

# PARISH UPDATE

Dear friends,

**Boy, have we had quite a diversity of weather these past couple weeks. From extreme heat, driving winds and smoke filled skies to cold temps with thunder, lightning and even hail. So please remember, if bad weather (rain, wind etc) occurs, then we will be required to move our Sunday field Masses at 9:00am, 10:30am Spanish and 4:00pm into the church and/or hall (limit 100 people).**

Others are encouraged to view our live stream Mass at <http://stangelabreachurch.org/mass/> or listen to our live broadcast to cars in the parking lot on the FM dial at 106.9 and receive Communion at the covered lunch table area after the 9:00 am Mass or after Mass has ended in the church. At all times please wear your mask, keep social distancing, and before receiving Communion, please sanitize your hands.

Our **Saturday, 5pm evening Mass** is now being celebrated in the church with a limit of 100 people as we are still in the Red Covid tier. Some of our children will be receiving their 1st Holy Communion at this Saturday's bi-lingual Mass. On November 21 5pm there will be an RCIA Mass for those adults who are to be Confirmed. At this time, subsequent Saturday evening Masses will continue with the 100 person limit.

Also, starting this weekend, because our **7:45 am Sunday Mass** has reached the 100-person limit, there will be an overflow Mass in the Hall. We will continue with our **Sunday Field Masses at 9:00am, 10:30am in Spanish and at 4:00pm.**

Please mark your calendar for our annual **Thanksgiving Day Mass** which will be held on November 26 at 9:00am on the School Field and Spanish Mass at 10:30am.

**Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament** is available in the Hall Monday to Friday following the morning Mass from 8:30 to 9:30 AM, before the evening Mass from 5 to 6 PM and Saturday afternoon from 3:30 to 4:45 PM.

**Congratulations everyone!** We met our PSA goal of \$104,000. All donations received from this day forward will be used for safety and security upgrades around the campus.

The Diocese recently rejected our request to bring back employees that are furloughed and strongly encouraged us to find volunteers to take their place. This is where you come in. St Angela's has a great history of volunteerism, people blessing others because they've been blest. Giving back is a cornerstone of our Catholic identity. And you see it in so many of our ministries which are currently handled by volunteers; from our Pastoral Council to ushers, faith formation teachers, Eucharistic Ministry, lectors and the list goes on. Please pray and ask our good Lord if he's calling you to share your gifts and talents here at St. Angela's as a volunteer.

# SUNDAY REFLECTION

## “WHAT’S IN YOUR BAG OF GIFTS?”

There was a time when, early in our marriage with four young children, I was out of work for nearly three years save a few odd jobs here and there, receiving unemployment income, welfare and miscellaneous gifts from friends to survive. It was one of those gifts which changed my wife and I's life due to the way in which it was given.

It came from a couple from our parish; we met through our son when he asked if he could invite some friends over for dinner. Thinking the friends would be our son's age, we were quite surprised when this couple with a daughter a few years older than our son was at the front door that evening. It was the beginning of a long, beautiful relationship that affected everyone in ours and their family from then on.

The gift was \$400, a large amount in those days, to pay some of our bills. The caveat was when we were in better financial shape, we should help others who were in need like we were. This was way before the 2000 movie “Pay It Forward.” It was not only a God send, but it refocused how we needed to look at life as Catholic Christians; who though having financial difficulties could still reach out to others with gifts God has given us.

St. Matthew's Gospel today focuses on disciples who are given gifts by God to be used to make a difference in people's lives who are in need. We are created by God for a purpose. It is our responsibility to discover what our purpose is and to be proactive as often as we can, because time is fleeting as to when God will come for us. We can either invest the talents (gifts) we have or waste them and face God at the end of our life about what we did or didn't do with all we received.

St. Paul in his first letter to the Thessalonians tells them through their belief in Jesus as their Savior they are following the ways of the Lord, but to not become complacent because time is fleeting and they need to be prepared before Christ's returns for judgment. If we don't follow through, God may deny our forward progress to a life of peace and joy. Similar to last week's parable, we need to stay awake at all times.

The Book of Proverbs about the ideal wife who embodies wisdom provides us with multiple options of how to share the many gifts God gives us. I know I am constantly blessed by my wife, Candi, who in our 52 years of marriage has shown me how one cares for others, whether they are family or not. The time and compassion she devotes seem endless, but the difference she makes touches all for the better.

As disciples of Jesus we promise to be obedient to God's will by using all He has given us in the service of one another, especially the poor and needy. This is why St. Paul calls us the children of light and day because we will be ready for the Lord's return due to our lifestyle and pursuits of all that is good. Let us take this week to look into our hearts for more ways we may be able to share our gifts from God for all we serve.

The 7:45am live stream Mass is now open for worship in the Church. Only the first 100 people will be admitted. We will now have overflow for the 7:45am Mass in the hall. We still have the 9am field Mass, 10:30am Spanish field Mass and a 4:00pm field Mass. Drive-up Communion is available from 10:00 to 10:15am. Please bring what you need for outside Masses, or *tune into St. Angela's field Masses on the FM dial at 106.9. **The field Masses are broadcast live to cars in the parking lot. Listen to our Mass and come up to receive Holy Communion on the field or at our drive-up communion at 10am.*** Please always wear your mask, keep social distance, and please sanitize your hands to receive the Host in your hand; step six feet aside before lifting your mask to consume the consecrated Host.

# HOW TO PREPARE FOR A FINANCIAL EMERGENCY

- ◆ **START AN EMERGENCY SAVINGS ACCOUNT.** Saving even small amounts like \$5 or \$10 a week is a good place to start. Make a budget to estimate monthly income and expenses. Reduce debt by making regular payments of at least the minimum due and pay your bills on time to maintain a good credit rating.
- ◆ **REVIEW YOUR INSURANCE COVERAGE INCLUDING FLOOD, HEALTH, AND HOMEOWNERS OR RENTER'S INSURANCE.** Remember, flood insurance typically takes 30 days to go into effect. You will want to renew your insurance every year.
- ◆ **CREATE AND UPDATE YOUR EMERGENCY PLAN.** By having a plan in place, you will be better prepared in case of an emergency.
- ◆ **KEEP IMPORTANT RECORDS SAFE AND SAVE IMPORTANT RECEIPTS.** Store them digitally, in a waterproof, fireproof container. Protect your property by taking photos and videos of household items in case you need to repair, replace, or rebuild after a disaster.
- ◆ **KEEP CASH IN A SECURE PLACE** so you can access it in case of an emergency and Automatic Teller Machines (ATMs) are not available.
- ◆ **CONTACT A QUALIFIED FINANCIAL COUNSELOR OR COACH.** Contact local organizations and non-profits who employ qualified and nationally certified counselors or coaches to receive guidance on how to organize your finances before and after an emergency.
