more confident you will be if you really have to evacuate.

Plan ahead for your pets.

Due to health concerns, pets are not allowed in Red Cross shelters. Keep a phone list of pet-friendly hotels and animal shelters along your evacuation route in case a designated pet shelter is not available. Contact your local humane society or animal shelter to ask if pet emergency shelters will be opened in a disaster.
