

SUNDAY REFLECTION

Several things happen today with our celebration of The Baptism of the Lord. Tomorrow, Monday, begins the season of Ordinary Time; a season not just of counting the time between Christmas and the start of Lent on Ash Wednesday, but a celebration of what Sundays are. The day the Catholic community comes together to celebrate and remember the day of the week when the Lord of Life was raised from the dead and our redemption was achieved.

For those of us who still have Christmas decorations and lights up, it's time to start taking them down. It's always sad to take them down but we must remember Christmas starts a journey. Christmas isn't a season on its own. Last week we celebrated the three kings coming to adore the Lord, and bring him gifts of profound importance. You and I bring profound gifts every Sunday to the Altar, to the Lord Jesus: our own unique gifts freely given by our Creator and offer back to the Father through Jesus in the great love of the Holy Spirit. Today's great feast doesn't just end Christmas but empowers us to begin the journey of Jesus, the journey to the Cross, to Death and Resurrection which again, we celebrate each and every Sunday.

Yesterday I had the privilege to celebrate 6 baptisms. It's always a great joy to celebrate baptisms and it is one of the most joyful actions I do as a deacon. One of the first actions at a baptism is to trace the Sign of the Cross on the foreheads of each child and then claim each for the Lord Jesus. As I tell the parents and godparents, this is a shared journey which doesn't end at First Communion or Confirmation. No, this journey never ends; this shared journey of following the Crucified Jesus into eternity is forever. It is the all-powerful Holy Spirit who is shown as a tender dove descending upon Jesus as he rises out of the waters of baptism, as the skies are opened with great majesty and power. It is so dramatically important to remember it was the Holy Spirit who descended upon you and me at our baptism and again, empowers us to walk this journey with the Lord to Calvary, to the Resurrection, and into the Kingdom of Heaven. Remember in this gospel passage, the heavens don't close; the Holy Spirit doesn't fly away; the Spirit stays with Jesus as the Spirit stays deep within each of us, into our very being.

Yet, there is a price to eternal life. In our First Reading from Isaiah, the prophet writes, "I have grasped you by the hand; as a light for the nations, to open the eyes of the blind, to bring out prisoners from confinement, and from the dungeon, those who live in darkness." We are called to live our lives as Jesus would live, more specifically, to be Jesus to others. To see those who live hopelessly, whose life has no meaning, who have been kicked so many times they don't know which way to turn. You and I are called to look at them, not with our imperfect eyes but with the tender eyes of Christ Jesus, who looks at them with love and compassion; who listens and reaches out. I can't tell you who those people are. But you know them. The ones who are confined in their own pain, in their depression, in their own muck of life. By the power of the Holy Spirit, the Lord takes us by our hand and walks us to those He needs to touch. On this great feast of the Baptism of the Lord, may we follow Jesus into eternity and on our way together, may we enlighten those in our lives who are in the darkness.

May God constantly bless us on our way and keep us safe.
