

SUNDAY REFLECTION

Samuel hears the call of the Lord while he sleeps and finds it difficult to recognize His call. As tough as it can be at times, whoever listens will be able to perceive what the Lord is asking and will be able to respond. Faith is a mysterious combination between the divine initiative and human liberty. In the second reading, Saint Paul remind us the faith which we profess should influence us in our daily lives, should change our way of acting, and help us improve our customs.

Today John tells us in the gospel how Jesus begins to unite all of his apostles and how he takes them as his own. John knew how to put himself in second place so Jesus could occupy the main part in our lives and in the lives of others. Jesus turns around to face Andrew and the other one and asks them; "what are you looking for?" Jesus is interrogating them asking what they seek in the deepest parts of their hearts, both men answer Jesus with an expression as honest and innocent as it was profound. Where do you live? Jesus wants them to select the very best in life. It is for this reason he invites him to share his company. The words "come to me" belong to real faith. To believe in Jesus is to leave the self behind as number one. To have Jesus as the Lord of our lives. Andrew went directly to his brother Simon to tell him: "we have found the Messiah... ,“ and in this way becomes an apostle and begins to evangelize. Jesus receives Simon and changes his name to Peter, meaning "The Rock". Another beautiful lesson for us is, if we want to evangelize, we must imitate Jesus by encouraging others to discover and make known.

The call of the Lord is a mystery and affects the life of every Christian, but it is manifested with greater clarity for those who Christ invites to leave everything and follow him more closely. The initiative of a vocation is always on Gods part, and the vocation is a free gift to the one who is called to respond with a total gift of oneself. In the same way Jesus calls the apostles, Jesus continues today to call young people to work for him, to work with him. Let us continue to ask God to bless those who are called; they follow the examples of the apostles and instantly leave their nets behind and followed Him.


