PARISH UPDATE

Dear friends,

Happy Thanksgiving week everyone. We give Thanks to God for all the abundant blessings we have received. Not just for God's abundant graces but the abundance of blessings we have received from each other and are able to give to one another. St. Angela's is without a doubt one of the most generous parishes I've attended; from volunteers as ushers, Eucharistic ministers, lector's, cantors, teachers, to all of our governing councils and committees. We are truly blessed and grateful.

Unfortunately, this week Governor Newsom announced a change to Orange County's Covid-19 tier from red to the most restrictive level, purple. This means **all Masses, baptisms, funerals, weddings, confessions etc. may only occur outdoors.** We are now limited to having all **Sunday Masses on the field at 9:00am, 10:30am in Spanish and 4:00pm.** If **bad weather** (rain, wind etc) occurs, you are encouraged to view our live stream Mass at **stangelabreachurch.org/mass/** and receive Communion at the covered lunch table area from 10 to 10:15am. At all times, please wear your mask, keep social distancing, and before receiving Communion, please make sure to sanitize your hands. At present, our schools may continue with in-person learning. However, group/ministry meetings, including Faith Formation, may not be indoors.


Please mark your calendar for our annual *Thanksgiving Day Mass* which will be held on November 26 at 9:00am on the field and Spanish field Mass at 10:30am or view our live stream *Thanksgiving Mass* at **stangelabreachurch.org/mass** and receive Communion at the covered lunch table area after Mass has ended.

Advent is just around the corner so please consider availing yourself of the Sacrament of Reconciliation on Saturdays from 3:30 to 4:40 in the plaza. All 3 priests will be available.

The Diocese recently rejected our request to bring back furloughed employees and strongly encouraged us to find volunteers to take their place. This is where you come in. St. Angela's has a great history of volunteerism, people blessing others because they've been blest. Giving back is a cornerstone of our Catholic identity. And you see it in so many of our ministries which are currently handled by volunteers; from our Pastoral Council to ushers, faith formation teachers, Eucharistic Ministry, lectors and the list goes on. Please pray and ask our good Lord if he's calling you to share your gifts and talents here at St Angela's as a volunteer.

SUNDAY REFLECTION

Today is the Solemnity of Our Lord, Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. This is the glorious and mighty title given to our Lord, as we acknowledge he is King of Heaven and Earth, and hopefully King of our hearts as well. Jesus is King of the Universe but how do we know if Jesus is the King of our hearts? Today's Gospel gives us the answer, if Jesus is King of our hearts then we will care for others as He has cared for us by feeding the hungry, giving drink to the thirsty, caring for the sick, visiting the imprisoned, clothing the naked, and welcoming the stranger. Jesus plainly tells us by doing for others, we are doing for Jesus himself. Conversely, when we fail to care for another and his or her needs, we fail to care for Jesus. All who have answered Christ's call of discipleship, and who love and care for others, will inherit the Kingdom he has prepared for us.

There is an abundance of wisdom in the readings the Church has chosen for this special day. Surely, it is no accident on the same day we honor Jesus as King, he is also referred to as shepherd. One title is glorious and mighty. While the other is humble and unassuming, but both are integrally tied to the meaning of this feast. For in coming to inaugurate and reign over the Kingdom, Christ also came in perfect humility. It is a humility that demands the same of us, in a holistic attitude serving as an antidote to secularism. It is a powerful image in today's Gospel as Jesus sits on his glorious throne surrounded by his angels, with the nations assembled before him waiting to be judged. It is clear those sheep who have listened to his voice will be welcomed fully into God's eternal Kingdom, for they will have already been living in God's Kingdom on earth.

As the Gospel states: At the judgment, God will separate us one from another, as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats. He will place the sheep on his right and the goats on his left. Then the king will say to those on his right, 'Come, you who are blessed by my Father. As such we are always called to listen to the Good Shepherd and live like good sheep. For surely, no one wants to be on the left and hear God tell us: 'Depart from me, you accursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels'. The goats on the left failed to heed the simple commands of their shepherd. Now I don't know about you, but if I'm honest with myself there have been times when I failed to be a good sheep. I failed to feed the hungry, give drink to the thirsty, care for the sick, visit the imprisoned, clothe the naked, and welcome the stranger. I think there are times we have all been more like a goat than a sheep. It's in those times we must humbly run to the Good Shepherd to be forgiven and avoid the all too common response of hardening our hearts with guilt, shame, and indifference. The Good Shepherd is always looking and searching out the lost.

Because we are gathered here today, it means we, however well or imperfectly, have heard and are listening to our Shepherd's voice. May we always cooperate with God's good graces and be found to be a sheep by caring for others the way Jesus has cared for us. Amen.

Please bring what you need for outside Masses, or tune into St. Angela's field Masses on the FM dial at 106.9. **The field Masses are broadcast live to cars in the parking lot. Listen to our Mass and come up to receive Holy Communion on the field or at our drive-up communion at 10am.** Please always wear your mask, keep social distance, and please sanitize your hands to receive the Host in your hand; step six feet aside before lifting your mask to consume the consecrated Host.
