

WELCOME TO OUR NEW PRINCIPAL

Dear St. Angela Merici Community,

I am very honored yet humbled to be your new St. Angela Merici Parish school principal. I am blessed to join the St. Angela Merici family, dedicated to a legacy of building community, celebrating through worship, and serving others. Rest assured I share your commitment to providing all St. Angela students with opportunities for high achievement within a secure and loving environment.

I return to St. Angela Merici Parish school again having once been a parent, a teacher, and part of the admin team. My first teaching position at St. Angela was fifth grade in 2001. I was so young and could only dream of one day becoming your principal. Now, here I am a seasoned school administrator beginning a new chapter at St. Angela, a school which inspired my love for Catholic education.

Many of you may remember me as the second grade teacher or the assistant principal seven years ago. I cherish all the memories St. Angela gave me and I am so blessed to have the opportunity to be back home. As an administrator, I have worked in many different capacities. During my tenure, I piloted a new curriculum, implemented new strategies for small group instruction such as Daily Five, Step Up to Writing, and Blended Learning, I hosted professional development for faculty and staff as well as being a mentor for new teachers. In addition, I am on the Diocesan Curriculum committee, the Leadership team for Multi-Tiered System of Support and continue to chair WCEA accreditation. Though these accomplishments are very noteworthy, I must admit my greatest accomplishment is raising my three children in the Catholic School system. I am an advocate for Catholic education and my priority is to continue to be an advocate for all students.

As I prepare our school for the 2020-21 school year, circumstances have changed with Covid-19. Planning for a safe return to school feels like a very long family road trip. We all have been on this road trip for almost six months and we just want to know when it will end and... Are we there yet? St. Angela Merici school has applied for the waiver and now we wait. I know for many of our families, this news is very frustrating as we are on hold. Like the little passenger in the backseat, it may feel like we may never get to our destination.

If the waiver is **approved**, we will begin in-class instruction for TK-6 students who would like to attend school in person (Option 1) or you may begin the school year at home (Option 2). Seventh and eighth grade students do not have the option of returning to campus and must begin with Distance Learning. If the waiver is **not approved** and/or the Covid-19 data is not in clear for a 14 day period, we will begin Distance learning for all. The Diocese of Orange hopes to give us an answer soon.

Believe me, I share your frustration. However, just like the 'family road trip' seemingly endless. We will arrive at our destination. We will not remain exiled in this strange land forever. We teach and live our virtues with our students at school, which we are called to live out in homes. Let faith, charity, and fortitude overcome the length of this trip and the sting of any frustrations we may feel now.

Again, I thank you for your support and please feel free to reach out to me as my door is always open for you. I pray for all our St. Angela Merici families as we continue on this road trip together.

SUNDAY REFLECTION

Although the apostles are progressing on the path of faith, Jesus knows they still lack much before their relationship with him can be strong and mature. With this in mind, he reinforces his efforts to prepare them by communicating to his disciples he must complete his mission which concludes with dying in Jerusalem. A tragic destiny awaits Jesus in the Holy City of Jerusalem. He is aware and knows full well that his decisions on behalf of the neediest and sinners, his style of freedom and separation from legalism, a life center rather on love, and in fact provoking the leaders of his world to do away with him.

A divine plan which aims to overcome a merely human perspective is nearing completion in Jesus. Behind a humiliating failure of the Messiah of God is hiding his supreme glorification. Nevertheless, his disciples are shaken by the announcement of the passion and cannot see beyond the death awaiting Jesus and themselves after. Peter and his companions recognize Jesus is the promised Messiah. In their mind they conceive he is the political and military freedom fighter who will, with God's power, conquer the oppressors and inaugurate a universal peace. Jesus knows God saves the world by other methods and means. Jesus will give his own life for the love of his father, brothers, and sisters on the cross.

Peter does not accept the plan of God. For this reason, Jesus responds by calling Peter, Satan, asking from him faith and obedience. For Satan, the enemy of God had already tempted Jesus in the desert; offering human power and fleeting success which is why Jesus reminds Peter of this position as disciple. The teacher of Nazareth teaches him the path of God. Peter should accept the paths of God are wiser than those with more human logic. So often, when it comes to leading a "good" life, a holy life, many of us just consider the bad things we do and decide whether or not we are on the right path by simply looking at our "obvious" behavior. I don't steal, I have not killed anyone, or violated my marriage. I don't bribe people or cheat people or go around trying to harm them. In others words, I DO the right things. But is that enough?

My friends, leading a good, holy life is challenging in his own right. Even Jeremiah, as we heard during the first reading, facing hardship for speaking out, felt "duped" by God. It becomes even harder when others try to discourage us from doing so. Let's be sure we are not the ones getting in the way of others trying to do the right thing; make sure we are not obstacles to another person's path to holiness. If we are, we might have Jesus thinking some pretty harsh things about us. Hopefully, that's the last thing we'd want.

Brothers and sisters, may you all have a blessed week and may God protect us all and keep us safe from this coronavirus.


