



At all times please wear your mask, keep social distancing, and before receiving Communion, please sanitize your hands.

Frequently Asked Questions:

***Has the Bishop's dispensation on attending Sunday Mass lapsed?** The dispensation hasn't lapsed but has been updated as we have a better understanding of the Corona Virus and have better safety measures in place. We have Mass on the field, Mass in the Church (starting Sept. 13), Live stream Mass, drive up Communion and Mass broadcast into your car on the FM dial. We have all these opportunity's to keep our Sunday obligation so please take advantage of them. Please see the article in this week's bulletin for additional details.

***Can we have choirs at our outdoor Masses?** This practice is discouraged by the Diocese, personally I can't foresee having a choir again until there's a proven safe and effective vaccine.

SUNDAY REFLECTION

THE CROSS OF FORGIVENESS

Why should we forgive those who hurt us? The gospel this Sunday gives three reasons: First, because Jesus commands it. Second, because forgiveness is part of loving one another. And third, because we want to be forgiven for our sins.

Obviously, Jesus expects us to forgive one another. Here he commands us to forgive unceasingly, without limit. Now this could be a challenge for even the most patient person. So does forgiveness exclude tough love? Does it mean we have to let someone hurt us over and over? No, it is possible to forgive someone and also prevent them from hurting us, if we do it with love (the second reason.) For instance, we might forgive an alcoholic family member, but still insist they get help. We can forgive a son or daughter who breaks the law, but still let them face the consequences so they learn from their mistake. We may forgive a friend who borrows money without repaying it, but still refer them to a credit counselor, instead of lending them more money. Since forgiveness is part of love, it is also part of tough love.

Which leads to the third reason: We forgive because we want to be forgiven. Or more accurately, we forgive because we have been forgiven. Jesus has already died for our sins. His resurrection shows us the Father accepted the sacrifice of his Son Jesus for our sins. If we truly believe Jesus is risen and we will rise to eternal life with him in spite of our sins, how can we refuse to forgive someone who hurts us? When we promise to take up our cross each day to follow Jesus, we must remember why Jesus took up his cross and realize we have to forgive as he does. This is why the cross is such a powerful symbol. It challenges us to accept suffering for Jesus' sake. It reminds us that sometimes our cross is simply forgiving someone rather than hurting them back or hating them. If Jesus gave his life to forgive us, how willing are we to spread our forgiveness around?





QUESTIONS ABOUT NOT ATTENDING SUNDAY MASS

Who does the Bishop foresee possibly making use of the dispensation from physically attending Sunday Mass?

- * Those who are over the age of 65.
- * Those who have an underlying health condition.
- * Those who are truly fearful they might contract the virus; in this case, “truly fearful” is defined as those who have not gone out to a restaurant or visited people with whom they do not live since March 2020.
- * Those who are sick, including those who have tested positive for the coronavirus and those who were exposed for fifteen consecutive minutes or more to one who tested positive for COVID-19.

What is expected of a Catholic who makes use of the dispensation for a legitimate reason?

Since the Bishop has no authority to dispense from a Divine Law, in this case, the commandment requiring us to keep the Lord's Day holy, one may consider the Divine Law fulfilled if, from 4 p.m. the Saturday before or on Sunday itself he/she:

- * Watches a Sunday Mass on television or via livestream (visit www.rcbo.org for a complete list).
- * Spends at least thirty minutes in prayer, by saying the Rosary, reading the Scriptures, or participating in another pious activity.

Is there anything else I should know?

Yes, the faithful are expected to adhere to the expectations laid out in canon 222 §1, that is, “to assist with the needs of the Church.” Financial support of one’s parish is essential to whether one physically attends Mass or not.
