SUNDAY REFLECTION

Given the last several months, we don't need a prophet to tell us this world won't last forever. As Saint Paul reminds us, the world in its present form is passing away. Jesus may return any moment at the end of time, but if it's not during our lifetime, each of us will one day die. As Scott Hahn once said "all of us face a 100% mortality rate...all of us will die. And all of us face a 100% immortality rate as well. All of us will live forever." The question becomes where will we live forever? If we repent, continuously seeking God's forgiveness for our sins, believed in the Gospel, and done our best to follow Jesus, then, God willing, we will see the Kingdom of God, where we will enjoy eternal life. If heaven is the goal, how should we behave?

Today's readings offer a few practical suggestions. The Ninevites teach us we should acknowledge our own sinfulness, repent, and seek forgiveness. This is important not only because it is right and just, but also because it is an exercise in humility. The glossary of the catechism defines humility as "The virtue by which a Christian acknowledges God is the author of all good. Humility avoids inordinate ambition or pride, and provides the foundation for turning to God in prayer (2559)." Therefore, humility can help us grow in holiness. Saint Paul tells us, we should keep our focus not on the things and events of this world, but rather on heaven, our final goal. We need to live each day knowing we are preparing our souls to, hopefully, live in heaven with Jesus and all the saints and angels.

I like to use the analogy that life is like a basketball player who keeps his eyes on his team mates and the forces who are trying to keep him from scoring. As he dribbles down the court he's aware of all his surroundings (friends and foes) but his ultimate focus is getting the ball into the basket. We too should be aware of all our surroundings and the things of this world but our ultimate focus must be getting into heaven, scoring the winning basket.

Finally, as we see in the Gospel Jesus tells us simply to repent and believe in the Gospel. He invites the first disciples, Simon and Andrew, to follow him. They do, and likewise with James and John. We learn from this Gospel faith includes actively following Christ, even if it means leaving the good things of this world behind. Simon, Andrew, James, and John left their careers and everything behind to follow Jesus...What are we willing to give up for Jesus? Self-sacrifice is never easy, but following Christ is the most important thing we can possibly do in this life. You can't have love without sacrifice; Jesus showed us his love for us on the cross and continues to show us his love every day. It's encouraging to know Jesus is always there to help us love as he loved and to keep our eyes fixed on heaven, our ultimate goal. Amen


