Dear friends,

Praise the Lord! Last month we celebrated 200 First Holy Communions at outdoor Masses. This month we celebrated the Sacrament of Confirmation for 100 of our teens at field Masses. Congratulations to everyone who made their Sacraments and a Big Thank You to those involved in our Faith Formation programs and especially to our parents who are the first and most important teachers of our faith. On October 17th at 5pm we will celebrate the Sacraments of Initiation for those in last year's RCIA process....and then start a new RCIA class.

We just finished our Diocesan 3 to 5 year Financial Audit. Our Audit was very successful and rated "outstanding" by the auditor. Our high marks are the result of much hard work and commitment by our Finance Council led by Bob Duffy, and staff Luz Moreno and Sue de Grasse. Thanks guys! Job well done.

A Big Thanks to Mrs. Telles, our new Principal, our school teachers and staff who have made our Distant and In Person learning classes so successful and safe. Welcome back kids! And a special welcome to our 7th and 8th graders who returned to campus for the first time this week. Also, please welcome our new School Finance Manager Mrs. Ava Susank. Ava comes to us after spending many years at St Bede's in La Canada. So please give her a warm welcome as well.

## Frequently Asked Questions:

**\*Has the Bishop's dispensation on attending Sunday Mass lapsed?** The dispensation hasn't lapsed but has been updated as we have a better understanding of the Corona Virus and have better safety measures in place. We have 3 Sunday Masses on the field, Live stream Mass in the Church (at 7:45am only), drive up Communion and Mass broadcast into cars on the FM dial at 106.9. We have many opportunity's to keep our Sunday obligation so please take advantage of them. Please see the article in this week's bulletin for additional details.

**\*Daily Mass Times:** Mass is being celebrated in the **Hall** at 8 am and 6 pm all week days and Saturday morning. Confessions are at the usual time, 3:30 pm Saturday, in the plaza area.

**\*Sunday Mass Times:** 7:45am livestream Mass in the church (limit 100), **9:00am field Mass, 10am drive up Communion, 10:30am Spanish field Mass and 5:00pm field Mass. Drive up Communion will be available from 10:00 to 10:15am in the school picnic table area.** Please bring a lawn chair, hat, umbrella, easy up, sunscreen, etc. for Masses on the field. You can also tune into St Angela's field Masses on the FM dial at 106.9. Listen to our field Mass in the safety of your vehicle and then come up and receive Holy Communion on the field or at our drive-up communion at 10am. At all times please wear your mask, keep social distancing, and before receiving Communion, please sanitize your hands.

\*Effective immediately, Baptisms, Weddings and Funerals can be celebrated inside the church. **\*Per the governor, all indoor services are limited to 100 people in attendance.**

## SUNDAY REFLECTION

In today's world, it seems we, as a society, are supporting and showing approval to people who are smart or beautiful or accomplished but are without character. Look at our politicians, big corporation executives, sports and show business stars; to most of them principles and values seem to be a secondary thing to wealth, fame, power, and the "good" life. In fact, it is our principles and values which make the good moral character of a human being.

In today's Gospel, Jesus uses the two sons as an example to call us back to good character. In the story, the elder son seems to be the model son and the younger son is the disobedient and irresponsible one. But as the story unfolds, it seems the younger son comes to be a better son than the elder son appeared to be in the beginning. It turns out that both sons are conflicted human beings.

The elder son says what was expected of him to say as an obedient son, but he does otherwise. He is pulled into two directions, as the Chinese saying: he has one-foot stepping in two boats. On one foot, he has the desire to please his father, and the other foot, the strong desire to break free from the parental expectation and "do his own thing." The younger son has the same conflict but reacts in a different way. He refuses to obey and flat out rejects the dilemma his elder brother finds himself in, and openly follows his own wishes instead of his father's. His action is decisive, but he realizes later his action has damaged his relationship with his father, so he regrets what he has said, and ends up doing his father's wishes.

In last Sunday's Gospel, Jesus told the unjust wage story to let the Pharisees and the Jews know the Gentiles and the sinners would have the same access (wages) to the kingdom of God as they did. In today's story, the elder son represents the Pharisees and the Jews, who are well-informed leaders and only obey God with their lips but not action. On the other hand, the younger son represents the outcasts of the society, who have repented and become the disciples of Jesus.

We must strive for good moral character for us and for our society in order to function properly, otherwise, trust among human beings will be nonexistent. The elder son tried to satisfy both his father's wishes and his own. Like the leaders I mentioned in the beginning, they respected the law, but they ignored it when convenient. If we are honest, we will acknowledge sometimes we are the elder son, and sometimes the younger. Jesus is inviting us to put some unity into our lives, not to put one foot in the world of our own desire of money and power, but to try to make the gospel the foundation of our values and of all our decisions.



My dear fellow parishioners, for the past three weeks, my wife Rachel, her mother, and her sister were all in different hospitals with the covid virus. Rachel's mom, Mary Huizar, passed away last week from the virus. Rachel's sister is now home and recovering. Rachel is also now home and is recovering. In the middle of all this, Rachel's brother was diagnosed with prostate cancer which has metastasized into his spinal cord. I have been doing nothing but attending to this, answering emails, and texts concerning Rachel and her mom's condition, now taking care of Rachel and planning her mom's funeral which is a week from Friday here at St. Angela's.

As many of you know, I was set to start a year's program of training and education to become a hospice chaplain. Due to the trauma of the past weeks and its potential effects on the future, Rachel and I have decided it is best to end this pursuit and be more available to my family. I will still be ministering here at St. Angela's two or three days a week as my time allows. A big difference from the five or six days a week in Los Angeles hospitals.


